26	INTRODUCTION	
27	1. Plaintiffs bring this action for damages against Defendants ERIN R.	
28	SPOHR, DANIEL SERAFINI, (collectively, "Defendants"), and DOES 1 through 10,

inclusive, for damages Plaintiffs suffered arising out of the senseless murder of Plaintiff ADRIENNE SPOHR and Defendant ERIN R. SPOHR's Father, Robert Gary Spohr and the shooting of Plaintiff ADRIENNE SPOHR and Defendant ERIN R. SPOHR's Mother, Wendy Wood, eventually resulting in the death of Wendy Wood.

2. On Saturday, June 5, 2021, a masked and hooded man ran up the driveway toward the Homewood/West Lake Tahoe home of Robert Gary Spohr and Wendy Wood. Hours later, Placer County authorities found Mr. Spohr dead from a point-blank gunshot wound. Ms. Wood was clinging to life with two gunshot wounds to the brain. Ms. Wood subsequently died because of the June 5, 2021, incident.

## JURISDICTION AND VENUE

- 3. This Court has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to Code of Civil Procedure §§ 395(a) and 410.10 because the injury causing death occurred in Placer County, California, rendering the exercise of jurisdiction over Defendants in California Courts consistent with the notions of fair play and substantial justice. This Court further has jurisdiction *in rem* over real property located in Placer County, California and is at issue in this matter.
- 4. Venue is proper in Placer County pursuant to Code of Civil Procedure § 395 because the injury causing death occurred in Placer County, California, and because Plaintiffs suffered harm in Placer County, California.

# **PARTIES**

- 5. Plaintiff ADRIENNE SPOHR is a resident of Sonoma County, California and is the surviving daughter of decedents Robert Gary Spohr and Wendy Wood.
- 6. Plaintiff THE ESTATE OF ROBERT G. SPOHR is represented by and through its Successor-in-interest ADRIENNE SPOHR pursuant to California Code of Civil Procedure section 377.60.
- Plaintiff THE ESTATE OF WENDY WOOD is represented by and through its Successor-in-interest ADRIENNE SPOHR pursuant to California Code of Civil Procedure section 377.60.

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- 8. Defendant ERIN R. SPOHR is a resident of Reno, Nevada.
- 9. Defendant DANIEL SERAFINI is a resident of Reno, Nevada.
- 10. The true names and capacities, whether individual, corporate, associate, or otherwise of Defendants DOES 1 through 10, are unknown to Plaintiffs who, under Code of Civil Procedure § 474, sue these DOE Defendants under fictitious names. Plaintiffs will amend this complaint to show the true names and capacities of DOE Defendants when they are ascertained. Each of the DOE Defendants is in some manner legally responsible for the occurrences alleged in in this complaint, and Plaintiff's damages as alleged were legally caused by each of those DOE Defendants.
- 11. At all relevant times, each of the Defendants were the partners, principals, agents, employees, servants, and joint venturers of each other, and in doing the things alleged in in this complaint were acting within the course and scope of their authority and relationship as partners, principals, agents, employees, servants, and joint venturers with the permission, knowledge, and consent of each other.

# RELEVANT FACTUAL ALLEGATIONS

- 12. According to authorities, the June 5, 2021, heinous murder of Robert Gary Spohr and attempted murder of Wendy Wood, eventually leading to Wood's death, were premeditated and planned. Indeed, Robert Gary Spohr and Wendy Wood (collectively, "Plaintiff's Decedents") were targeted by the masked, hooded assailant.
- 13. Wendy Wood spent a month in the Intensive Care Unit and several weeks in rehab. Wood was forced to relearn basic skills, including how to walk, talk, and eat again. She never regained memory of the June 5, 2021, incident. Eventually, her injuries stemming from the June 5, 2021, incident led to her death.
- 14. Plaintiff ADRIENNE SPOHR and Defendant ERIN R. SPOHR share property gifted to them by their Parents, Plaintiff's Decedents, including real property located in Placer County, California.

15. In April of 2023, the Placer County Sheriff's Office confirmed new developments in the "cold case" regarding the shooting of Plaintiff's Decedents. In a social media post, the office confirmed that the suspects may reside in the Reno area.

