I want to apologize for the delays in reaching out to you on this request. We've searched for records responsive to your attached request and found the results to be voluminous. Quite honestly, we are picking up so many things that are beyond the desired scope that we really need to discuss what you need and hope to locate. Just running a search of just from Dr. Fauci for this time period leads to over 21,000 pages with the attachments.

Some thoughts on what might help: Would it be possible to limit this request to just *from* Fauci without the attachments? From there, you'll have a better idea of what you might really need. I am concerned that this review will take forever based on the original quantity. Or, since some time has passed, if you want to take a look at the search terms initially provided and add additional terms, change the time frame, etc., I'd be happy to try some things out and see what we get. I'd hate to have you wait even longer for things, types of items you are not really seeking. We are picking up random CVs, articles, and nothing to do with direct contact with J&J, etc.
