**Faculty petition urging for constructive dialogue with peaceful protestors**

We, the undersigned faculty, agree with President Garber's statement that disagreements are most effectively addressed through candid, constructive dialogue. We are concerned that the university has yet to meet with the students to hear their concerns. Instead, the administration has issued escalating threats of punitive disciplinary action, the severity of which the university has not seen in decades. We urge the administration to meet and engage in meaningful dialogue with peacefully protesting students.
