To whom it may concern,

On August 3, 2023, we submitted a FOIA request on behalf of our client, Mr. David Kezerashvili, through the SecureRelease Portal. Please see enclosed, documentation evidencing submission of the request.

In our request, we sought copies of all documents, statements and related materials (electronic and physical) associated with the inadmissibility / ineligibility determination made by U.S. Customs and Border Protection on May 1, 2023 pursuant to INA § 212(a)(2)(I). Since then, we have not received **any** correspondence confirming receipt of our request - written or electronic.

Upon checking the status of our FOIA request through the SecureRelease Portal, we note that the request status is reflected as "Initial Determination." Pursuant to 5 USC § 552(a)(6)(A), we understand this to mean that the agency has made a determination as to whether to comply with our request. 


