

Re:	TX-34 Polling Update – Race is a Dead Heat

Methodology

1892 conducted a poll of n400 likely voters for the 2024 General Election in Texas' 34^{th} congressional district. The poll was conducted from April 11-13 and has a ±4.9% margin-oferror. Responses were 75% cells and 25% landline, with interviews conducted in English and Spanish.


State of the Race

1. **Toss-up:** Incumbent Democrat Vicente Gonzalez's lead over Republican Mayra Flores is within the margin-of-error at 48-45%.



- 2. **Swing Voters:** Undecideds are poised to break for Mayra Flores. Undecideds are voting for Trump by +12%, dislike Joe Biden by -12%, and are voting for a Republican on the generic Congressional ballot by +24%.
- 3. **Winning Environment:** Inflation is the top issue among Undecideds (57%), Independents (54%), and Moderates (41%). Flores is already winning voters who list inflation as their top issue on both open-end and closed-end issues questions (+2% and +3%, respectively).

Securing the border is the second most important issue in the district. Importantly, immigration is also a winning issue with the middle. By 51%-36% voters favor "Trump's border policies" over "Biden's border policies." Independents favor Trump's policies by +10%. Among the voters who prefer Trump's border policies, Flores leads the ballot +64%.
