See Nat'l Pub. Radio, Inc. v. United States Dep't of the Treasury, No. 19–cv–17 (JDB), 2021 WL 1850696, at *2 (D.D.C. Mar. 31, 2021). This case has now been pending for nearly two years. The production, at some point, must come to a close. Consistent with the court's decision in National Public Radio, the court orders as follows: (1) Defendant shall process by no later than May 12, 2023, all documents for which it has received responses to its consultation/coordination requests by April 21, 2023; and it is further ordered that (2) the parties shall submit a Joint Status Report by no later than May 12, 2023, detailing the status of all remaining outstanding consultation/coordination requests including (a) number of pages; (b) the date first referred for consultation; (c) the name of the consulting agency if disclosable in accordance with 31 C.F.R. § 1.3(d)(3); (d) the consulting agency's estimated time for responding and any circumstances giving rise to that estimate; and (e) Defendant's anticipated time for processing and production thereafter.
