"County Settlement Allocation Report (aka the County Settlement Allocation Reporting form) and any amendments, attachments, or revisions filed with the Pennsylvania Opioid Misuse and Addiction Abatement Trust ahead of the March 15, 2024 deadline. For clarity, I am requesting the final reports/submissions due by March 15. See attachments for full description of request."
