INCIDENT DETAILS:

On 03/02/3024 at approximately 1703 hours, a PSP Bedford Trooper was conducting routine patrol when a vehicle approached the marked state police vehicle at a high rate of speed.

A traffic stop was conducted on the vehicle. While the vehicle was pulled over, the operator fled on foot into a nearby wooded area. After a short foot pursuit, the operator was taken into custody. The operator was covered in blood and was acting erratically. The operator refused to identify himself and the odor of alcoholic beverage was coming from him breath.

The male was transported to UPMC Bedford to be cleared by medical staff. While at the hospital, contact was attempted with the registered owner of the vehicle in New Jersey. At that time, Gloucester Township Police Department provided a subjects name and date of birth to see if it was the operator of the vehicle. The operator matched the name and date of birth given by Gloucester Township Police Department.

The operator was a lead suspect in a homicide that occurred earlier in the morning. Gloucester Township Police Department provided a homicide warrant for the operator.

PSP Bedford is currently investigating along with Gloucester Township Police Department.

In the interest of transparency, it is the policy of PSP to disseminate information regarding incidents which are likely to generate significant interest among the public and media in a timely manner. While we make every effort to ensure the information is accurate to the best of our knowledge and belief, incidents are often fluid and rapidly evolving.
