(Priority Matter Under NRS 298.109(3))

**Arbitration Exemption: Declaratory and
Injunctive Relief**

18 Plaintiffs Uwe Rockenfeller and Francisco Morales ("Plaintiffs") bring this complaint for
19 declaratory and injunctive relief against Defendants Robert F. Kennedy Jr., Nicole Shanahan, and
20 Francisco V. Aguilar, in his official capacity as the Nevada Secretary of State, pursuant to
21 NRS 298.109, NRS 30.030 and NRS 33.010. Plaintiffs allege as follows:

22 **JURISDICTION AND VENUE**

23 1. This Court has jurisdiction pursuant to NRS 298.109(3) as this is a challenge to
24 candidates' qualifications under Nevada law to appear on Nevada's ballot as independent candidates
25 for President and Vice President of the United States. Furthermore, the Court has jurisdiction to
26 grant declaratory and injunctive relief under NRS 30.030 and NRS 33.010.

27 2. Venue is proper under NRS 298.109(3), which specifies that this challenge shall be
28 filed in the First Judicial District Court.

THE PARTIES

1
2 3. Plaintiff Uwe Rockenfeller is a resident of Clark County, Nevada, registered to vote
3 as a member of the Republican Party.

4 4. Plaintiff Francisco Morales is a resident of Clark County, Nevada, registered to vote
5 as a member of the Democratic Party.

6 5. Upon information and belief, Defendant Robert F. Kennedy Jr. is a New York
7 resident, registered as member of the Democratic Party in New York, attempting to qualify as an
8 Independent Candidate for President of the United States in Nevada while simultaneously seeking
9 to access the ballot as a candidate for President of the United States for several political parties,
10 including the American Independent Party of California, the We the People Party of Hawaii, the
11 Natural Law Party of Michigan, the Reform Party in Florida, the Alliance Party of South Carolina,
12 and the Independent Party of Delaware.

13 6. Upon information and belief, Defendant Nicole Shanahan is a California resident,
14 attempting to qualify as an Independent Candidate for Vice President of the United States in Nevada
15 while simultaneously seeking to access the ballot as a candidate for Vice President of the
16 United States for several political parties, including the American Independent Party of California,
17 the We the People Party of Hawaii, the Natural Law Party of Michigan, the Reform Party in Florida,
18 the Alliance Party of South Carolina, and the Independent Party of Delaware.

19 7. Defendant Francisco V. Aguilar is the Nevada Secretary of State and is named in his
20 official capacity. As the Secretary, Mr. Aguilar is responsible for the execution and enforcement of
21 Nevada's election laws. His duties include certifying the eligibility of candidates for President and
22 Vice President of the United States and placing qualified candidates on the Nevada general election
23 ballot.

COMMON FACTUAL ALLEGATIONS

24
25 8. On or before April 29, 2023, Defendant Robert F. Kennedy Jr. ("RFK Jr.")
26 announced his campaign for the Democratic nomination for President of the United States.

27 9. Months later, after it became clear that a majority of Democratic voters would reject
28 his primary campaign, RFK Jr. pivoted to playing spoiler by forming his own political party – the

1 "We the People Party" – to run for President of the United States in states where it would be easier
2 to get on the ballot than filing as an independent.¹ (Ex. 2 at 4.)

3 10. Either RFK Jr. did not seek to qualify his "We the People Party" in Nevada or the
4 effort to qualify it was unsuccessful. RFK Jr.'s "We the People Party" is, upon information and
5 belief, not qualified for the Nevada general election ballot.

6 11. Thus, for the State of Nevada, RFK Jr. now claims that he is an "Independent"
7 candidate for President of the United States while simultaneously seeking the nominations of at
8 least six separate political parties in six other states. Upon information and belief, these six political
9 parties have distinct platforms and ideologies.

10 12. For example, RFK Jr. has announced he is the American Independent Party of
11 California's candidate for the President of the United States. (Ex. 3 at 6.) The American Independent
12 Party has a sordid history, supporting past segregationist candidates for president like former
13 Alabama governor George Wallace. (*Id.*) And its recent former chairman, Robert J. Walters,
14 published a book that claimed that genetic differences between Black students and White students
15 were the reason Black students performed worse in schools than White students. (*Id.*) The
16 American Independent Party promoted Walters' book on Facebook. (*Id.*)

17 13. In the State of Hawaii, RFK Jr. apparently qualified his We the People Party and
18 claims to be the candidate for President of the United States of the We the People Party in that state.
19 (Ex. 4 at 9.)

20 14. And in the State of Michigan, RFK Jr. is seeking to access the Michigan ballot as
21 the Natural Law Party of Michigan's candidate for President of the United States. (Ex. 5 at 11.)

22 15. In the State of Florida, RFK Jr. is seeking to access the Florida ballot as the Reform
23 Party's candidate for President of the United States. (Ex. 6 at 15.)

26 ¹ For example, upon information and belief, in North Carolina, RFK Jr. instructed those
27 gathering signatures that the "sole purpose of this petition is to qualify a new political party in
28 North Carolina," a reference to the We the People Party, that would "place the name of Robert F.
Kennedy Jr. on the 2024 general election ballot as a candidate for the office of President of the
United States." [https://assets.nationbuilder.com/joinkennedy/pages/5014/attachments/original/

1 16. Similarly, in the State of South Carolina, RFK Jr. is seeking to access the
2 South Carolina ballot as the Alliance Party's candidate for President of the United States.
3 (Ex. 7 at 16.) However, RFK Jr. only sought the Alliance Party's nomination after he first attempted
4 to qualify as an independent candidate for South Carolina's ballot. (*Id.* at 16-17.)

5 17. And in the State of Delaware, RFK Jr. is seeking to access the Delaware ballot as a
6 candidate of the Independent Party of Delaware. (Ex. 8 at 18.)