# **GENERAL ALLEGATIONS**

#### FIRST CAUSE OF ACTION

# Wrongful Death (Against all Defendants)

- 16. Plaintiffs incorporate by reference and reallege each and every allegation and statement contained in the prior paragraphs.
- 17. Plaintiffs are informed and believe, and thereon allege, that Defendants, and each of them, including DOES 1 through 10, inclusive, caused, conspired to cause, or otherwise participated in causing, the premeditated and planned June 5, 2021, murder of Robert Gary Spohr and attempted murder of Wendy Wood, eventually leading to Wood's death.
- 18. The aforementioned subject incident giving rise to this wrongful death and survival action proximately and legally caused Plaintiff's Decedents to suffer fatal injuries.
- 19. Plaintiffs are further informed and believe, and thereon allege, that Defendants, and each of them, including DOES 1 through 10, inclusive, were agents, servants, employees, successors, joint venturers, co-conspirators, and/or successors-in-interest of their co-defendants, who were acting within the course, scope, and authority of said agency, employment and or venture, and/or in furtherance of said conspiracy in causing the aforementioned subject incident to occur.
- 20. As a legal, direct, and proximate result of the malicious, despicable, cruel, and unjust conduct of Defendants, and each of them, including DOES 1 through 10, inclusive, as described in this complaint, Plaintiffs have sustained damages resulting

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from the loss of love, affection, society, service, comfort, support, right of support, expectations of future support and counseling, companionship, solace, and mental support, as well as other benefits and assistance of Plaintiff's Decedents, all to their general damages in a sum in excess of the jurisdictional limits of this Court, which will be stated according to proof, pursuant to Section 425.10 of the California Code of Civil Procedure.

- 21. As a legal, direct, and proximate result of the malicious, despicable, cruel, and unjust conduct of Defendants, and each of them, including DOES 1 through 10, inclusive, as described in this complaint, Plaintiffs will be deprived of the financial support and assistance of Plaintiff's Decedents, the exact amount of such losses to be stated according to proof, pursuant to Section 425.10 of the California Code of Civil Procedure.
- 22. As a legal, direct, and proximate result of the malicious, despicable, cruel, and unjust conduct of Defendants, and each of them, including DOES 1 through 10, inclusive, as described in this complaint, Plaintiffs have incurred property, medical, funeral and burial expenses in an amount to be stated according to proof, pursuant to Section 425.10 of the California Code of Civil Procedure.
- 23. As a legal, direct, and proximate result of the malicious, despicable, cruel, and unjust conduct of Defendants, and each of them, including DOES 1 through 10, inclusive, as described in this complaint, Plaintiff's Decedents have suffered lost earnings, the exact amount of such losses to be stated according to proof, pursuant to Section 425.10 of the California Code of Civil Procedure.
- 24. Because the malicious, despicable, cruel, and unjust conduct of Defendants, and each of them, including DOES 1 through 10, inclusive, as described in this complaint, was committed in a deliberate, cold, callous, calculating, premeditated, intentional and/or unreasonable manner, causing fatal injuries to Plaintiff's Decedents, and done with conscious disregard of Plaintiff's Decedents rights and safety, Plaintiff THE ESTATE OF ROBERT G. SPOHR by and through its Successor-in-interest

ADRIENNE SPOHR, and Plaintiff THE ESTATE OF WENDY WOOD by and through its Successor-in-interest ADRIENNE SPOHR, request the assessment of punitive damages against Defendants, and each of them, including DOES 1 through 10, inclusive, in an amount appropriate to punish and/or set an example of them.

#### SECOND CAUSE OF ACTION

# Survival and Survival Damages (Against all Defendants)

- 25. Plaintiffs incorporate by reference and reallege each and every allegation and statement contained in the prior paragraphs.
- 26. Plaintiffs are informed and believe, and thereon allege, that Defendants, and each of them, including DOES 1 through 10, inclusive, caused, conspired to cause, or otherwise participated in causing, the premeditated and planned June 5, 2021, murder of Robert Gary Spohr and attempted murder of Wendy Wood, eventually leading to Wood's death.
- 27. The aforementioned subject incident giving rise to this wrongful death and survival action proximately and legally caused Plaintiff's Decedents to suffer fatal injuries.
- 28. Plaintiffs are further informed and believe, and thereon allege, that Defendants, and each of them, including DOES 1 through 10, inclusive, were agents, servants, employees, successors, joint venturers, co-conspirators, and/or successors-in-interest of their co-defendants, who were acting within the course, scope, and authority of said agency, employment and or venture, and/or in furtherance of said conspiracy in causing the aforementioned subject incident to occur.
- 29. As a legal, direct, and proximate result of the malicious, despicable, cruel, and unjust conduct of Defendants, and each of them, including DOES 1 through 10, inclusive, as described in this complaint, Plaintiffs have sustained damages resulting from the loss of love, affection, society, service, comfort, support, right of support, expectations of future support and counseling, companionship, solace, and mental support, as well as other benefits and assistance of Plaintiff's Decedents, all to their

