Thanks for the update Derek.

Regarding the budget, we are having a meeting today actually to address many of these sustainability funding plans. The Spokane County ARPA award for the Real-Time Crime Center was \$3,997,000. This excludes construction, and the County has committed \$350,000 in capital construction improvements of the Public Safety Building space. Additionally, the City of Spokane Valley secured \$850,000 of ARPA funds that we are working with them for collaboration in the RTCC for law enforcement technology improvements.

I expect our figures to change as we update the budget figures, but I am estimating a total of \$750,000 of annual costs for continued part-time operation of the RTCC from 2027 and beyond. Our planning and strategies currently underway are aimed at mitigating that recurring cost figure. Through LE contracts with the City of Spokane Valley, and other independent governments in the county, we will work on negotiating shared funding. We are also looking at several grants, subscriptions, or other relevant current revenue sources. Everything reasonable and applicable is currently being considered, but no funds are committed after 2026 yet.