7 18. Defendant Nicole Shanahan is RFK Jr.'s vice presidential running mate, (Ex. 9 at 22)
8 and, upon information and belief, is seeking to be the candidate for Vice President of the
9 United States of the American Independent Party of California, the We the People Party in Hawaii,
10 the Natural Law Party of Michigan, the Reform Party in Florida, the Alliance Party in
11 South Carolina, and the Independent Party of Delaware alongside RFK Jr.

12 19. RFK Jr. is attempting to qualify in Nevada as an Independent candidate for President
13 of the United States. (Ex. 10 at 33-34). Similarly, upon information and belief, Shanahan is
14 attempting to qualify in Nevada as an Independent candidate for Vice President of the United States
15 to be RFK Jr.'s running mate.

16 20. RFK Jr. circulated a petition for signatures from registered voters that listed only his
17 name as a candidate for President of the United States, and which did not include the name of his
18 vice-presidential running mate, contravening Nevada law. (*Id.* at 34).

19 21. Upon information and belief, RFK Jr. submitted his signed petitions in
20 January 2024, and in March 2024, the Nevada Secretary of State informed his campaign that the
21 ballot access petitions were invalid as they did not contain a vice-presidential candidate as required
22 by Nevada law. (*Id.*).

23 22. Upon information and belief, RFK Jr. made no attempt to correct his invalid ballot
24 access petition for several months.

25 23. On or before May 31, 2024, RFK Jr. – through Team Kennedy, a registered
26 campaign committee with the purpose of electing RFK Jr. to the office of President of the
27 United States – filed a "Complaint for Injunctive and Declaratory Relief" in federal court seeking,
28 among other things, to prohibit the Nevada Secretary of State from enforcing Nevada law.


4. Such further and additional relief that this Court deems appropriate.

About 'We the People' Party

The campaign is proud to announce that supporters have formed a new party that will get Bobby on the ballot in five states: California, Delaware, Hawaii, Mississippi, and North Carolina. The party called "We The People."

Most states offer independent presidential candidates two methods of achieving ballot access — as an individual candidate or as the nominee of a party. The two processes often require different number of signatures. In most states, the individual candidate process requires fewer signatures. However, in some states, the party ballot access requires fewer signatures and is the most direct path to ballot access. Once a new party achieves ballot access this party can nominate the candidate of their choosing, in this case, Robert Kennedy Jr.

With these party filings, we are reducing the number of valid signatures we need to get on the ballot nationwide by 302,000, nearly a third of the total. In Hawaii and North Carolina, they will get ballot access through collecting signatures. In California and Delaware, they will get ballot access by registering members to the party online, 75,000 in California and 769 in Delaware. In Mississippi, the new party will be able to get ballot access without collecting any signatures or party registrations.

In California, you can register with the party online [California Secretary of State website](#). Simply fill out the voter registration form there, select "other" as your party preference at the bottom of the form and type in "We The People" in the box on the right. Please sign up for the party and encourage all family friends, colleagues, and community members to join you. Each member brings us one step closer to ballot access in California. You can [find detailed instructions to register here](#) (downloadable version [here](#)).

"We the people" are the first three words of the Constitution. These words symbolize that our government draws its power from the people that it was made to serve.

This past October, RFK Jr returned to Philadelphia, the birthplace of the United States, and declared independence from the "bankrupt two-party system." He did so with the National Constitution Cen behind him and the words "We the people" etched into the building by his side.

Standing in that historic place he said, "Like the Founding Fathers declared their independence from crown more than two centuries ago, today we declare our independence from the corrupting influence of Wall Street and corporate donors that have rigged our economy for the few at the expense of the many."

RFK Jr. embraces California ballot nomination from party with history of far-right ties

The American Independent Party of California, which backed segregationist and former Alabama governor George Wallace in 1968, nominated Kennedy for president.

Independent presidential candidate [Robert F. Kennedy Jr.](#) said this week that he has qualified to be on the ballot in California and will accept the nomination of the American Independent Party, which has a history of associating itself with far-right figures and individuals who have expressed racist views.

Kennedy's alliance with the American Independent Party, which has previously supported segregationist and [former Alabama governor George Wallace](#) as well as [Donald Trump](#) in 2016, is part of his campaign's attempt to get access on states' ballots through gathering signatures or receiving the nominations of minor parties.

The American Independent Party's recent former chairman, Robert J. Walters, wrote a book in 2015 that claimed genetic differences rather than discrimination led to Black students performing worse in schools compared with White students. The party promoted his book to their Facebook followers in 2022.

Three states — Utah, [Michigan](#) and Hawaii — confirmed that Kennedy is on the ballot, and he hinted at a recent event that more announcements were imminent. The California secretary of state's office confirmed that it received the paperwork from the party, which now only exists in California, but the state will not certify candidates until Aug. 29, after its deadline to receive requests for ballot access.

In a five-minute video posted Monday [on X](#), Kennedy explained his relationship with the American Independent Party and said the party's new leadership contacted him.

“It’s had its own rebirth, even before I came along,” he said, adding that the group had drafted a new charter recently and had been evolving before he launched his effort to get on the ballot. “It’s been reborn as a party that represents not bigotry and hatred, but rather compassion and unity and idealism and common sense.”

It is unclear what policy beliefs the party now holds. A “statement of purpose” on the party’s website says that “the new American Independent Party connects positive, visionary and independent candidates with California voters.” The party’s chairman, Victor Marani, wrote in a text message that politics “has changed dramatically in the past half century.”

“Right now, today, America thirsts for real Independent candidates who will represent the voters instead of Party interests,” Marani said, declining to offer any more specifics about the party’s associations with far-right figures. The official website does not provide policy details about the party’s platforms. The Kennedy campaign did not respond to questions about the group’s history. The Washington Post was unable to reach Walters for comment.

An [archived version of the website from 2021](#) indicates the group included that marriage should only be between a man and a woman, fetuses should have the same legal protections as people and undocumented immigrants should “be punished for their crime in a way that will deter them from future offenses.”

The American Independent party was established in the 1960s to get Wallace, who ran on a segregationist platform and stoked fears of insurgency, on the ballot in California.

