From OHOV member, Kevon Martis: I know everyone is anxious to get going so I thought I would share an update on what's going on at OHOV.

Our team remains committed to maintaining local control for wind and solar projects. I have received many calls and messages asking about what can be done and what are our next steps. I can assure you we are in the process of organizing and collaborating on all our options to ensure the voice of voters is heard loud and clear.

Our options are boiling down to being a very expensive statewide approach. Overall, it will be seven figures expensive. It will require us to donate in a way we have never done before and to work harder than ever before in every part of the state. But I know this community is dedicated to this cause and if we join hands and hit it hard, we can take back control of our own land use.

We are not ready to make an official announcement as the legal details continue to be worked out, but funds are needed to even continue this process and ensure we are organized for success.

What I can tell you:

- We have retained a top law firm with an incredible record of working on these efforts
- We will be maintaining our PR team and lobby team for the next step in this
 process and they will organize, execute and provide logistics to ensure a
 streamlined effort along with coalition building to grow our support through a
 variety of voices

- We are receiving information, proposals, and identified timelines from any and all potential vendors to ensure we have every base covered and we can achieve our goals efficiently and as cost-effectively as possible
- Our goal is to make an official announcement next month

Our most immediate need is funding to get off the ground. Like I said, this is an expensive effort, and we need the funds to finalize the plans, make the announcement, and launch the effort in a way that will spearhead our momentum for this project. We need a minimum of \$100,000 to secure our partners and finalize the details of the plan. Once we are able to launch the effort, we will be soliciting donations from a variety of individuals, businesses and coalition members to help us reach our seven figure goals. But this initial seed money of \$100,000 is the first step in the process.







Ballot Proposal Prepped To Repeal New Energy Siting Law

An initiative petition to repeal the just-enacted laws which move siting authority for large-scale solar and wind energy projects to the Public Service Commission is in the works.

On Wednesday, paperwork was filed with the Bureau of Elections creating a new ballot question committee, Citizens for Local Choice. The treasurer of the committee is Roger Johnson, a member of the Deerfield Township Planning Commission in Lenawee County. Johnson has been active with the Our Home Our Voice organization that has led the fight to preserve local control on several issues, including siting authority for large scale renewable energy projects.

HB 5120 and HB 5121, signed by Governor Gretchen Whitmer in November, take effect February 13. They greatly restrict the ability of local governments, mainly townships, to regulate and block utility-scale solar and wind projects. Should a local government block a project or adopt an ordinance with tougher regulations than the state, the energy company seeking the project could go to the PSC to obtain approval.

Townships, agriculture interests and many residents have slammed the legislation as an affront to local control. Supporters, however, have said needed energy projects are getting blocked for purely political reasons.

Contacted Friday, Johnson said he could not say much yet about what the Citizens for Local choice group plans.

"We can't talk about it yet," he said. "Everything's in the hands of the attorneys. The whole issue of direction, and what's it's for ... we hope to make a public release in a week or two on what we are and who we are and what we formed the group for. But until everything's locked down with the legal requirements, we have to say just check back with us."

One source tracking the topic said the drafting of initiative petition language is in its final stages.

A referendum has been ruled out, the source said. A referendum would require the fewest signatures — at least 223,099 valid signatures from registered voters — but they would have to be collected by February 13, and there is not enough time.




