





Marysville Police Department Officer Wiggins #0195 Case # 2022-00022462 Supplemental Report

I, Officer Wiggins #0195, am a commissioned police officer in the State of Washington, County of Snohomish and employed by the City of Marysville. On the above date and time, my assignment was as a patrol officer. I was wearing an authorized Marysville Police Department patrol uniform. I was driving in a Marysville Police Department patrol vehicle equipped with emergency lights, and siren. I am equipped with a body worn camera that was on and activated during this event. All video was uploaded to Evidence.com.

On Saturday May 14 at approximately 05:00 hours I responded as a backing officer to a call at the Smokey Point Behavioral Hospital at 3955 156th ST NE. Also on scene were Sergeant Lawrenson, Officers Adams, and, my FTO Officer Brevig as well as Custody Officer Buell. The hospital had reported that a patient, Martinez, Ruben DOB 6-25-1985 had assaulted one of the nurses.

The staff showed us where Martinez was located. Officer Adams, Officer Buell and I removed the four point soft restraints that the hospital had put him in. We then placed Martinez in handcuffs; he initially complained about the handcuff tightness and we adjusted them for him. Martinez was cooperative and did not resist. Officer Buell brought the WRAP with him and he and I sat Martinez up to place him in the WRAP. We then brought him off of where he had been restrained and placed him onto the ground in order to put him into the rest of the WRAP. We placed him on his knees and then on his stomach and then on his side in order to place the WRAP on him properly. We were able to place the WRAP on Martinez without incident as he offered no resistance throughout the entire time that we were placing him in the WRAP. Once Martinez was fully in the WRAP I lifted him into a wheelchair.

We wheeled Martinez out of the hospital and he was calm and cooperative the entire time. Officer Buell then transported him the Snohomish County Jail.

I waited to collected statements from the witnesses.

Nothing further.

AUTHORITY:

I, Nicholas Buell, am a Custody Officer with a limited commission by the City of Marysville, WA.

ASSIGNMENT:

- I am currently assigned to the Detention Division of the Marysville Police Dept.
- During this incident, I was wearing an approved Custody Officer uniform, including department patches, badge and Custody insignia.
- On the above date, I was working within the Marysville Jail located at 1635 Grove Street within the city limits of Marysville, Snohomish County, Washington.

ELEMENTS OF CRIME/INCIDENT:

At approximately 0310 hours, an ASLTP call came out from the Smokey Point Behavioral Hospital. A patient had been damaging furniture and throwing it at staff members. Hospital staff struggled with him but were eventually able to secure and distance themselves from him. Approximately one and a half hours later the staff called back and wished to press charges on Ruben for assault in the 3rd degree on a staff member.

Patrol requested assistance from jail staff for the use of our WRAP device as well as to facilitate a transport. I dispatched myself to the call location and arrived on scene at approximately 0445. I met with Patrol Officers and hospital staff at the entrance to the building where I was informed that Ruben had been physically assaultive, damaging property, and making verbal threats to kill. I was also informed that Ruben was of slightly large stature and currently restrained to a bed. With this information I decided it was best to make use of the WRAP device. I have voluntarily been placed into the WRAP in previous training and know from experience that the device is not painful, but is good at restricting excessive body movement. This is especially useful for subjects who are physically resisting or attempting self-harm.

At this time I activated my body-worn camera and we all made our way to the room that Ruben was located. As we entered the room I could see that Ruben was laying on a wooden bed with both wrists and both ankles out to his sides and individually restrained. Ruben voiced his frustration with us as we transferred him from the bed restraints and into the WRAP, but was compliant. We used a wheel chair that the hospital staff provided us so that we could easily

relocate Ruben out to the parking lot into my transport vehicle. I and two other officers carefully placed him into the back seat where I fastened a seat belt around him.

From Smokey Point Behavioral I transported Ruben to the Snohomish County jail where I had deputies assist me in the sally port. We were able to get him through their medical portion and safely remove him from the WRAP device where he was then placed in their custody without further incident.
