On consideration of the Emergency Motion for Stay Pending Appeal filed by State of Alaska, Department of Education & Early Development and Deena Bishop on 5/6/2024, the Response filed by Intervenor-Appellants Andrea Morceri, Theresa Brooks, and Brandy Pennington on 5/13/2024, and the Opposition filed by Appellees Edward Alexander, Josh Andrews, Shelby Beck Andrews, and Carey Carpenter on 5/13/2024,

IT IS ORDERED: The motion for a stay pending appeal is **DENIED**. The stay through 6/30/2024 previously entered by the trial court remains in effect.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: This appeal and the related appeal, S-19113, filed by the Intervenor-Appellants on 5/15/2025 are consolidated for purposes of briefing, argument, and consideration. The record on appeal was distributed to the parties on 5/10/2024; therefore, no separate Opening Notice will issue.

These consolidated appeals will be heard on an expedited timeline, as follows:

Opening Briefs Due:	May 28, 2024
Responsive Briefs Due:	June 10, 2024
Reply Briefs Due:	June 17, 2024
Oral Argument:	June 27, 2024 at 10:00AM.

Initial briefs under Appellate Rule 212(a)(1) are not required. Instead, the briefs should be submitted in printed and bound format on the above due dates. **No extensions of time will be permitted**. The covers do not need the Clerk's signature, but should follow the usual convention for colors (Ivory – Blue – Green, and Pink for excerpts). The Clerk's Office requires ten (10) printed copies of briefs and eight (8) printed copies of excerpts, if any, as well as an electronic PDF version emailed to pleadings@akcourts.gov.

Oral argument will be conducted in person, in Anchorage, unless otherwise announced. Oral arguments conducted before the Alaska Supreme Court are livestreamed on KTOO at ktoo.org/gavel, and are archived for later viewing at the same location.
