This letter is to follow up regarding my letter to you dated July 7, 2015, wherein I inquired of you regarding the existence (or non-existence) of any additional, unproduced evidence from Plaintiffs. As you will recall, the only response I've had from Plaintiffs in that regard is your letter dated September 4, 2015, which was accompanied by (1) an amicus brief submitted to the Supreme Court prior to oral argument, and (2) a three year old email exchange. Yesterday, Plaintiff Fairchild's filing with the Court included reference to "three Oklahoma pharmacies" that are apparently "willing and able to compound or obtain injectable pentobarbital, and another pharmacy that could order and distribute injectable pentobarbital" for the Department of Corrections' use in executions of death row offenders. As you know, two sworn affidavits were submitted in support of this contention.

Please provide the names, addresses, and telephone numbers of the relevant Oklahoma pharmacies by five o'clock today so that steps may be taken to possibly secure the drug in question in time for upcoming executions.
