Current Situation:

Severe storms with large hail and high winds impacted the City of Dallas. Currently, the city is receiving many calls for service related to downed trees, blocked roadways, and downed power lines. There are a large number of people in the city without power due to the storms. Oncor is working on restoring power, estimates that a majority of outages will be restored by Friday, but several heavily damaged areas may not be restored until Saturday.

- The focus today will be addressing the city's mass care strategy and identifying unmet needs.
- A virtual press conference is scheduled for 11am this morning.
- OCC two WIC clinics are closed today due to power outages. All Community Centers are open.
