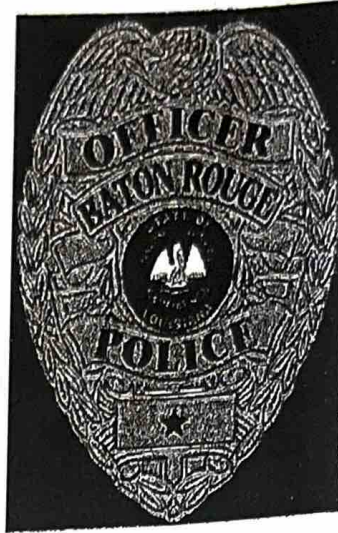

NARRATIVE AREA

ON 04-16-2003 AT APPROX 1630 HRS DETECTIVE INTERVIEWED WITNESS AT HIS PLACE OF EMPLOYMENT,

STATES THAT HE WAS WORKING AS A BOUNCER ON 03-09-2003, NIGHT OF INCIDENT.

WAS INSIDE OF BUSINESS AT APPROX 0205 HRS, ATTEMPTING TO GET EVERYONE OUT OF BAR, WHEN A PATRON CAME BACK IN AND STATED THAT THERE WAS FIXING TO BE A FIGHT OUTSIDE. WHEN WITNESS WALKED OUTSIDE HE OBSERVED ONE W/M RUNNING WHILE 5 W/M'S WERE CHASING HIM.



██████ BEGAN RUNNING TOWARDS THE FIGHT WHEN HE OBSERVED A TALL W/M WITH DARK HAIR, LONG SLEEVE DARK SHIRT, CATCH THE VICTIM AND THE W/M BEGAN TO HIT THE VICTIM OVER AND OVER AGAIN. DETECTIVE QUESTIONED ██████ AS TO IF THIS TALL MALE WAS ██████ AND HE STATED "NO". ██████ ADVISED THAT HE KNEW ██████ PRIOR TO THIS INCIDENT AS BEING A FREQUENT PATRON OF THE BAR AND COULD IDENTIFY HIM. HE STATED THAT ██████ WAS IN THE GROUP OF OTHER 4 MALES THAT CAUGHT UP WITH THE VICTIM NEXT AND THAT GROUP OF MALES (INCLUDING ██████ BEGAN TO HIT AND KICK THE VICTIM WHILE HE WAS LYING ON THE GROUND IN A FETAL POSITION, TO PROTECT HIMSELF.

DURING THE FIGHT ██████ AND OTHER BAR WORKERS WERE ATTEMPTING TO BREAK THE FIGHT UP AND ██████ STATED "BREAK IT UP THE COPS ARE ON THEIR WAY". THAT IS WHEN HE HEARD FROM THE GROUP "WE ARE THE COPS". ONE OF THE GUYS, UNK WHICH ONE, STATED THAT HIS MOM HAD BEEN CALLED A WHORE.

THE FIGHT BEGAN TO BREAK UP AND THE VICTIM WAS STILL LYING ON THE GROUND, WHEN ██████ WALKED UP AND KICKED THE VICTIM SEVERAL TIMES.

██████ AND OTHER BAR WORKERS WERE THEN ABLE TO GET THE VICTIM TO HIS FEET AND HE WAS STANDING THERE WHEN ██████ AGAIN WALKED UP AND SLAPPED THE VICTIM SEVERAL TIMES.

THE OTHER 4 SUSPECTS BEGAN TO WALK TO THEIR VEHICLES. SOME VEHICLES WERE PARKED IN THE SOUTHDOWNS PARKING LOT (A JEEP AND ANOTHER UNK TRUCK), AND SOME VEHICLES WERE PARKED IN THE SONIC PARKING LOT. THE VEHICLES IN THE SOUTHDOWNS LOT LEFT THE SCENE.

THE SUSPECTS WHO HAD WALKED ACROSS THE STREET TO SONIC PARKING LOT, ENTERED THE REAR OF THE BUSINESS WITH ██████

██████ DID NOT OBSERVE THE INCIDENT IN THE SOUTHDOWNS LOT WHERE VICTIM ██████ WAS SHOVED. ██████ AT THAT TIME HAD WALKED BACK TO BUSINESS.

