18 ECS1 Public Safety how can I help you?

19  
20 C1 Hey, I'm not sure if you can help me or not (Inaudible). We just moved  
21 last month from Pennsylvania, I have a job in Augusta for the summer  
22 and I'm staying at a boarding house in Pittston, and I was given  
23 twenty-four (24) hour notice to get out after they gave me a written  
24 notice on the tenth (10<sup>th</sup>) saying please be out by September 30<sup>th</sup> we're  
25 closing the house early. And then last night they gave me twenty-four  
26 (24) hours to get out. But I have nowhere to go I called the homeless  
27 shelters, (Inaudible) because they (Inaudible) for kicking me out. And  
28 I just don't know where to turn, I called 211 they gave me your number.

29  
30 ECS1 What's the address?

31  
32 C1 [REDACTED] in Pittston.

33  
34 ECS1 And what's your last name?

35  
36 C1 My last name is [REDACTED], [REDACTED].

37  
38 ECS1 And your first name?

39  
40 C1 [REDACTED], [REDACTED].

41  
42 ECS1 And what's your date of birth for the office records only?

43  
44 C1 [REDACTED].

45  
46 ECS1 And a phone number that we can reach you at?

47  
48 C1 [REDACTED]-[REDACTED]-[REDACTED].

49  
50 ECS1 They said you had to be out by September 30<sup>th</sup>?

51  
52 C1 Yes. They gave us a note that says: We'll be closing the house on  
53 October 1<sup>st</sup> rather than the 31<sup>st</sup>. You need to be moved out by September  
54 30<sup>th</sup>. This notice will give you enough time to find a place.  
55 (Inaudible) for work, and I needed temporary housing until I found a  
56 place, and that's why I stayed here. And then last night they said I

57 needed to be out by Sunday, and I have nowhere to go. And I don't  
58 think it's legal for them to just give me twenty-four (24) hour notice  
59 to be out. And then I have in writing that they gave me until  
60 September 30<sup>th</sup>.  
61  
62 I think one of the issues is that they're probably running an illegal  
63 boarding house which I didn't know when I moved up here, and I wanted  
64 to pay in check and then they, just this past week after getting the  
65 written notice that they would no longer be taking a check but they  
66 would accept payment in cash. And so there's something not right here.  
67 And they said I'm the only one that pays by check so, and for some  
68 reason he said because I wanted to pay with a check, now I'm out.  
69  
70 ECS1 All right, we'll let the officer know and we'll have him contact you,  
71 okay?  
72  
73 C1 All right, thank you.  
74  
75 ECS1 You're welcome.  
76  
77 C1 All right, bye.

85 ECS2 Public Safety, how can I help you?  
86  
87 C1 Hi, I was just with Trooper Allen but he got called on another call.  
88 He told me that my - we're having issues with my landlord, he told me  
89 that my landlord is willing to talk to me that's it's safe to come back  
90 over here to ask him (Inaudible) but he was wrong. I got to the house  
91 the landlord started yelling so I just quickly got back in my car. And  
92 I asked him, I said, I don't feel safe going over there but he said  
93 that the guy said that it would be okay, but it's obviously not.  
94  
95 ECS2 Okay, I will let him know.  
96  
97 C1 All right, so.  
98  
99 ECS2 Are you still there or where are you?  
100  
101 C1 I'm in the parking lot but I'm getting ready - I didn't go back because  
102 he starts pitching a fit.  
103  
104 ECS2 So what's the name of the gas station?  
105  
106 C1 It's like a general store on East Pittston Road. And he was just  
107 sitting there yelling, because (Inaudible) the house (Inaudible).  
108 He acts all nice and sweet when the cop is here and as soon as he  
109 leaves. It's the Village General Store is the name of the store.  
110  
111 ECS2 You said a Village Store?  
112

113 C1 Yeah.  
114  
115 ECS2 And what kind of a car are you in?  
116  
117 C1 It's a black Hyundai Accent. And then we were discussing - he was just  
118 here a few minutes ago.  
119  
120 ECS2 Okay well I'll let him know.  
121  
122 C1 All right, thanks.  
123  
124 ECS2 Thank you.  
125  
126 C1 All right, bye.  
127