general damages in a sum in excess of the jurisdictional limits of this Court, which will be stated according to proof, pursuant to Section 425.10 of the California Code of Civil Procedure.

- 30. As a legal, direct, and proximate result of the malicious, despicable, cruel, and unjust conduct of Defendants, and each of them, including DOES 1 through 10, inclusive, as described in this complaint, Plaintiffs will be deprived of the financial support and assistance of Plaintiff's Decedents, the exact amount of such losses to be stated according to proof, pursuant to Section 425.10 of the California Code of Civil Procedure.
- 31. As a legal, direct, and proximate result of the malicious, despicable, cruel, and unjust conduct of Defendants, and each of them, including DOES 1 through 10, inclusive, as described in this complaint, Plaintiffs have incurred property, medical, funeral and burial expenses in an amount to be stated according to proof, pursuant to Section 425.10 of the California Code of Civil Procedure.
- 32. As a legal, direct, and proximate result of the malicious, despicable, cruel, and unjust conduct of Defendants, and each of them, including DOES 1 through 10, inclusive, as described in this complaint, Plaintiff's Decedents have suffered lost earnings, the exact amount of such losses to be stated according to proof, pursuant to Section 425.10 of the California Code of Civil Procedure.
- 33. Because the malicious, despicable, cruel, and unjust conduct of Defendants, and each of them, including DOES 1 through 10, inclusive, as described in this complaint, was committed in a deliberate, cold, callous, calculating, premeditated, intentional and/or unreasonable manner, causing fatal injuries to Plaintiff's Decedents, and done with conscious disregard of Plaintiff's Decedents rights and safety, Plaintiff THE ESTATE OF ROBERT G. SPOHR by and through its Successor-in-interest ADRIENNE SPOHR, and Plaintiff THE ESTATE OF WENDY WOOD by and through its Successor-in-interest ADRIENNE SPOHR, request the assessment of punitive damages

against Defendants, and each of them, including DOES 1 through 10, inclusive, in an amount appropriate to punish and/or set an example of them.

### THIRD CAUSE OF ACTION

# Intentional Infliction of Emotional Distress (Against all Defendants)

- 34. Plaintiffs incorporate by reference and reallege each and every allegation and statement contained in the prior paragraphs.
- 35. This complaint alleges actions for damages pursuant to the common law of the State of California as determinable from the face of the complaint.
- 36. The malicious, despicable, cruel, and unjust conduct of Defendants, and each of them, including DOES 1 through 10, inclusive, as described in this complaint, was extreme and outrageous and committed with wanton and reckless disregard of the probability of causing Plaintiff ADRIENNE SPOHR to suffer severe emotional distress.
- 37. The malicious, despicable, cruel, and unjust conduct of Defendants, and each of them, including DOES 1 through 10, inclusive, as described in this complaint, caused Plaintiff ADRIENNE SPOHR to suffer the loss of her father by first degree murder and to endure watching her mother suffer for a month in Intensive Care Unit and several weeks in rehab, relearn basic skills, including how to walk, talk, and eat again, and memory loss.
- 38. As a proximate result of the malicious, despicable, cruel, and unjust conduct of Defendants, and each of them, including DOES 1 through 10, inclusive, as described in this complaint, Plaintiff ADRIENNE SPOHR suffered shame, humiliation, mental anguish, and extreme emotional and physical distress all to her general damage, which will be stated according to proof, pursuant to Section 425.10 of the California Code of Civil Procedure.
- 39. As a direct, foreseeable, and legal result of the malicious, despicable, cruel, and unjust conduct of Defendants, and each of them, including DOES 1 through 10, inclusive, as described in this complaint, Plaintiff ADRIENNE SPOHR has suffered and continues to suffer substantial losses in earnings, bonuses and other employment

benefits, in addition to expenses incurred in obtaining alternative employment, and has suffered and continues to suffer shame, humiliation, mental anguish, and extreme emotional and physical distress all to her general damage, which will be stated according to proof, pursuant to Section 425.10 of the California Code of Civil Procedure.

