1 AMEND House Bill No. 2446, Page 2, Section 324.1905, Lines 30-37, by deleting all of said lines and
2 inserting in lieu thereof the following"

3
4 "(a) Care and procedures incident thereto of superficial lacerations, lesions, or abrasions
5 and the removal of foreign bodies located in superficial structures, not to include the eye;

6 (b) The use of antiseptics and topical or local anesthetics in connection with the procedure
7 described in paragraph (a) of this subdivision;

8 (c) Intramuscular, intravenous, subcutaneous, and intradermal injections of substances;

9 (d) Trigger point therapy;

10 (e) Noninvasive and minimally invasive aesthetic lasers that cannot be used for major surgeries
11 or cutting;

12 (f) Dermal stimulation; and

13 (g) Allergy testing.

14
15 The definition of "minor office procedures" does not include general anesthetics or surgery;"; and

17 Further amend said bill, page, and section, Lines 47-48, by deleting all of said lines and inserting in lieu
18 thereof the following:

20 "nondiagnostic ultrasound, cold laser, colon hydrotherapy, soft tissue therapy, therapeutic exercise, and
21 treatments taught in"; and

23 Further amend said bill, Page 9, Section 324.1940, Lines 18-19, by deleting all of said lines and inserting in
24 lieu thereof the following:

26 "(a) All legend drugs and over-the-counter drugs;

27 (b) Controlled substances within Schedules III, IV, and V of section 195.017, excluding all
28 benzodiazepines, opioids, and opioid derivatives; and

29 (c) Durable medical equipment and devices;"; and

31 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references accordingly.

5 a. Be accredited or have achieved candidacy status for accreditation by the
6 Council on Naturopathic Medical Education or an equivalent federally recognized
7 accrediting body for naturopathic medical programs also recognized by the board; or

8 b. Be a proprietary school or part of a proprietary school that has received a certificate of
9 approval from the coordinating board for higher education under the provisions of 173.600 to
10 173.619; and"; and
