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NARRATIVE

On 10/21/15 at approximately 1317hrs, I, Officer Gualdoni #349 was dispatched to [redacted] in Lake Forest in reference to a possible trespassing issue.

I arrived on location and met with the complainant identified [redacted] [redacted] informed me earlier in the day [redacted] staff cut a player identified as [redacted] pending further team disciplinary action.

[redacted] informed me [redacted] then returned a short time later, at which time security would not allow him to drive past the front gate of the property. [redacted] advised [redacted] parked his vehicle at the gate and walked past security and up to the building advising he needed to get his belongings. [redacted] advised when [redacted] [redacted], he told [redacted] yesterday, he felt like killing everybody in the building. [redacted] gathered belongings and left the property without further incident.

[redacted] advised [redacted] returned to the property a short time later advising he needed his cell phone from the locker room. Security would not allow [redacted] through the front gate. He again parked his vehicle and entered the property on foot. [redacted] informed me he made contact with [redacted] on the property and was escorting [redacted] to retrieve his phone, at which time [redacted] told [redacted] "I am the devil" and he wished staff member's children would die. [redacted] advised he informed [redacted] multiple times he is not to return to the property and must leave [redacted] then left the property without further incident.

[redacted] described [redacted] as very angry and irrational and believed [redacted] [redacted] informed me he had concern for the safety of staff on the property due to [redacted] behavior and statements [redacted] also advised it is believed [redacted] owns multiple firearms [redacted] informed me [redacted] is known to drive a [redacted] truck with black rims and dark tinting on the windows with possible [redacted] I ran the provided registration through [redacted] [redacted] advised he did not have any information on [redacted] current location or residence, as [redacted] refused to provide that information to staff for their records.

[redacted] completed a voluntary written statement describing [redacted] and the concerning statements he made to staff. [redacted] informed me he believed [redacted] was a credible threat to staff on the property.

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NARRATIVE (continuation)

[REDACTED] provided a phone number which he believed to be [REDACTED] current cellular phone. When called, the number went straight to an automated message that did not allow voicemails to be left. A GPS ping of the cellular phone was conducted and showed a location in the state of Texas.

[REDACTED] asked for police presence until staff left the property at 1800hrs that day (10/21). He also asked for police presence when staff began to arrive at 0500hrs the following day (10/22). [REDACTED] advised [REDACTED] is not allowed on the property at [REDACTED] Football Drive in Lake Forest, and he would sign a complaint for trespassing if [REDACTED] returned to the property. LFPD provided a uniformed officer to stand by on the property during the requested time.
