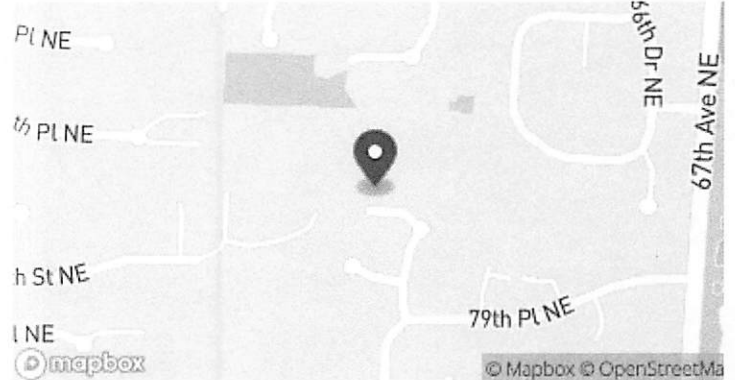

On 05/01/22 at approximately 0310 hrs, Officer Buell and I were called out to the above address. At approximately 0318 hrs, wrap application was used on a combative and resistive male. The male was safely secured in our vehicle and transported to the Snohomish County Jail.

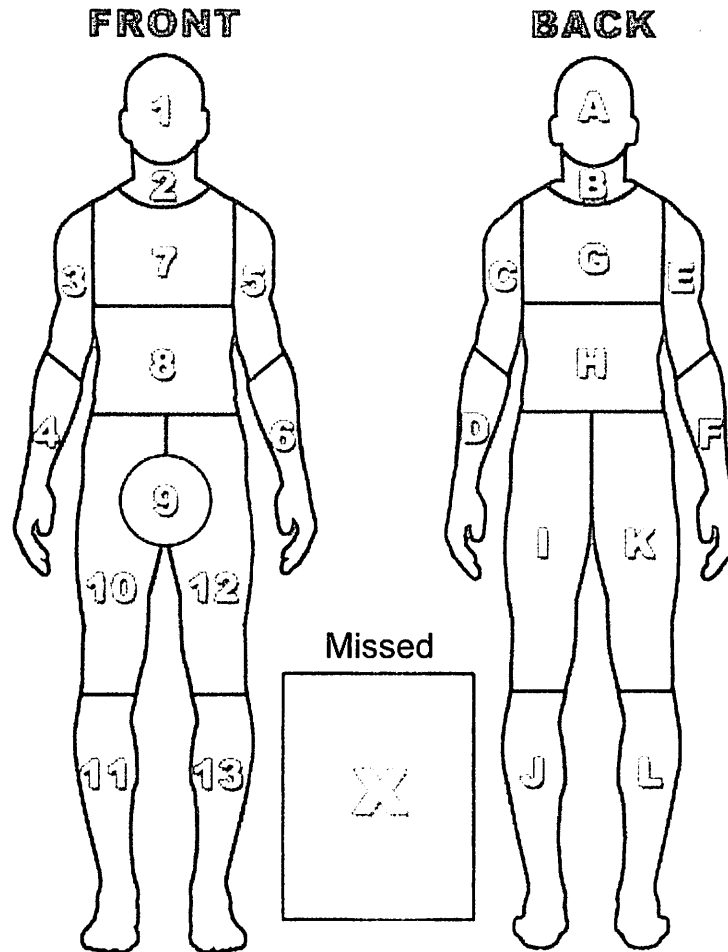

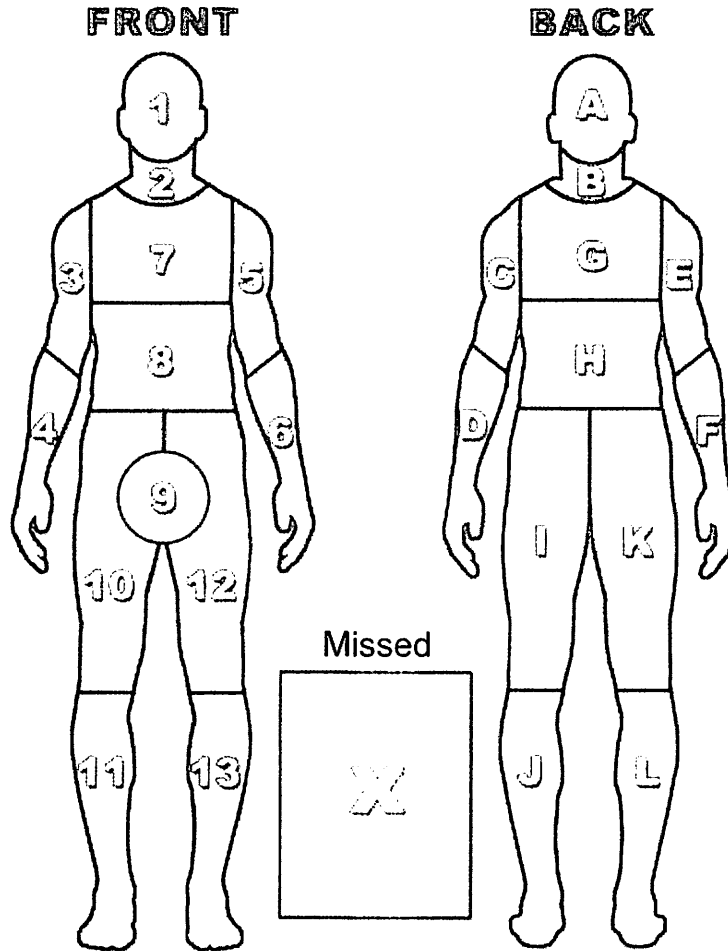

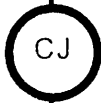

**AUTHORITY:**

I, Nicholas Buell, am a Custody Officer with a limited commission by the City of Marysville, WA.

**ASSIGNMENT:**

- I am currently assigned to the Detention Division of the Marysville Police Dept.
- During this incident, I was wearing an approved Custody Officer uniform, including department patches, badge and Custody insignia.
- On the above date, I was working within the Marysville Jail located at 1635 Grove Street within the city limits of Marysville, Snohomish County, Washington.

**ELEMENTS OF CRIME/INCIDENT:**

At approximately 0245 on 05/01/2022, Patrol Officers were dispatched to a DVV call. After Patrol was on scene, the male half was described by Patrol Officers as "irate", and at approximately 0305 the subject began fighting with officers. Patrol was able to get Jesus into handcuffs but requested assistance from Custody for transport.

Officer Lee and I responded to the location with our Ford Explorer transport vehicle which also contains a WRAP device in the trunk for physically uncooperative subjects. At approximately 0312, Officer Lee and I arrived at the scene. I observed Jesus laying stomach down in a patch of grass wearing handcuffs and two officers keeping him in the prone position until we arrived. Sergeant Goolsby informed us that Jesus's behavior was very up and down and had been attempting to hit his own head on the ground. I know Sergeant Goolsby has prior experience with the WRAP