

While Project 2025 leaders are gathering in <u>Milwaukee today</u> to discuss their vision for America, their MAGA blueprint, <u>led and organized by RNC sponsor The Heritage Foundation</u>, would jeopardize the safety of Americans everywhere.

Here's how Project 2025 and its backers are <u>threatening</u> to undermine Americans' safety:

- Dismantle the Department of Homeland Security (DHS)
- Privatize the Transportation Security Administration (TSA)
- Undermine and politicize the FBI
- Criminalize medication abortion
- Invoke the Insurrection Act on Day One to quash protests

While claiming to further ensure Americans' safety at the Republican National Convention this week, these Project 2025 plans would do anything but. Two major Project 2025 players, Gene Hamilton and Ken Cuccinelli, are at the helm of this dangerous agenda:

Gene Hamilton, <u>executive director of America First Legal</u> penned the Project 2025 plan for the Department of Justice. Hamilton:

- Authored some of the Trump Administration's worst immigration policies, including <u>travel bans</u>, <u>changes to refugee policies</u>, and the implementation of an <u>aggressive new approach to</u> <u>immigration enforcement</u>, and drafted the memo that terminated DACA
- Proposed radically weakening the FBI demoting it within the DOJ, making it subject to more political appointees, and terminating major active investigations
- Wants to stack DOJ with political loyalists over civil servants and discipline staffers who aren't sufficiently loyal to the president

Ken Cuccinelli authored the Project 2025 plan to gut the Department of Homeland Security. Cuccinelli:

- Advanced a far-right <u>white supremacist vision</u> while helping to lead the administration's DHS and its U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS)
- Suggests dismantling the Department of Homeland Security entirely, breaking up the department, reassigning agencies across the government to different departments, and shuttering certain services altogether
- Claims "<u>DHS's mission is politically charged</u>" and wants to increase the number of political appointees loyal to the president within DHS
