- Participate in a 24/7 monitoring program:
 - Be tested for alcohol 2 times per day, each day, for the first _____ days of probation.
 - Be randomly tested for controlled substances _____ times per week for the first _____ days of probation. Report to the AASAP office in the Boney Courthouse now within 12 hours of being released from custody. Defendant shall pay all reasonable costs of participating in the program.

- Complete an assessment and follow recommendations of a state-approved batterer's intervention program. Pay costs. Give proof of completion to the prosecutor by _____

Call to set up an appointment at either (907) 272-4822 or (907) 332-7660, 9 a.m. – 5 p.m., Monday through Friday. If there is no answer, leave a message with your name and return phone number. Make initial contact within two weeks of your sentencing or your release from jail.

IF YOU FAIL TO REPORT TO THE PROGRAMS ON TIME OR COMPLETE PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS, A WARRANT MAY BE ISSUED FOR YOUR ARREST AND THE SUSPENDED PART OF YOUR JAIL SENTENCE AND/OR FINE MAY BE IMPOSED.