It has nominated several controversial figures since then, including segregationist Lester Maddox in 1976; John G. Schmitz, a former official with the ultraconservative John Birch Society, in 1972; and Michael Peroutka, a former board member of the League of the South, an Alabama-based organization that the Southern Poverty Law Center has [classified as a hate group](#), in 2004. The party nominated Trump in 2016 and, in 2020, long-shot presidential candidate and businessman [Rocky De La Fuente](#) for president and rapper Kanye West for vice president. West, now known as Ye, made [antisemitic comments in 2022](#).

The party’s former leadership, former chair Markham Robinson, and several other politicians aligned with the group were [also part of the “birther” movement](#), falsely questioning the eligibility of former president Barack Obama in 2009 and Republican nominee Sen. Mitt Romney (Utah) in 2012.

Records on the California’s secretary of state website indicate the group’s leadership changed this year. Marani was previously a longtime Republican operative who had donated to GOP candidates, chaired the Santa Cruz county Republicans and worked for Rudy Giuliani’s 2008 presidential campaign.

The American Independent Party is California’s third-largest political party, already has ballot access and, with 835,000 registered voters in the state, provided Kennedy an easier path forward than running with his own party. In 2016, a [Los Angeles Times investigation](#) found that members have registered with the party in error because they thought they were registering as political independents.

Republicans have increasingly attacked Kennedy amid concerns he could attract conservative voters, including Trump, who claimed without evidence on Truth Social last week that Kennedy is a “Democrat ‘Plant’” who is in the race to help Biden.

Meanwhile, Democrats have attacked Kennedy’s alliances with right-leaning groups and people, frequently taking aim at Kennedy over donations the campaign and the super PAC supporting him have accepted from major GOP donors. Democrats closely aligned with Biden fear Kennedy’s name recognition and previous support of Democratic causes might drive voters to him who might otherwise pick Biden, advantaging Trump in states where there are close contests.

“He’s a right-wing extremist, plain and simple,” said Pete Kavanaugh, founder of Clear Choice, a Democratic-aligned super PAC aimed at defeating third-party efforts, after the news of the California nomination. “He’s accepting the mantle of George Wallace and there’s no hiding from it. He’s making Trump blush.”

Hawaii Office of Elections Confirms Kennedy Supporters Submit Needed Signatures for 'We The People' Party

PEARL CITY, HI—FEB. 22, 2024—The [Kennedy campaign](#) today announced that the Hawaii Office of Elections has confirmed Kennedy supporters have collected the 862 required signatures to establish the "We The People" party in Hawaii. Supporters submitted more than three times the required number of signatures. The official deadline to submit signatures was today.

The "We The People" party will nominate Kennedy as its presidential candidate.

"Mahalo to the people of Hawaii who made this great accomplishment possible," Kennedy said. "I'm inspired by how enthusiastic people are to collect signatures, create new political parties, and rally for real change. This kind of energy is what will get us onto the ballot in every state and fuel our voter registration and GOTV operation as we head toward election day."

Kennedy visited Hawaii in January and saw firsthand the [aftermath of the Lahaina wildfire](#), one of the worst and most tragic examples of government inefficiency and corruption. He also [held a rally](#) on the island of O'ahu where hundreds of people heard him speak about how he will as president, restore the middle class, unwind the war machine, unravel corporate capture, end the chronic disease epidemic, secure the border, among other priorities.

The signature gathering effort was led by the "We The People" Hawaii Party Chair Kim Haine.

"Mahalo to all the amazing volunteers across our island state who worked so hard to make this happen," Haine said. "We're excited and honored to be a part of this historic campaign to preserve peace, prosperity, and freedom for all. RFK Jr. truly embodies the spirit of aloha, and we know aloha can change the world."

The campaign launched a [Ballot Access Headquarters page](#) to keep media and supporters up-to-date on the campaign's operations to get RFK Jr. on the ballot in all 50 states and the District of Columbia.

Kennedy is already on the [ballot in Utah](#) and has collected all the necessary signatures to be on the [New Hampshire ballot](#).

Earlier this month, supporters of independent presidential candidate Robert F. Kennedy, Jr. [filed political party paperwork](#) in six states — California, Delaware, Hawaii, Mississippi, North Carolina, and Texas.

Three months ago, Kennedy returned to Philadelphia, the birthplace of the United States, and [declared his independence](#) from the "bankrupt two-party system." He did so with the National

How R.F.K. Jr. Got on the Michigan Ballot, With Only Two Votes

The independent candidate persuaded a tiny party to give him its line on the ballot in a key 2024 battleground state, sparing him a costly, arduous organizing effort.

In January, when Doug Dern, the state chairman of the Natural Law Party of Michigan, got an email from a top strategist for Robert F. Kennedy Jr.'s presidential campaign, he sensed it could be a star turn for his tiny political group.

For 22 years, Mr. Dern, a bankruptcy lawyer with a small practice outside Detroit, has almost single-handedly kept the Natural Law Party on Michigan's ballot. Each cycle, the party runs a handful of candidates in obscure state races to meet Michigan's minimum polling requirements for minor parties.

"Keep that ballot access," Mr. Dern, 62, said in an interview on Friday. "Because someday, a candidate is going to come along who's going to be perfect for it. Someday, the third parties are going to be hot."

That day may have come.

In gaining access to the ballot in Michigan, a critical swing state in the 2024 election, Mr. Kennedy has injected new uncertainty into what promises to be one of the most closely contested presidential races in history. And he did it without having to gather a single signature, avoiding a costly and arduous organizing effort, not to mention the possibility of having to fight court challenges to those signatures.

Mr. Kennedy was formally nominated at a brief convention held Wednesday morning in Mr. Dern's law office. The only two attendees were Mr. Dern and the party's secretary.

Stefanie Spear, a spokeswoman for the Kennedy campaign, confirmed the timeline of the campaign's outreach and said simply that Mr. Kennedy and his running mate, Nicole Shanahan, had been "duly nominated by the Natural Law Party."

