14	2. That the Court dismiss the Second Amended Complaint in its entirety with prejudice;
15	3. That Defendants be awarded its costs of suit, including its attorneys' fees to the extent
16	permitted by law or contract; and
17	4. For such other and further relief as the Court may deem just and proper.
