Dear Chiara Eisner, This is an interim response to your September 8, 2023, Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request. You requested the following two excel spreadsheets, "EXPORT Full Census 09-04-21" and "EXPORT Full Census 10-22-21," from the Pomona Fairplex Emergency Intake Site, with the exception of personally-identifiable information.

As a result of my review of your request for expedited processing, I have determined that your request for expedited processing meets the requirements under the FOIA and is granted. The FOIA requires that an agency expedite processing of a request only when the requester demonstrates a "compelling need." The subject matter of your request demonstrates that there is an "urgency to inform the public concerning actual or alleged Federal activity."