Third parties have drawn increasing attention in recent elections — and arguably have swung some of them — by allowing voters to express discontent with major-party candidates. Mr. Kennedy is counting on a particularly strong showing in this election as polls show voters are highly dissatisfied with their options.

The Natural Law Party was founded in 1992 on a platform that included promotion of transcendental meditation, responsible gun use, flat taxes and organic farming. But it has dwindled over the years. Heading into the 2024 election, Michigan's was its only state chapter.

These days, the party is more like an empty vessel for independent candidates, which Mr. Dern sees as a virtue in itself — a commitment to giving voters more choice. Every presidential cycle, independent candidates reach out to Mr. Dern, seeking the party's nomination in Michigan. In 2008, the spot went to Ralph Nader, who had been seen as a spoiler in the 2000 election.

Mr. Dern, who has worked as a stage magician and also has a law practice for drunken-driving arrests, has made it his personal mission to keep the party active. "I've just been plugging away, year after year, making sure there are people on the ballot," he said.

Natural Law candidates, who have frequently included Mr. Dern himself, have run for secretary of state, seats on Michigan's Supreme Court, lieutenant governor, state university boards and others. Their mission is simple: Secure enough votes in the general election to keep the party on the ballot for the next cycle.

In Michigan, minor parties can retain their ballot access only if their top vote-getting candidate — for any statewide office on the ballot — receives a total vote equal to at least 1 percent of the total votes cast for the winner of the last secretary of state race.

In January, Cornel West's independent presidential campaign reached out to Mr. Dern, he said. Under normal circumstances, Mr. Dern said, Mr. West would have been a great candidate for his party.

But the very next day, a better offer arrived in the form of an email from Nicholas Brana, a campaign consultant for Mr. Kennedy — whose ideals, Mr. Dern noted, align with much of the Natural Law Party's original platform, including its emphasis on health. Mr. Kennedy, an environmental lawyer and a scion of a storied political family, is also a leading figure in the anti-vaccine movement and a critic of the Covid pandemic response.

The party affiliation is crucial for Mr. Kennedy's campaign. Independent candidates without any party backing face a daunting path to getting on the ballot in Michigan, requiring between 12,000 and 60,000 signatures, including 100 signatures from each of at least half of the state's congressional districts.

Candidates can skip all that if they are nominated by a minor party with ballot access. The party just has to hold a convention, nominate a candidate and submit a certificate to the Michigan Department of State. There are a few other legal niceties — for example, presidential candidates need to submit a list of electors — but that is basically it, Mr. Dern said.

So, on Wednesday morning, Mr. Dern said, he and Kathleen Oakford, the party's secretary, held their convention in a low-slung office building in Hartland, Mich.

The proceedings were brief.

“She came in, I took my gavel and tapped it on my desk.” He called the state convention to order, they signed the proposed certificate of nomination, he closed the meeting, “And I took off for Lansing and filed it.”

Since Mr. Kennedy’s campaign announced his place on the ballot, Mr. Dern has fielded calls and emails from other states and candidates. A resurgence of interest in the Natural Law Party is underway, Mr. Dern said.

“There’s even talk of reviving the national chapter,” he said.

Kennedy Gains Ballot Access in Florida With Reform Party

TALLAHASSEE, FL—JUNE 7, 2024—The Reform Party **received notice** that the Florida Division of Elections has recertified its party status giving Independent Presidential Candidate **Kennedy Jr** ballot access in the Sunshine State.

“We’re thrilled to give Floridians an independent option this November,” said **Reform Party of Florida Chair Jenniffer Desato**. “We’ve been eagerly waiting to collaborate with the Kennedy Campaign here in Florida and make history together.”

Two weeks ago, the National Committee of the Reform Party **acted** to nominate Kennedy, granting him ballot access in Florida and providing a major fundraising advantage.

Currently individuals can donate a maximum of \$6,600 to the campaign. With the Reform Party nomination, the party will be able to raise an additional \$41,300 from individual donors and spend in coordination with the campaign to support Kennedy. The party contribution limit is more than six times the campaign contribution limit, supercharging Kennedy’s fundraising.

The Reform Party was founded in 1996 by supporters of Ross Perot, the most successful independent candidate in the last century before Kennedy. The party rules call for it to nominate a presidential candidate, who then picks their vice-presidential candidate. Kennedy accepted the Reform Party nomination and chose Nicole Shanahan as his running mate. The party refiled its Florida state party paperwork this week to run Kennedy.

The campaign’s aggressive **ballot access operation** will ensure the Kennedy-Shanahan ticket is on the ballot in all 50 states and the District of Columbia. The ballot access operation is **fully funded** with more than \$15 million raised.

The Kennedy-Shanahan ticket is officially on the ballot in nine states: **Utah, Michigan, California, Delaware, Oklahoma, Hawaii, Texas, South Carolina**, and now **Florida**.

It has collected enough signatures for ballot access in nine other states: **New Hampshire, Nevada, North Carolina, Idaho, Nebraska, Iowa, Ohio, New Jersey**, and **New York**.

The Kennedy-Shanahan campaign has collected the signatures needed for ballot access in **18 states** totaling **268 electoral votes**, 49% of the 538 total electoral votes nationwide. Florida will add another electoral vote.