131 ECS3 Public Safety.  
132  
133 C1 Hi, I called a couple times; Trooper Allen was out here with me

139 C1 When the trooper was here he went over and talked to the landlord by

153 ECS3 I'll have him get in contact with you, okay?

165 ECS3 Public Safety.  
166  
167 C1 Hi, I called a couple times, Trooper Allen was out here with me

171 himself and said that the landlord was waiting (Inaudible)and stuff and

174 ECS3 Okay, what is your name?

176 C1 My name is [REDACTED] [REDACTED]. And my cat is in there and I do want to get  
177 her out.

179 ECS3 What's your phone number [REDACTED]?

181 C1 [REDACTED]-[REDACTED]-[REDACTED].

183 ECS3 All right, I'll have him get in contact with you, okay?  
184  
185 C1 All right, thank you.

187 ECS3 You're welcome.

189 C1 Bye.

194 ECS2 Public Safety.  
195  
196 C1 Hi, I've called so many times today; my name is [REDACTED] [REDACTED].  
197 Trooper Allen (Inaudible).  
198  
199 ECS2 Was it Seth Allen that you spoke with?  
200  
201 C1 Yes.  
202  
203 ECS2 Yeah he's working until 4:00.  
204  
205 C1 Could you ask him to give me a call back?  
206  
207 ECS2 Okay, what was your name again?  
208  
209 C1 [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED].  
210  
211 ECS2 Okay. (Inaudible) [REDACTED]?  
212  
213 C1 [REDACTED]-[REDACTED]-[REDACTED].  
214  
215 ECS2 [REDACTED]-[REDACTED]?  
216  
217 C1 Yes.  
218  
219 ECS2 Okay, I will have him call you.  
220  
221 C1 Okay thanks.

226 ECS2 Public Safety.  
227  
228 C1 Hi, sorry to call again - this is [REDACTED] [REDACTED], I was waiting for a  
229 call back from Trooper Allen.  
230  
231 ECS2 Okay. He hasn't called you back since the last time?  
232  
233 C1 No.  
234  
235 ECS2 Okay, so I'll just put a bug in his ear and just let him know that I  
236 sent him a message.  
237  
238 C1 All right, thanks.  
239  
240 ECS2 Bye.  
241  
242 AV August 15, 2015

245 ECS4 Public Safety.  
246  
247 C1 Hi, I called earlier - I'm having issues with my landlord.  
248  
249 ECS4 Okay.  
250  
251 C1 I'm just wondering (Inaudible). I went to pay for next week and they  
252 said you have to get out with no notice at all, and, he's been  
253 harassing us, we got back into our room, and they're banging on the  
254 door telling us we have three (3) hours to get out. Can they legally  
255 force us out when we have the money to pay the rent and they didn't  
256 give us proper notice?  
257  
258 ECS4 You don't have a lease signed or anything do you?  
259  
260 C1 No but everything that I've read online (Inaudible) that they need to  
261 give a notice (Inaudible).  
262  
263 ECS4 Okay, where do you live?  
264  
265 C1 It's at [REDACTED]. Trying to find (Inaudible) can't find  
266 anything (Inaudible).  
267  
268 ECS4 Uh-huh.  
269  
270 C1 Because, they gave us literally no notice.  
271  
272 ECS4 Okay, its [REDACTED], what was the address?  
273  
274 C1 [REDACTED] in Pittston, Maine.  
275  
276 ECS4 And what is your name?  
277  
278 C1 My name is [REDACTED] [REDACTED]. We were dealing with Trooper Allen earlier,  
279 and he said there was nothing he could do because it was a civil  
280 matter.  
281

282 ECS4 Okay.  
283  
284 C1 So can they just break the door down and throw us out physically - and  
285 they didn't follow any of the procedures, there's none.  
286  
287 ECS4 Okay, so the trooper told you he couldn't help you?  
288  
289 C1 He just said because it's a civil matter, that there's no one that can  
290 help with civil matters until Monday. And we don't know what to do, we  
291 were just going to come back in here and grab a few things but we have  
292 nowhere to go.  
293  
294 ECS4 Okay, if the trooper told you there's nothing he could do - the only  
295 thing else I could do is have another trooper to call you and they're  
296 going to tell you the same thing.  
297  
298 C1 Is there a (Inaudible)? Is there literally anyone that can protect us  
299 and help us because I have a feeling these people are going to hurt us.  
300  
301 ECS4 You think they're going to hurt you?  
302  
303 C1 We were already threatened by the husband.  
304  
305 ECS4 Okay, did you tell this to Trooper Allen?  
306  
307 C1 Yes.  
308  
309 ECS4 And he said?  
310  
311 C1 And he said it's a civil matter.  
312  
313 ECS4 Okay, if that's what he said then there's nothing else I can do either.  
314  
315 C1 So do you actually have to be physically assaulted before you can do  
316 anything?  
317  
318 ECS4 Of course you don't ma'am, of course you don't. But I mean if this has  
319 been handled by a trooper -  
320  
321 C1 Because he wasn't screaming and (Inaudible) I asked him if he could  
322 come over to the house with me where I can safely get in (Inaudible).  
323  
324 ECS4 Okay.  
325  
326 C1 So I came over to try and get in by myself and the landlord was  
327 screaming at me; and I couldn't get in and then Trooper Allen did call  
328 and say that they had to let us in, and they said they were only  
329 letting us in to get our stuff.  
330  
331 ECS4 Okay.  
332  
333 C1 But we're paid through till tomorrow, and plus they didn't give us any  
334 sort of eviction notice (Inaudible).  
335  
336 ECS4 I will have whoever is working right now, that area, I will have them  
337 call you and see if they (Inaudible)  
338