██████ OBSERVED ██████ WALK ACROSS THE STREET AND ██████ BEGAN TO WALK IN THAT DIRECTION. ██████ BEGAN TO WRITE DOWN LIC PLATE NUMBERS ON A PAPER AND ██████ BEGAN TO WRITE DOWN THE NUMBERS ON HIS HAND.

██████ THEN OBSERVED THE SUSPECTS COME OUT THE BACK ENTRANCE OF SONIC AND PROCEED TOWARDS ██████. THE TALL W/M WITH DARK HAIR, LONG SLEEVE DARK SHIRT, ATTEMPTED TO GRAB THE PIECE OF PAPER FROM ██████ AND STATED "YOUR NOT GETTING THE LIC PLATES". TALL GUY ATTEMPTED TO GRAB THE PAPER FROM ██████ AND ██████ JERKED BACK AWAY FROM HIS REACH. THE TALL SUSPECT THEN LUNGED AT ██████ TAKING HIM TO THE GROUND AND PLACED HIM INTO A HEADLOCK. THE OTHER TWO SUSPECTS THEN BEGAN KNEELING ON TOP OF THE VICTIM TO KEEP HIM DOWN AND THEY BEGAN REACHING INTO HIS POCKETS TO FIND THE PAPER. ONE OF THE GUYS SAID "I GOT IT" AND THEY THEN LET ██████ TO HIS FEET. ██████ ADVISED THAT ██████ WAS ONE OF THE SUSPECTS THAT WAS KNEELING ON TOP OF ██████, LOOKING FOR THE PAPER.

AFTER THE INCIDENT ██████ WALKED UP TO THE TALL SUSPECT AND STATED THAT THE WHOLE INCIDENT WAS UNCALLED FOR. THE SUSPECT STATED "WHAT WOULD YOU DO IF SOMEONE CALLED YOUR MOTHER A WHORE?" SOMEWHERE IN THE CONVERSATION THE SUSPECT STATED "YOU DO YOUR JOB AND WE WILL DO OURS". ██████ STATED THAT HE DOES NOT

KNOW WHAT THIS STATEMENT MEANT OR WHY IT WAS SAID.

██████████ WAS STANDING IN THE SONIC LOT WHEN THE OFFICER PULLED UP. HE STATED THAT THE OFFICER WAS GETTING OUT OF HIS VEHICLE WHEN A FEMALE RAN UP FROM DOWN THE STREET AND SAID SOMETHING ABOUT A INCIDENT GOING ON DOWN THE ROAD. THE OFFICER ADVISED HER TO GO BACK TO THAT LOCATION AND A OFFICER WAS IN ROUTE. OFFICER THEN GOT OUT OF HIS VEHICLE AND STATED "YA'LL GO ON AND GET OUT OF HERE". OFFICER DID NOT ATTEMPT TO IDENTIFY ANYONE OR ATTEMPT TO FIND OUT WHAT WAS GOING ON. THAT IS WHEN THE SUSPECTS GOT INTO THEIR VEHICLES AND FLED.

██████████ STATES THAT HE OBSERVED THE TALL SUSPECT WITH DARK BROWN HAIR, GET INTO A WHITE FORD EXTRA CAB TRUCK. ██████████ LATER GAVE PLATE # ██████████ (PARTIAL PLATE) TO THE INITIAL OFFICER. ██████████ HAD WRITTEN THIS PLATE NUMBER ON HIS HAND.

OFFICER THEN WENT TO ██████████ AND GROUP AT SOUTHDOWNS TO FIND OUT WHAT WAS GOING ON. DETECTIVE QUESTIONED IF HE, ██████████, FELT THE OFFICER OBSERVED THE SUSPECTS AND RECOGNIZED THEM. ██████████ STATED THAT HE DID FEEL THAT WAY, NOT BY WHAT THE OFFICER HAD SAID BUT BECAUSE HE HAD LET THEM LEAVE WITHOUT IDENTIFYING THEM.

DETECTIVE THEN PRESENTED ██████████ WITH 5 PHOTO LINE-UPS, LABELED A - E. EACH LINE-UP CONSISTED OF 6 PHOTOS NUMBERED 1-6.