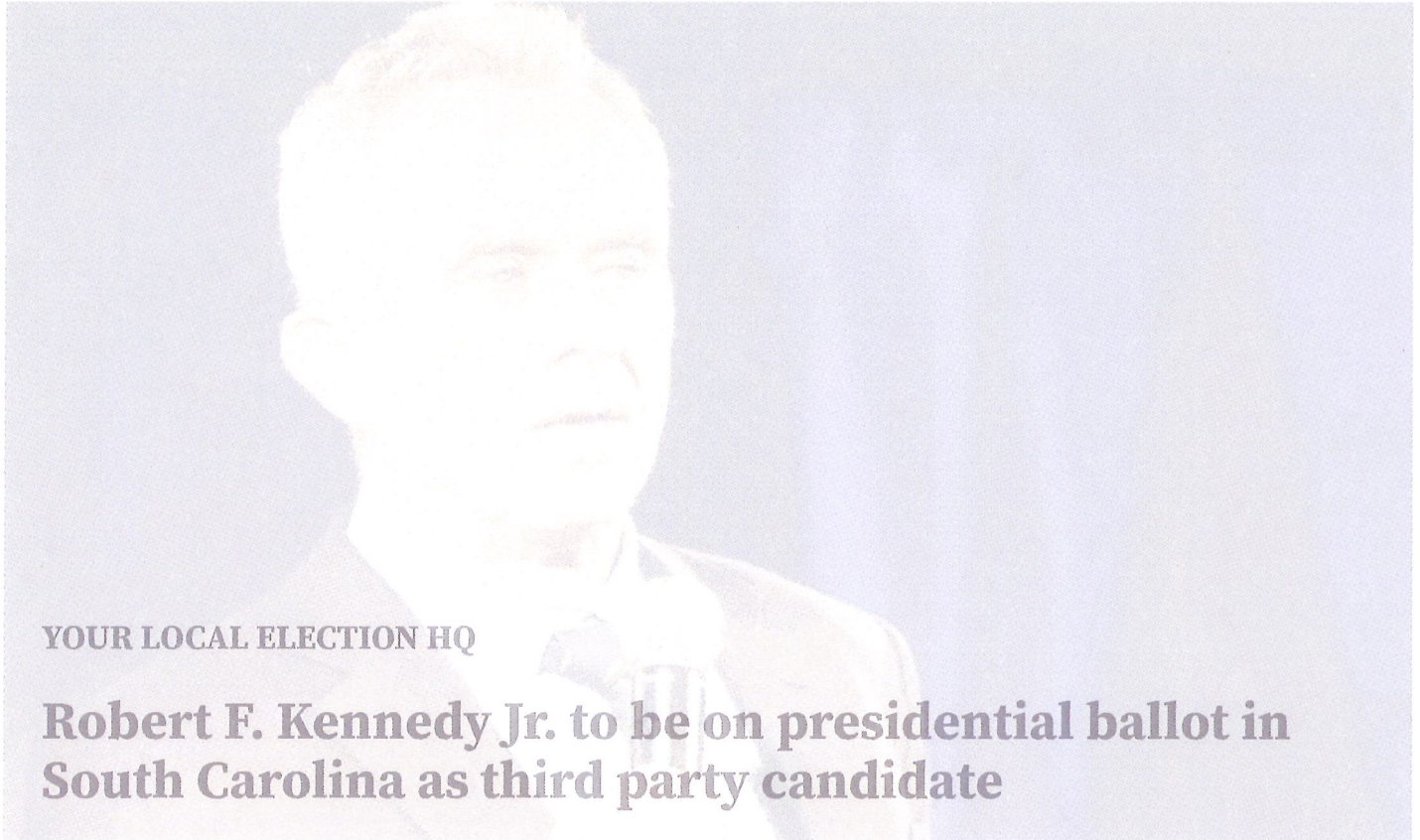
On May 1, the Kennedy campaign **released results** from a Zogby poll showing Kennedy beats both Presidents Biden and Trump in head-to-head matchups. Trump defeats Biden, and Kennedy beats President Trump in a two-way race, by a tight margin. In a two-way race between Kennedy and President Biden, Kennedy wins in a landslide. Kennedy is the first independent ever to defeat both major party candidates in head-to-head matchups.

CHARLESTON, S.C. (WCBD)- Robert F. Kennedy Jr. announced Friday that he has qualified to be on the presidential ballot in South Carolina in November but it won't be as an independent.

The Alliance Party of South Carolina chose Kennedy as their party's nominee for president, the campaign said Friday.

“I proudly accept the Alliance Party’s nomination for president of the United States,” Kennedy said. “Their leadership and members have demonstrated an inspiring commitment to values that revitalize our representative democracy.”

The chair for the Alliance Party did not immediately return a request for comment.

Robert F. Kennedy Jr. files complaint over rules for CNN’s presidential debate next month



Officials with the South Carolina Election Commission said Kennedy submitted a petition in March, seeking ballot access as an independent candidate. That process requires a candidate to submit 10,000 signatures from active, registered voters.

But, Kennedy will now only appear on the ballot under the Alliance Party label as fusion voting — in which more than one political party nominates the same candidate on the ballot — is prohibited in the state.

Kennedy and his vice presidential pick, Nicole Shanahan, have also gained access to the ballot in California, Delaware, Hawaii, Michigan, Oklahoma, Texas, and Utah.

The campaign said it has also collected enough signatures for the ballot in Idaho, Iowa, Nebraska, Nevada, New Hampshire, New Jersey, New York, North Carolina, and Ohio.

Polling [averages](#) from Decision Desk HQ/The Hill show Kennedy with 8% support in a hypothetical three-way matchup with President Biden and former President Trump.

The Independent Party of Delaware is putting Robert F. Kennedy Jr on the ballot as its 2024 presidential candidate.

As RFK Jr. seeks to get on the ballot in all 50 states and the District of Columbia for November's general election, his campaign is trying to gain access through different ballot eligible political parties in various states.

In Delaware, he turned to the Independent Party of Delaware. That party's Secretary General Wolfgang von Baumgart explains why they nominated Kennedy.

"To offer the American people a constructive alternative, a constructive problem solving alternative, to the two-party system that actually creates more problems than it solves,"

said von Baumgart. "We are interested in creative solutions to our common problems rather than ideological rhetorical polarized battles."

RFK Jr. has been successful getting on the ballot in four other states including Michigan and California.

His campaign is also working to get the signatures required to gain ballot access in other states.

Kennedy faces an uphill battle as a third party candidate, but many experts see him as a potential spoiler to both President Joe Biden and former president Donald Trump in November.

Kennedy Welcomes Nicole Shanahan as His Running Mate

"There is only one moment in time and one candidate that I would step into this capitol if I could now and that candidate is Robert F. Kennedy Jr.," **the 38-year-old VP pick said.**

"I believe, very strongly, that focusing on the health and well-being of our youth is the key to a strong America. That means honestly looking at the root causes of where childhood development is being sidelined. We have the tools to prioritize American wellness, we just need to use them."

