(P#631) and C. Risley (P#660) were investigating this event during dismissals. [REDACTED]

I was parked near the Jack in the Box, which is the common spot for these fights to occur. I observed three black male juveniles walking back and forth between the Jack in the Box parking lot and across Dewey to the parking lot north. All three males had blue medical rubber gloves on, which appeared strange and drew my attention. My first thought was this was possibly to use a weapon during a fight and not leave fingerprints. They returned to the Jack in the Box parking lot, then walked west, toward the Storage Facility, out of my view. I notified Sergeant Bolden (P#511) as he was in the area and not currently investigating the firearm call.

Sgt Bolden arrived to my location and observed the juveniles grouping up, which is common before a fight starts. Sgt Bolden observed one juvenile, later identified as [REDACTED], moving about the crowd, pointing at our vehicles, and talking to other juveniles. At one point, Bolden stated he thought he saw something in [REDACTED] pocket and that he believed [REDACTED] may have a weapon, due to his actions. Bolden stated he wanted to stop and speak with [REDACTED], so we both turned around and made a person stop on [REDACTED] near the south fence of the Durango HS football field. [REDACTED] was walking in a group of approximately four other juveniles when we made the stop and was walking in the street as we approached him. As I pulled in front of [REDACTED] and Bolden pulled behind, he attempted to walk away from the stop by walking in the street, south from our location.

I immediately exited my vehicle and told [REDACTED] we wanted to speak to him, and that he was drawing our attention with his actions, so that was why we were stopping him. As I attempted stop him and walk him to the hood of the car, he pulled his hands away. I took his cell phone out of his hand and placed it on the hood of the car, and the male he was walking with, later identified as [REDACTED], was yelling to let his cousin go. I yelled at the group which had started to form to leave the area, and [REDACTED] continued to yell at us to let his cousin go. He started walking away as I approached him, but I felt that he was agitating the group and wanted to gain control, as we only had three officers on the scene at this time. When I grabbed [REDACTED] by his left arm and placed him in handcuffs, the crowd began yelling more and one male juvenile, later identified as [REDACTED], attempted to stop me from detaining [REDACTED].

[REDACTED] was walking directly behind me and I once again told him to keep walking and leave the area. Due to him already attempting to stop me from detaining [REDACTED], I told him if he wanted to be next in

handcuffs. I then told him again to start walking, at which point he said no. I then grabbed [REDACTED], who immediately pulled away and started pulling his hands from my grasp, and yelling at me not to touch him. I pushed [REDACTED] up against the fence, and he attempted again to remove himself from my grasp, so I then spun him around and took him down to the ground. He continued to move his body, in what I believed was an attempt to get up, so I yelled at him to stop moving. As I did so, an unidentified juvenile pushed me on my right shoulder and stood directly in front of me. I then pulled out my pepper spray and started yelling for everyone to get back and I then directed Officer C. Turner (P#655) to place [REDACTED] in handcuffs. I then finished clearing the crowd far enough away from our vehicles so that we could continue our investigation. [REDACTED] was later asked if he had any injuries, to which he declined and also declined a medical response.

At this point, the crowd was still yelling, but had backed up enough for us to speak with the three males we had detained. While speaking with the juveniles, [REDACTED] mother and father arrived on scene. His mother refused to calm down and speak with me, rather she was yelling and screaming and causing the crowd to start forming and getting loud again. His father, identified as [REDACTED], spoke with me and I advised why he had been stopped and why he was currently in handcuffs. I explained that if we would have been able to speak with them, without the yelling, screaming, and non-compliance, we would have already been done and released them. Officer Glaze was now on scene and after explaining the situation, I asked Glaze to release [REDACTED] with no charges. The pat down of [REDACTED], conducted by Bolden, produced negative results. He was advised of why he was stopped and released on scene with no charges.