LINE-UP "A" WAS SHOWN FIRST. ██████████ OBSERVED THE LINE-UP FOR APPROX 2 MINUTES AND THEN CIRCLED #3. PHOTO LINE-UP SHEET WAS FILLED OUT AND SIGNED BY ██████████. #3 IS A UNK W/M CANDIDATE THAT WAS CHOSEN BY COMPUTER FOR THE LINE-UP. #5 WAS SUSPECT DAUTHIER, WHICH ██████████ DID NOT CHOOSE.

LINE-UP "B" WAS SHOWN SECOND. ██████████ OBSERVED LINE-UP FOR SEVERAL MINUTES BUT WAS UNABLE TO IDENTIFY ANYONE. LINE-UP SHEET FILLED OUT AND SIGNED. THIS LINE-UP CONTAINED SUSPECT ██████████.

LINE-UP "C" WAS SHOWN THIRD. ██████████ OBSERVED LINE-UP FOR SEVERAL MINUTES AND WAS UNABLE TO IDENTIFY ANYONE. LINE-UP SHEET FILLED OUT AND SIGNED. THIS LINE-UP CONTAINED SUSPECT MICHAEL LAUGHLIN.

LINE-UP "D" WAS THEN SHOWN FOURTH. ██████████ OBSERVED LINE-UP FOR SEVERAL MINUTES AND WAS UNABLE TO IDENTIFY ANYONE. LINE-UP SHEET FILLED OUT AND SIGNED. THIS LINE-UP CONTAINED SUSPECT ██████████.

LINE-UP "E" WAS SHOWN LAST. ██████████ OBSERVED LINE-UP FOR SEVERAL MINUTES AND WAS UNABLE TO IDENTIFY ANYONE. LINE-UP SHEET FILLED OUT AND SIGNED. THIS LINE-UP CONTAINED SUSPECT ██████████.

ALL LINE-UPS WERE PLACED INTO BRPD EVIDENCE UNDER SAME FILE #.

INTERVIEW ENDED AT APPROX 1730 HRS.

WRITTEN VOLUNTARY STATEMENT FROM ██████████ PLACED INTO BRPD EVIDENCE.

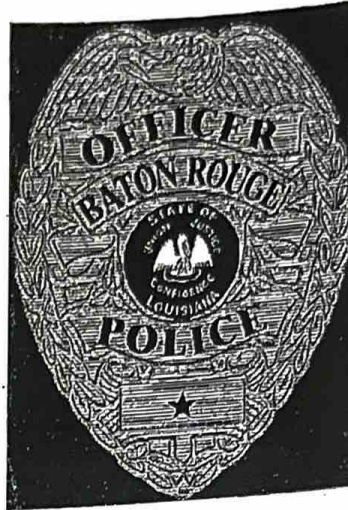

On 04-04-2003 at approx 0900 hrs. detective interviewed witness [REDACTED], at his place of business, [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] stated that on 03-09-2003 at approx 0200 hrs, he was at the Southdowns bar and lounge.

While standing outside of business [REDACTED] observed 3 w/m's hitting and kicking another w/m. The w/m victim was lying on the ground and being hit and kicked several times.

█████ stated that he and three other males then approached and attempted to "make the fight even". The fight then dispersed and the w/m victim got up and approached ██████. Victim thanked ██████ for his assistance and then walked to his vehicle and drove away.

Victim appeared to have a bloodied face but was walking well on his own and did not seem to be in need of medical attention.

█████ then left the business, he advised that he did not see the incident involving ██████.

█████ was unable to provide detective with any further information that would be of assistance to the ██████ investigation.

█████ was shown approx 9 drivers license photos of w/m's. ██████ positively identified ██████ as one w/m involved in the initial fight. ██████ unable to identify any other suspects in the photos shown.

Investigation continues.

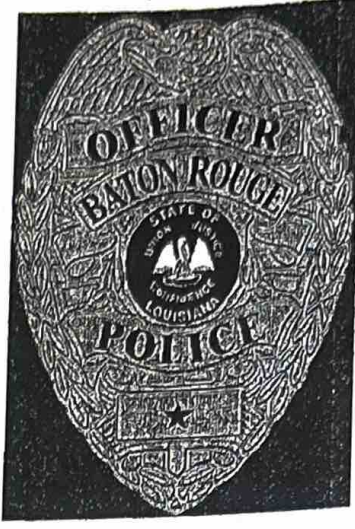

ON 04-15-2003 AT APPROX 0930 HRS DETECTIVE CONTACTED OWNER OF SOUTHDOWNS BAR AND GRILL, RODNEY CAREY, AT HIS PLACE OF BUSINESS, 4205 PERKINS RD.