Kennedy introduced his running mate enthusiastically, describing how he "wanted a VP who will speak for millennials and Gen Z. Someone who cares about healing our children, protecting our environment, restoring our soils, and getting the chemicals out of our food, and who understands that technology will either enslave us or give us a path back to freedom and prosperity."

"From our first meeting," **Kennedy said,** "Nicole's intellectual capacity left me awestruck. I knew then I wanted her as my vice president and I knew America was going to fall in love with her."

Shanahan's work on behalf of honest governance, racial equality, regenerative agriculture, and children's and maternal health has put her at the forefront of many of the country's most urgent needs.

Today's event reaffirms the key principles of the Kennedy campaign of restoring the middle class, ending the chronic disease epidemic, unwinding the war machine, and unraveling corporate capture of our government agencies.

The Kennedy campaign has launched a [robust ballot access plan](#) to ensure the Kennedy-Shanahan ticket is on the ballot in all 50 states and the District of Columbia.

Kennedy is already on the [ballot in Utah](#) and has collected all the necessary signatures to be on the ballot in [New Hampshire](#) and [Nevada](#). Kennedy leads Presidents Biden and Trump among independents. Independents continue to constitute the largest political bloc in the U.S. with an average of 43% of adults. In contrast, 27% of adults identify as Republicans and 27% of adults identify as Democrats.

Three months ago, Kennedy returned to Philadelphia, the birthplace of the United States and his independence from the "bankrupt two-party system." He did so with the National Constitution behind him and the words "We the People" etched into the building by his side.

"We the people" are the first three words of the Constitution. These words symbolize that our government draws its power from the people that it was created to serve.

On Oct. 9, Kennedy said, "Like the Founding Fathers declared their independence from the crown more than two centuries ago, today we declare our independence from the corrupting influence of Wall Street and corporate donors that have rigged our economy for the few at the expense of the many."

Nicole Shanahan Remarks:

Hello everybody and thank you Bob! It's so good to be here in Oakland.

This city will always have a special place in my heart.

I grew up just a few miles from this very spot. My mother is an immigrant from Guangzhou, China, and my late father was an Irish and German American. I want to tell you a little bit about them and my childhood so you can understand the source of my politics and convictions.

My mother's first job when she came to the United States in 1983 was as a live-in caretaker to an elderly woman while attending school. By the time I was born, she worked as a secretary at a dental office. My father loved us dearly, but he was a troubled man, plagued by substance abuse, and couldn't really hold onto a job for very long.

From watching my father and his struggles, I learned not to be judgmental. He was doing the best he could. I think of him when I see the statistics on the millions of Americans, the tens of millions, who are addicted or depressed or suffering.

This is one of the real epidemics of our time. It affects nearly every American. My family's experience was unusual, but it is not. It has become part of my determination to do something for our country.

Every time my dad lost his job, our family just couldn't cover its expenses. Food, gas, clothing, utilities added up to more than we had. I know a lot of Americans know exactly what that's like, to be just one misfortune away from disaster. I don't think we would have made it without food stamps. My mom worked hard, but without that help it just wouldn't have been possible to hold it together. My mom probably knows how she became very wealthy, but my roots here in Oakland taught me many things. I have never forgotten that the purpose of wealth is to help those in need. And that's something I want to bring to our politics too.

I went to high school at St. Mary's, also just a few miles from here. In my junior year I had another formative experience that is still a huge part of my political consciousness. I applied for a program to live with families in El Salvador, and praying with these families and helping them rebuild from the civil war there, I learned what war really is. I learned how it tears lives apart, how it brutalizes children, how it visits unspeakable horror on the innocent. And I also learned of the resilience of the human spirit, and its capacity to heal, to forgive, and to restore. El Salvador is where I came to understand war, but more importantly it is also where I came to understand peace.

That is what inspired me to my first political action. In high school, at the onset of the Iraq War, I became an anti-war activist. I didn't really know how to do it — I printed pamphlets and led a walkout. But I knew in my bones that violence begets more violence. I'd seen what that does to a society. I didn't want my country, America, the country that I love, to be doing that in the world. So these are two of the political convictions I still hold today: to serve peace, and to help those in poverty. You can understand why I gravitated toward the Democratic Party because that was supposed to be the party of peace, the party of compassion. Many Democrats still believe in those ideals, but unfortunately, the institution, it has lost its way. There is only one anti-war candidate today, peace candidate, and you won't find him in the Democratic Party or the Republican Party. He is Robert F. Kennedy Jr.

It is his commitment to peace and to the welfare of hard-working people in America that drew me to him. It is his person of compassion, to his candidacy.

As recently as a year ago, I didn't think much of Bobby Kennedy.

I didn't think much of him, because I didn't know. All I had was the mainstream media narrative. But then a friend pulled me aside one day and said, "Nicole, please, do me a favor. Listen to one interview with Bobby Kennedy. Just one."

So I listened to one. Then to another and another. And I recognized a person who was the exact opposite of the media slander of his character. I saw a person of intelligence, of compassion, and of reason. I saw a fellow lawyer who had committed himself to finding the truth and fighting for the environment and people. I discovered a person who speaks out on issues that, even though they are critically important to human health and welfare, are consistently ignored by our government. And for the first time in a long time, I felt hope for our democracy.

One of those issues also happens to be a passion of mine and a focus of my philanthropic work — chronic disease. I got into it through my own journey of reproductive health, followed by a steep learning curve in caring for my daughter who has an autism diagnosis. In that journey I discovered that women's fertility is in precipitous decline around the world. We are facing a crisis in reproductive health, and that's embedded in the larger epidemic of chronic disease. Because it has been so personal for me and my daughter, I got deep into the research and consulted some of the best scientists and doctors. Let me share what I found. There are three main causes. One, is the toxic substances in our environment, like endocrine disrupting chemicals in our food, water, and soil, like the pesticide residues, the industrial pollutants, the microplastics, the PFAs, the food additives, and the "forever chemicals" that have contaminated nearly every human cell.

