Thanks for the update Derek.

Regarding the budget, we are having a meeting today actually to address many of these sustainability funding plans. The Spokane County ARPA award for the Real-Time Crime Center was \$3,997,000. This excludes construction, and the County has committed \$350,000 in capital construction improvements of the Public Safety Building space. Additionally, the City of Spokane Valley secured \$850,000 of ARPA funds that we are working with them for collaboration in the RTCC for law enforcement technology improvements.

I expect our figures to change as we update the budget figures, but I am estimating a total of \$750,000 of annual costs for continued part-time operation of the RTCC from 2027 and beyond. Our planning and strategies currently underway are aimed at mitigating that recurring cost figure. Through LE contracts with the City of Spokane Valley, and other independent governments in the county, we will work on negotiating shared funding. We are also looking at several grants, subscriptions, or other relevant current revenue sources. Everything reasonable and applicable is currently being considered, but no funds are committed after 2026 yet.

And will taxpayers likely have to pay whatever amount isn't covered by additional grants or federal dollars?

One of the many things Russ and I talked about in our meeting today was the mountaintop wireless network. The brand of wireless equipment we would be using is Tarana. On Friday I'll be meeting with Russ and an engineer from Tarana to discuss some details of what the network would look like and to get some coverage maps generated. Russ has all the equipment in stock, so once we get a plan together, things could potentially move as fast as we want them to.

One of the things he suggested we consider is a Tarana certification class that his company is putting on in October. The class would provide all of the knowledge needed to deploy, troubleshoot, and maintain the wireless network infrastructure. If we are going to pull the trigger on this wireless network, it would probably be a good idea for a representative from IT and myself, in the absence of a RTCC IT manager, to go through this training.

I'll probably be sending follow-up emails on several of the other topics we discussed, as I have the brainpower to digest them!

Installation of the Gateway device is a one-time \$500 fee. Subscription is \$300/yr for up to eight cameras. I'll get the fee schedule for more cameras.

Currently, Flock is not charging our agency for the installations or subscriptions because we are an early adopter "testing agency" for the technology and 3<sup>rd</sup> party camera sharing.

At some point these costs will kick-in, and I am discussing that with them currently. We will need to discuss the process for determining who we cover the costs for, and who pays for their own connections once charges start.