and asked him if he thought Jesus's behavior warranted the use of the device, and he said yes. I have voluntarily been placed into the WRAP in previous training and know from experience that the device is not painful, but is good at restricting excessive body movement. This is especially useful for subjects who are physically resisting or attempting self-harm.

Officer Lee and I went to retrieve the WRAP from our transport vehicle which is the same time we activated our body-worn cameras. When returning to Jesus's location, he was now placed in a seated position. While appearing to be cooperative, the decision to proceed with the application of the WRAP was still suitable as Jesus's behavior was unpredictable and



this would be the best course of action to preserve his safety as well as ours. In order to place Jesus in the WRAP, we would need to again place him on his stomach in the prone position, which we did. While applying the device, Jesus was stiff but not resisting. He was very emotional and vocal but only speaking in Spanish. At a couple different points he would also yell out.

Once Jesus was fully placed in the WRAP, I and two other officers carried him to our transport vehicle and placed him in the back seat. From there Officer Lee and I transported him to the Snohomish County Jail. I advised Dispatch that we would need assistance from the Corrections Deputies upon arrival. Jesus was mostly quiet during the drive. We would periodically ask him if he was doing okay and he would respond with "I am okay". County Deputies met us in the sally port where I gave them a brief of the situation. A Sergeant at the Snohomish County Jail was able to communicate with Jesus in Spanish which was able to calm him down enough to get him through his intake questions and out of the WRAP. Snohomish County then took Jesus into their custody with no further incident.
