1.	Behind the Kurdish Defensive Line.
	a. <u>Terrorism</u> . Overall, DAESH maintains a strong intent to conduct terrorist attacks against population centers such as Erbil, Kirkuk, and Sulaymaniyah; however, their capability to execut successful attacks remain largely mitigated by the efficiency of Kurdish security forces. While ther is low popular support for DAESH throughout Iraqi Kurdistan, Kirkuk remains the most vulnerable to terrorist attacks. This is in large part owing to DAESH's ability to blend in with the mixed Arab/Kurd population and due to the porous border in the area.
	b. On 21 Oct 16, DAESH conducted coordinated simultaneous attacks within Kirkuk cit against critical infrastructure, police facilities, hotels and a government building.

2. Mosul use of	Mosul. From mid-October to early November, DAESH has enhanced its defensive preparations is including tunnels and trenches around the perimeter of the city.
