**FINAL JUDGMENT AND  
ORDER**

The Attorney Discipline Probable Cause Committee, having reviewed the Agreement for Discipline by Consent under Rule 57(a)(3)(A), Ariz. R. Sup. Ct., accepts the parties' proposed agreement by a vote of 5-2-2<sup>1</sup>.

Accordingly:

**IT IS ORDERED** that Respondent, Alexander Kolodin, is admonished for his conduct in violation of the Arizona Rules of Professional Conduct, E.R. 3.1 and E.R. 8.4(d), as outlined in the consent documents.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that Respondent is placed on probation for eighteen months, with the possibility of early termination after one year if all the terms and conditions of probation are satisfied. The terms of probation are:

1.CLE: In addition to annual MCLE requirements, Respondent shall complete the following Continuing Legal Education ("CLE") programs within 18 months from the date of service of the Order accepting this consent agreement:

- a. Avoiding Ethical Pitfalls, JA323/J2107
- b. Ethics Café Series: ER3.4 – Fairness to Opposing Party and Counsel, JA297
- c. Ethics Café: ER 3.3 – Candor Towards Tribunal, JA257
- d. Ethics Café: ER 3.1 Meritorious Claims and Contentions, JA232
- e. Ethic Issues for the 21<sup>st</sup> Century Lawyer, J2289/MP1213

Respondent shall provide the State Bar Compliance Monitor with evidence of completion of the programs by providing a copy of handwritten notes and certificate of completion. Respondent shall contact the Compliance Monitor at 602-340-7258 to arrange to submit this evidence. Respondent will be responsible for the cost of the CLE.

2. Respondent shall commit no further violations of the Rules of Professional Conduct.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that Respondent pay the costs and expenses of the State Bar of Arizona in the amount of \$ 2696.15, within 30 days from the date of service of this Order.
