### Summary of Discussion:

A debrief of February 2020 meetings (SOREM and Pelmorex) was provided by PS on topics including long term funding, governance needs and the upcoming PAWG and NAAD system Governance Council meetings. A discussion of risk / policy intention around s. 9(1)(h) funding under the *Broadcasting Act* and discussion of the recent Broadcasting and Telecommunications Legislation Review (the Yale Report). Questions remain regarding legislative review, and availability of same / similar instruments. In light of resource priorities, PS will be focusing on needs analysis and set out roles and responsibilities of all stakeholders involved in NPAS. CRTC provided updates on ongoing operational items including upcoming public opinion research and the ISED CRC project on system efficiency /handset testing.

## **Action Items**

- 1) CRTC to present at FPT SOREM and demystify the policy behind the 9(1)h status and the next five years projections, explain CRTC's role and set out risks and considerations.
- 2) PS to report back to CRTC after NAAD System Governance Council meeting to be held March 24.
- 3) PS to provide info on EM government officials in preparation for CRTC's meetings with P/Ts, first up with Ontario (key players: QC, ON, AB, BC).
- 4) PS and CRTC to examine NPAS sustainability / funding at next PS/CRTC quarterly meeting, look at work plan and have a discussion, including risk assessment. PS to set out path / roadmap; and articulate roles and responsibilities. Discuss what SOREM should task to PAWG.
- 5) POR and handset testing CRTC finalizing POR questionnaire (roll out after May 2020 alerting test); CRTC to share POR results with PAWG (P/Ts).
- 6) Following CRTC handset testing CRTC will look at options with ISED CRC on how to standardize device features.
- 7) PS to provide updates about accessibility initiatives and official languages priorities.