Second is electromagnetic pollution. You don't hear politicians talking much about that, but it is something we need to look at. As Bobby says, we need to investigate every possible cause of the chronic disease epidemic that is devouring our nation from the inside.

Third, I'm sorry to say, our own medications. Pharmaceutical medicine has its place, but no single study can assess the cumulative impact of one prescription after another after another after another throughout the course of

childhood. Conditions like autism used to be rare. One in ten thousand. Now it's one in 22 here in California. Allergies. Obesity. Anxiety. Depression. Our children are not well.

Our people are not well. And our country will not be strong for very long either if we don't heed this desperate call for attention.

I've spoken to our government agencies about this. I've spoken to senators. I've spoken to governors. They all know something is wrong, but none of them take any kind of action. There is only one candidate for President who takes the chronic disease epidemic seriously. It is Robert F. Kennedy Jr., and I will be his ally in making our nation healthy again.

It's not about a new pill. It is not about "finding the cure." We know the cure is cleaning up our environment and providing the basic public goods that are the foundational conditions for health and healing. It is about a shift in our priorities. It is about compassion. Chronic disease, addiction, poverty, depression... this is where Americans are hurting the most. It is time for politicians to listen.

So here is how the Kennedy-Shanahan ticket is going to end the chronic disease epidemic. While Bob focused on ending the corporate capture of our regulatory agencies, I am going to assemble some of the best technologists and scientists in the world and we will use the latest in AI and computation and examine the health records

databases of our nation and those of other countries who are also on the quest to solve chronic disease. We will find unbiased answers to our most pressing health concerns within weeks and not decades of time to move out of the dark ages of medicine. We can solve the mysteries guarded by corporate influence. We can move from bandaid solutions to root causes, and we can end the chronic disease epidemic.

My sense is that most American Moms and dads already know the truth of the matter and it is long overdue that the duty of care owed to the American family is actually given. We CAN find the answers conclusively. I have a background in tech, so I tend to think in terms of data. In my tech days, I developed AI-powered software to automate affordable legal services. Well, the CDC and research institutions have the data we need. We can apply technology to figure out what environmental factors are making us sick. We just have to ask the right questions, do the right research, and apply the right tools. We have to overcome the science of the corporate bias that contaminates it. Today we can put the chronic disease epidemic into reverse.

Actually the first political issue to which I applied my tech background was criminal justice. It was at the Bay in San Francisco, where the district attorney's office needed help examining thousands of records thought to contain evidence of racial bias, wrongful arrests, and patterns of prejudice. I put together a team of computer scientists to develop a computational method to collate all these case records, and design a method for analysis. In short, I got to see the sorry state of criminal justice in this country. It isn't just about policing. It is about the school-to-prison pipeline. It is about a broken and dismally functioning infrastructure. And it is about recidivism. How do we provide alternative paths? How do we make prisons places of rehabilitation not punishment? These questions don't have easy answers but they ARE the right questions, and Bobby Kennedy is the only Presidential candidate who is asking them.

I'd like to mention one more issue close to my heart. My interest in health and solving climate issues led me into the realm of agriculture. I realized that a nation's health comes down to its soil and the people who work it. Healthy soil is the foundation of healthy food. It is the foundation of a healthy ecosystem and a healthy climate. It is the

foundation of a healthy economy. But what politician, besides Bobby Kennedy, do you hear ever talking about soil? I've produced two films on this issue — Common Ground is the latest. I've talked to Congresspeople and Senators, but all I've ever gotten is vague

promises that never amount to real change. Republicans and Democrats alike have fallen under the sway of the big agrochemical companies and food conglomerates. They might invoke the ideal of the family farm, but they have betrayed it again and again. So I'm entering politics myself. I'm joining some of America's most innovative farmers. Their methods rebuild soil, sequester carbon, recharge aquifers, and revitalize the farm economy. We don't have to force anyone to imitate them. All we have to do is change our system of regulation and subsidy to support those methods, instead of extractive corporate agriculture.

I hope you all understand now what has brought me into politics as an independent candidate for vice president. I am leaving the Democratic Party to do it, because Kennedy has himself said I want to say two things about that. First, even though I'm leaving the party, I believe I am taking its best ideals and

impulses with me. The Democratic Party is supposed to be the party of compassion and peace. It is supposed to be the party of diplomacy and science. It is supposed to be the party of civil liberties and free speech. And most importantly, the party of the middle class and the American Dream. While I know those ideals still abide within many Democrats, I want to point out that the party has lost its way. In its leadership, in its institutions, it has become interested in elitism, celebrity and winning at all costs, that means turning a blind eye on issues they all know true. I know because I've been in those circles for the last 8 years and have grown increasingly tired of it. It wasn't until I met Bobby and the people supporting him, that I felt any hope in the outcome of this election.

As I've reexamined my Democratic Party assumptions, I have seen conservative voters. I have met hunters and farmers that are some of the staunchest conservationists I have ever known. I understand ecosystems better than most. I have met mothers protecting their children who are seeking every possible avenue for their health. And yet the Republican Party, the Democratic, is letting them down because the actions of the party are diverting from the values that actually support individual freedom. In fact, the very failure of both parties to do their job to protect their founding values has contributed to the decline of this country in my lifetime. Maybe that's why I see so many Republicans disillusioned with their party as I became disillusioned with mine. If you are one of those disillusioned Republicans, I welcome you to join me, a disillusioned Democrat, here in this movement to unify and heal America.

This independent movement comes at a time of extreme division in America that threatens to tear the country apart. It is time for a re-alignment. It is time, as Bobby Kennedy says, to focus on our unifying values rather than our divisions. And so, if anyone is listening who never considered an independent candidate, I want to extend the same invitation, the same plea to you that my friend did. Please, please listen to Bobby Kennedy in his own words. Take a close look at his vision for America. It is a vision I share too as I back his campaign, and focus the next 7 months of my life getting him on each and every ballot in this country!

