Per our conversation earlier this summer, we still need DEC permits to get STAMP (mega-site) operational and competitive for a potential semi-conductor manufacturing facility in WNY. Of note, the Gov helped ground-break for Plug Power at STAMP, but it's also frozen because of a lack of state permits. (This site is in her old congressional district)

Last week, we signed Green CHIPS. Now we need executive assistance to get DEC to issue the permits.