40. Because the malicious, despicable, cruel, and unjust conduct of Defendants, and each of them, including DOES 1 through 10, inclusive, as described in this complaint, was committed in a deliberate, cold, callous, calculating, premeditated, intentional and/or unreasonable manner, causing fatal injuries to Plaintiff's Decedents, and done with conscious disregard of Plaintiff ADRIENNE SPOHR's rights and safety, Plaintiff ADRIENNE SPOHR, requests the assessment of punitive damages against Defendants, and each of them, including DOES 1 through 10, inclusive, in an amount appropriate to punish and/or set an example of them.

## FOURTH CAUSE OF ACTION

## Punitive Damages (Against all Defendants)

- 41. Plaintiffs incorporate by reference and reallege each and every allegation and statement contained in the prior paragraphs.
- 42. The conduct of Defendants, and each of them, including DOES 1 through 10, inclusive, as described in this complaint, was committed in a deliberate, cold, callous, calculating, premeditated, intentional and/or unreasonable manner, causing fatal injuries to Plaintiff's Decedents, and done with conscious disregard of Plaintiffs', and each of them, rights and safety.
- 43. Because the malicious, despicable, cruel, and unjust conduct of Defendants, and each of them, including DOES 1 through 10, inclusive, as described in this complaint, was committed in a deliberate, cold, callous, calculating, premeditated, intentional and/or unreasonable manner, causing fatal injuries to Plaintiff's Decedents, and done with conscious disregard of Plaintiffs', and each of them, rights and safety, Plaintiffs request the assessment of punitive damages against Defendants, and each of them, including DOES 1 through 10, inclusive, in an amount appropriate to punish

and/or set an example of them pursuant to California Code of Civil Procedure section 3294.

### **DEMAND FOR JURY TRIAL**

44. Plaintiffs hereby demand a jury trial.

### PRAYER FOR RELIEF

Plaintiffs seek the following damages in an amount according to proof at trial: For Wrongful Death and Survival:

- (1) For non-economic damages suffered by Plaintiff ADRIENNE SPOHR including, but not limited to the loss of love, affection, society, service, comfort, support, right of support, expectations of future support and counseling, companionship, solace, and mental support, as well as other benefits and assistance of Plaintiff's Decedents, in a sum in excess of the jurisdictional minimum, according to proof;
- (2) For economic damages suffered by Plaintiff THE ESTATE OF ROBERT G. SPOHR by and through its Successor-in-interest ADRIENNE SPOHR, and Plaintiff THE ESTATE OF WENDY WOOD by and through its Successor-in-interest ADRIENNE SPOHR, related to the loss of earnings according to proof;
- (3) For funeral and burial expenses suffered by Plaintiffs, according to Proof;
- (4) For hospital, medical, professional, and incidental expenses suffered by Plaintiffs, according to proof;
- (5) For punitive and exemplary damages against Defendants in an amount according to proof under Code of Civil Procedure § 3294 and/or any and all other statutory or legal bases that may apply;
- (6) For prejudgment and post judgment interest according to proof; and,
- (7) For such other and further relief as the Court shall deem proper, all according to proof.

# For Intentional Infliction of Emotional Distress (Plaintiff ADRIENNE SPOHR only):

- (1) For a money judgment representing compensatory damages including lost wages, earnings, all other sums of money, together with interest on these amounts according to proof;
- (2) For an award of money judgment for mental pain and anguish and severe emotional distress, including medical special damages, according to proof;
- (3) Attorneys' fees, expert fees, consultant fees and litigation costs and expenses, as allowed under any statute, including under the tort of another doctrine:
- (4) For punitive and exemplary damages against Defendants in an amount according to proof under Public Utilities Code § 2106, Code of Civil Procedure § 3294 and/or any and all other statutory or legal bases that may apply;
- (5) Costs of suit;
- (6) For prejudgment and post judgment interest according to proof; and,
- (7) For such other and further relief as the Court shall deem proper.
