Check the Status of a Request

Thank you for submitting a Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request with the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC). You can check the status of a request without registering, but to obtain detailed information about the request you will need to be signed into our e-FOIA PAL application.

To check the status of a FOIA request, you must enter the assigned FOIA request Tracking Number and the last name of the requester (Example: Enter **17-F-00000** as the Case # and **Smith** as the last name of the requester)

Enter the **CAPTCHA Image** in the box, click **Verify** and then click the **Find** Box.

A request goes through several stages/phases during processing. Some of the status codes for a request during processing are as follows:

Status Code	Meaning
Received	We have received your request submission. You will receive a letter, which acknowledges the receipt of your request and assigns your request a tracking number.
On Hold/Fee Related or Need Clarification	The request has been placed on hold for either a fee related issue or we need clarification about the information you are requesting.
Assigned	The request has been assigned to a Government Information Specialist for processing.
In Process	We are processing the request.
Completed	We have completed the processing of the request.
Documents Delivered	Your requested material can be downloaded via the e-FOIA PAL portal or you will receive the material by postal mail.
Closed	We have closed the request (letter and/or material sent to requester).

Some text fields may be case-sensitive.
