SITUATION

1. Behind the Kurdish Defensive Line. [REDACTED]

a. Terrorism. Overall, DAESH maintains a strong intent to conduct terrorist attacks against population centers such as Erbil, Kirkuk, and Sulaymaniyah; however, their capability to execute successful attacks remain largely mitigated by the efficiency of Kurdish security forces. While there is low popular support for DAESH throughout Iraqi Kurdistan, Kirkuk remains the most vulnerable to terrorist attacks. This is in large part owing to DAESH's ability to blend in with the mixed Arab/Kurd population and due to the porous border in the area. [REDACTED]

b. On 21 Oct 16, DAESH conducted coordinated simultaneous attacks within Kirkuk city against critical infrastructure, police facilities, hotels and a government building. [REDACTED]

2. Mosul. From mid-October to early November, DAESH has enhanced its defensive preparations in Mosul including tunnels and trenches around the perimeter of the city. The group intends on combining the use of human shields, IEDs, snipers, suicide bombers and deception measures including ISF uniforms. [REDACTED]

3. Although indications show DAESH is almost certain it will lose Mosul, reporting suggests the group intends on maintaining a presence despite the loss. [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] These sympathizers excluded any DAESH members who had formally pledged loyalty (bayyat) to the group or were involved in its activities in order to allow them to remain unnoticed by security forces.