The vision we share is a vision of national healing. It is an America that leads the world, no longer through force of arms, but through the power of example. It is an America that wages peace through diplomacy. It is an America that had become the sickest industrialized country on earth and turned it around. It is an America where everyone who works hard can afford a decent life. It is an America where people of all races receive fair and equal treatment under the law. It is an America whose freedoms are the envy of the world. It is an America with honest and transparent government institutions. Can you imagine that - a country whose government doesn't lie to you?

People talk about my age. It is true, I will be the youngest vice president in American history. Tell me why so many of us young people have turned away from politics. It's because we lost hope that change would ever come from inside the system. After all, whichever party wins with promises of change and change, or to drain the swamp, things proceed as normal, declining bit by bit with each passing year. So that's one reason. So I come to you today as a former Democrat. I come to you as a woman not quite 40. I come to you as someone who has experienced sickness and health and poverty and wealth. And finally, I come to you as a mother. Most of the philanthropists I work with are women, other mothers, and I was a mother that I came to support this campaign. I never thought in a million years that I would be running for president. No, I joined the many groups of mothers who support this candidate. They are Republicans and Democrats and independents. They read the labels in the supermarket and wonder how to keep their kids healthy. They watch in anguish as their children suffer from chronic disease. They cry silently as their teenagers deal with depression, anxiety, and addiction. They do their best to hold it together. If you ask me who my heroes are, that's who, it's the moms trying to make a normal life for their children in a world that has gone crazy.

As a mother myself who knows firsthand the challenge of a special needs child, my promise to you is make this world a little less crazy will work with Bobby Kennedy to make America once again a country of peace, a country of compassion, a country that is prosperous and free. This won't happen overnight. But I have seen the miracles that the human spirit can accomplish. I have seen its resilience. I have seen its tremendous capacity to heal. What is possible for the human being is possible also for our nation. So please join me and Robert Kennedy in the healing of America.

Robert F Kennedy Jr's Remarks:

I am honored to accept the Muwuk Oh-lone Tribe endorsement of our campaign, and I appreciate the trust the Chairwoman and the tribal council place in me.

They know the battle for justice and healing for indigenous people has occupied a large part of my energies and of my professional and personal life.

This work will continue when we are in the White House. The Muwuk Oh-lone Tribe and other tribes unfairly deprived of federal recognition deserve to have their status legitimized.

My father spent a lot of time in Oakland, conducting hearings for the poverty program here in 1967 campaigning here in 1968.

During his presidential run, he made an unscheduled visit at Cate Taylor Memorial Methodist Church with Willie Brown to meet with NAACP leadership, members of the Black Panther Party, and local activists.

My dad refused: "This is between them and me. I need to hear them out."

The Monsanto case was my latest in a lifetime of battles to get poisons out of our food and our farm and restore our soils.

The effort has consumed much of my life — I wanted a vice president who shares my passion for wholesome, healthy foods, regenerative agriculture, and good soils, and I found one.

Among other things she has used cutting-edge technology including AI to calculate the catastrophic health consequences of toxins in our soil and water.

Technology has been a lifelong passion of my future vice president.

"We checked with the (Secretary of State) in January; we got his written assurance from his office that we could collect signatures without the vice president on the ballot," said independent presidential candidate Robert F. Kennedy Jr.

The RFK Jr. campaign gathered over 15,000 signatures that were required. They presented them in January, and in early March, the Secretary of State informed the campaign that an employee of the Secretary of State's office had provided the Kennedy campaign with "inaccurate guidance." The campaign was then informed that they needed to have a vice president listed on their ballot petition.

"So we are litigating, we filed suit immediately," said Kennedy.

Kennedy filed a lawsuit in the U.S. District Court for the District of Nevada against Nevada Secretary of State Francisco Aguilar. Aguilar is responsible for overseeing elections.

"The court must prohibit what was either rank incompetence or partisan political gamesmanship by the Secretary from invalidating petition signatures afforded the highest First Amendment protection by the United States Supreme Court," said Paul Rossi, Senior Counsel for the Kennedy 2024 Campaign, in a statement.

We interviewed the Nevada Secretary of State, Cisco Aguilar, about the situation.

"We did have another interaction with the campaign team or the RFK campaign team. They have resubmitted their application again for their signature gathering documents because there was a clerical error on the original document," said (D) Nevada Secretary of State Cisco Aguilar.

Despite the acknowledgment by the Secretary of State's office that an employee provided the RFK Jr. campaign with inaccurate information, as of Tuesday the campaign is currently working on collecting and resubmitting the required number of signatures.

"At the same time we are taking the precaution to do the ballot access drive all over again and we're going to collect another 15-thousand signatures, and one way or another, or by two ways we'll be on the ballot by August," said Kennedy.

The deadline for RFK Jr. to submit the second round of signatures is July 5th.

"We're not going to pick and choose how we implement the law and how we follow statute, the secretary of state is a regulator. It is our job to call balls and strikes. It is our job to ensure that Nevada has the safest and most secure elections in the country," explained Aguilar.

Kennedy chose California lawyer and philanthropist Nicole Shanahan as his running mate at the end of March, a few weeks after he submitted the petition. The lawsuit is happening as Kennedy works to get on the ballot in enough states to have at least 270 electoral votes by June 20th. This is in order to qualify for the CNN debate stage with former President Donald Trump and President Joe Biden.

The first presidential debate is June 27th. During the Libertarian Convention on May 27th, RFK Jr. challenged Donald Trump to a debate, but Trump declined.

Kennedy has informed us about the issues he's facing in other states while trying to get on the ballot, despite having gathered more than enough signatures. Additionally, RFK Jr. discusses the DNC's communications with CNN to keep him off the first presidential debate stage. You can learn

Team Kennedy filed a lawsuit in federal court to validate the original petition. But, time is running out to meet the July 5th deadline.

While RFK Jr fights the NV SOS in court (Plan B) we've begun Plan C, which is to collect signatures circulating a second petition stamped June 11 to get the required signatures by July 5th.
