I appreciate the invite during the SAT Conference. Unfortunately due to personal scheduling I will not be attending the conference.

On another issue Capt Kolb is on vacation and there was a medication mishap this last week. An inmate came in from the Mental Hospital on Thursday 07/22/21 at 16:00. He arrived with a list of prescriptions. He was seen Friday morning and the medication was not filled. The Jail noticed a change in the inmate but did not rise to notifying me. I was contacted by a family member who had received multiple phone calls from the inmate that were increasing in mental instability. When investigated I learned that Jail staff was under the impression nurse asked the inmate if he could wait until Monday for prescriptions. The Jail staff called the oncall and the prescriptions were filled at Brookshire's Pharmacy and my Chief Deputy had to go pickup on Saturday afternoon.

Though its not a big deal the inmate is diagnosed with schizophrenia and does not want to be on meds and that is part of the reason he was self-medicating and committed Agg Robbery.

Back story to this was that the Agg Robbery occurred and on Wednesday night and suspect was found and taken to CCMC for mental evaluation about 9pm that evening. The deputies stayed all night with the suspect and transported to Wichita Falls. The suspect stayed at mental hospital a week and was arrested and brought to jail. Not that mental crisis is an excuse for the crime I want to insure trust in the community that what little mental health care is available will be continued while incarcerated.

I have attached TA MemoSB1849 from 2018 that I believe that if a complaint was submitted to TCJS that it would be found sustained.