CAREY STATED THAT HE WAS NOT AT THE BAR ON THE NIGHT OF THE INCIDENT HOWEVER SEVERAL EMPLOYEES, INCLUDING HIS DAUGHTER, HAD ADVISED HIM OF THE INCIDENT.

CAREY PROVIDED DETECTIVE WITH TWO PHOTOS OF [REDACTED]. HE ADVISED THAT [REDACTED] IS A REGULAR PATRON OF THE BAR AND WHEN [REDACTED] HAD RETURNED TO THE BAR APPROX 1 WEEK AFTER INCIDENT, SEVERAL EMPLOYEES HAD POINTED HIM OUT AS A SUSPECT IN THE INCIDENT. PHOTOS WERE TAKEN OF [REDACTED] AT THAT TIME AND THESE PHOTOS WERE PRESENTED TO DETECTIVE.



VIDEO TAPE FROM SURVEILLANCE CAMERA ON NIGHT OF INCIDENT ALSO GIVEN TO DETECTIVE. RODNEY WAS UNABLE TO PROVIDE ANY FURTHER INFORMATION AS TO THE NIGHT OF THE INCIDENT.

DETECTIVE WAS ABLE TO WATCH VIDEO TAPE APPROX 30 MINUTES LATER IN OFFICE AT 704 MAYFLOWER.

ON THE TAPE APPROX 4 - 5 W/M'S AND ONE W/F ARE SEEN STANDING IN FRONT OF THE BAR AT 0205 HRS. IT APPEARS THERE IS ONE W/M THAT IS HARASSING THE SUBJECTS. ONE SUBJECT IN GROUP APPEARS TO BE HAVING SOME WORDS WITH THE W/M. AT APPROX 0210 HRS, THE W/M RUNS AND THE 4 - 5 SUBJECTS IN GROUP RUN AFTER IN HIM IN PURSUIT. ALL SUBJECTS THEN LEAVE RANGE OF THE CAMERA.

THE TAPE IS VERY DARK AND IT IS EXTREMELY DIFFICULT TO SEE THE FACES OF THE SUSPECTS. DETECTIVE WAS UNABLE TO IDENTIFY ANYONE FROM THIS VIDEO TAPE.

THE TAPE WAS TURNED OVER TO INTERNAL AFFAIRS INVESTIGATORS FOR FURTHER INVESTIGATION AND LATER TO BE TURNED INTO BRPD EVIDENCE.

Assaults Office on 03/14/03 at 0900 hours. On 03/14/03, [REDACTED] contacted said Detective. He advised Detective the bar had closed and he was inside with the bartender, D.J. and bar backs assisting with cleaning up the place to get out for the night. The cleaning was disrupted by a female crying and banging on the door for help. [REDACTED] stated he doesn't know what the females' name is but she told them there was a fight in the parking lot.

When they emerged from the bar, he saw seven or eight guys fighting one guy. The guy was lying face down and had his hands raise up not fighting. They attempted to disperse the group that were involved in the fight and that's when he saw [REDACTED] taken to the ground and punched on by three males. They were separated and told the police had been called, and they responded by saying they were the fucking police. [REDACTED] stated that it look like it was taking the police a long time to get there, so a second call was placed stating that off duty officers were involved in the fight. [REDACTED] stated that the people started leaving the parking lot. Some of the people involved in the fight went to the Sonic Restaurant. [REDACTED] stated the main individual involved in the fight went in the back door of the Sonic. [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] went across the street and was writing license plate #'s of the individuals involved when [REDACTED] was engaged again and thrown to the ground and choked while they took away the paper he was writing on. [REDACTED] heard them say to [REDACTED] that he didn't know who he was fucking with and he had better leave it alone. After this, they separated and they walked back to Southdown's parking lot and waited for the police.

[REDACTED] stated a few more people involved in the incident left prior to the on duty officers showing up. An officer approached him and the other witnesses at Southdown's and asked where were the people involved in the fight, and they pointed to the Sonic. The on duty officer walked over to the Sonic and asked them what were they doing and advised them to get out of there. The witness statement was marked for identification purposes and tagged as evidence. For more information see all reports this same file number as the investigation continues.
