In response to your Colorado Open Records Act request of November 13, 2023, I provide the following:

Below are the current Colorado law enforcement agencies and entities that are accessing the LexisNexis Lumen application and its facial recognition software to both solve crimes and protect individual liberties. According to Colorado statute, (a link to which I provided in my first response), agencies follow strict guidelines when utilizing facial recognition software. For example, human intervention and review is a required process to ensure accuracy and to also protect privacy and liberties.