339 C1 Thank you. Because I mean there has to be someone that can help us.  
340  
341 ECS4 Okay. What's the phone number again?  
342  
343 C1 [REDACTED] - [REDACTED] - [REDACTED] - I mean we just moved up here from Pennsylvania, I've  
344 never been in a situation like this in my entire life. And I have  
345 never met people like this, and I have never been in any other  
346 situation where no one will help.  
347  
348 ECS4 Okay.  
349  
350 C1 I mean I work for the crisis and help (Inaudible) some people will give  
351 people help and now I'm sitting in the street there's no one to help.  
352  
353 ECS4 Okay, let me have somebody call you, okay?  
354  
355 C1 All right.  
356  
357 ECS4 Thanks.  
358  
359 C1 Thank you.  
360  
361  
362 AV August 15, 2015  
363 18:10:00  
364  
365 ECS5 911, what is the address of the emergency?  
366  
367 LSO Hi, this is Lincoln County - I have a caller from [REDACTED]  
368 [REDACTED] in Pittston. This is the female, the tenant that lives there her  
369 boyfriend is the one that was being choked and stabbed the male; he has  
370 run off now. She also had a scuffle with the female landlord, and  
371 she's rather upset and she needs some help as well.  
372  
373 ECS5 Okay. We do have two (2) 911 calls at the same location.  
374  
375 LSO Okay, she's on the line with us but she may have some more information  
376 as far as what her boyfriend was wearing because he ran off.  
377  
378 ECS5 Okay.  
379  
380 LSO Also, she needs to file a report because she was attacked as well.  
381  
382 ECS5 Okay.  
383  
384 LSO And the landlord did take the phone out of her hand as well (Inaudible)  
385 call for help.  
386  
387 ECS5 Okay.  
388  
389 LSO Okay.  
390  
391 ECS5 Hello?  
392  
393 C1 Yes.  
394  
395 ECS5 Hi, what's your name ma'am?



396  
397 C1 My name is [REDACTED] [REDACTED].  
398  
399 ECS5 Okay, and who was stabbed was it your boyfriend?  
400  
401 C1 No, my boyfriend was being choked and he had a pocket knife in his  
402 pocket and when he was being strangled by the landlord he pulled the  
403 knife out and stabbed him and then ran for the door so he could get  
404 away from him.  
405  
406 ECS5 So where is he now?  
407  
408 C1 I don't know because I barricaded myself in the bedroom after I got  
409 away from the female landlord because she said she was going to throw  
410 me down the steps, and she attempted to but I'm like three hundred  
411 (300) pounds so she couldn't do it.  
412  
413 ECS5 Okay.  
414  
415 C1 And so I just really want to get into the room and (Inaudible).  
416  
417 ECS5 Okay, and you're still in the room now ma'am?  
418  
419 C1 Yeah, but I don't know where JEFF is because he just ran to get away  
420 from him because he was trying to kill him.  
421  
422 ECS5 What is JEFF wearing?  
423  
424 C1 He's wearing like a camouflage shorts and a black t-shirt.  
425  
426 ECS5 And describe him to me.  
427  
428 C1 Like 5'10" or 11", about a hundred and seventy (170) pounds, blonde  
429 hair, blue eyes.  
430  
431 ECS5 Would he have driven away in a car?  
432  
433 C1 What?  
434  
435 ECS5 Would he have driven away in a vehicle or anything?  
436  
437 C1 No, I don't think he even had the keys to the car. (Inaudible), then  
438 they come running (Inaudible).  
439  
440 ECS5 Ma'am, how old is he?  
441  
442 C1 JEFF is twenty-eight (28).  
443  
444 ECS5 You said he's twenty-eight (28)?  
445  
446 C1 Yes.  
447  
448 ECS5 Okay the rescue is in route and we have the troopers in route so we'll  
449 let them know what JEFF's wearing, okay?  
450  
451 C1 Okay.  
452

453 ECS5 Does he still have a knife, to your knowledge?  
454  
455 C1 I don't know, but I mean, we've been calling, literally, you can check  
456 the records (Inaudible) we feared for our life because this man is  
457 crazy.  
458  
459 ECS5 Okay, okay.  
460  
461 C1 Trooper Allen (Inaudible) and he said he couldn't do anything to help  
462 because he said it was a civil matter and he left.  
463  
464 ECS5 Ma'am, just stay in the room and don't come out until rescue gets  
465 there, okay?  
466  
467 C1 Okay.  
468  
469 ECS5 Okay, thanks.  
470  
471 C1 Thanks.  
472  
473 AV August 15, 2015  
474 18:21:35  
475  
476 ECS6 911, what is the address of the emergency?  
477  
478 LSO This is the girlfriend from the [REDACTED] incident.  
479  
480 ECS6 Okay.  
481  
482 LSO Go ahead ma'am.  
483  
484 ECS6 Hello?  
485  
486 C1 Hi, how long is it going to be because I don't even know if JEFF is  
487 still alive (Inaudible) or out or not.  
488  
489 ECS6 Ma'am, ma'am.  
490  
491 C1 Yes.  
492  
493 ECS6 Calm down. Are you able to look out the window and see the cruiser  
494 outside?  
495  
496 C1 (Inaudible)  
497  
498 ECS6 Okay.  
499  
500 C1 All right, thank you.  
501  
502 ECS6 You're welcome.  
503  
504 C1 All right, bye.
