Dear Mr. Olson:

The purpose of this letter is to advise you of the status of your pending Freedom of Information/Privacy Acts (FOIPA) request at the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI). Currently, the FBI is searching for, retrieving, scanning, and evaluating files that may be responsive to the FOIPA. Many factors may contribute to the time required to process your request; however, the greatest single factor is the number of documents associated with your request.

Once your files have been evaluated as potentially responsive, your request will be forwarded to the "perfected backlog," where your request will wait for assignment to an analyst.

You have the opportunity to reduce the scope of your request; this will accelerate the process and could potentially place your request in a smaller processing queue. This may also reduce search and duplication costs and allow for a more timely receipt of your information.

Please advise in writing if you would like to discuss reducing the scope of your request. The status of newly assigned requests may not be available until the next weekly update. If the FOIPA has been closed, the notice will indicate that appropriate correspondence has been mailed to the address on file.
