AMENDED CASE SPECIFIC SCHEDULING ORDER

As a current member of the General Assembly, the Defendant is automatically entitled to a continuance and stay from “all aspects of the case.” O.C.G.A. § 17-8-26(a). The Defendant’s requests¹ for a continuance of the motions deadline are therefore GRANTED. The case specific scheduling order filed September 29, 2023, is hereby amended as follows:

(1) Motions: The filing deadline for pretrial motions (other than motions *in limine*) is extended from January 8, 2024, to April 18, 2024,² for the above-listed Defendant.

All other provisions, including initial reciprocal discovery obligations, remain in place. Additional extensions will only be considered upon filing of a particularized motion containing a detailed, fact-based explanation of the need for the extension including the amount of time needed.
