Hello Elizabeth,

Happy New Year!

I am happy to run these searches for you, although they would not reduce the duplication I described or the processing time. I think that, essentially, the duplication arises from searching for gswoboda@azleg.gov communications in other mailboxes while simultaneously running searches in the gswoboda@azleg.gov mailbox. As written, this new set of searches would pull all of the same results that I described in my previous email that overlap with each other (general staffing topics, committee staffing, etc.). I'm glad you pointed out that you are interested in Gina's alternate emails, I think there is a good way to address that. In order to cover what you are looking for, I would suggest the following:

Search 1

Subjects: Petersen, Kredit, Covert, Engwall, Rogers, Rodriguez

Parameter: Any Communication with ginaswoboda@hotmail.com or ginaswo@asu.edu

Range: 8/1/22 to Present

Search 2

Subject: Swoboda (gswoboda@azleg.gov)

Parameters: All of 3, 4, and 5 below

Range: 1/3/23 to 4/30/23

This consolidates 5 searches into 2, covers any alternate emails, and drops any Swoboda communications that aren't related to individuals/groups/keywords you have specified as being of interest. This consolidation only works, of course, under the assumption that you are not interested in the general staffing communications that I mentioned – again, those covered things like HR announcements, office arrangements, scheduling, calendars, etc.

I hope this makes sense/is helpful! Please let me know if something like this works for you, or if you would rather stick with your request as written.

To be clear, however, American Oversight still requests that complete email chains be produced, displaying both sent and received messages. This means that both an individual's response to an email and the initial received message are responsive to this request and should be produced.

All reports, analyses, recommendations, or guidance prepared by Gina Swoboda regarding elections and election-related legislation for the Arizona State Senate.

For request items 3 through 5, please provide all responsive records from January 3, 2023, through April 30, 2023.

Let me know if the above addresses the duplication concern? We don't want to miss emails between the senators and Ms. Swoboda's alternate, non-official addresses, so adjusted the first two parts accordingly.

Hi Elizabeth,

Thanks again for taking my call today. Below is an outline of where we are at with the four requests submitted as well as some points/suggestions on how we might proceed.

I've run preliminary searches for each of the four requests outlined below.

Request 1: AZ-SEN-23-1158

- This request concerns communications between Senator Petersen, Josh Kredit (Chief of Staff), Assistants, and a list of domains for individuals and organizations.
- A preliminary search yields zero responsive results with any of the individuals or organizations on the list *except* for Gina Swoboda (Senior Policy Advisor, Elections)
 - Most of the results are related to the election committee (duplicative results with request 2 and 4) or staffing topics (HR, scheduling, office information, etc.).

Request 2: AZ-SEN-23-1159

- This request concerns communications between Senator Rogers and her assistant and a list of domains for individuals and organizations.
- A preliminary search yields zero responsive results with any of the individuals or organizations on the list *except* for Gina Swoboda.
 - Most of the results are related to the election committee scheduling and details, which Senator Rogers is on and Gina staffs (duplicative results with request 1 and 4).

Request 3: AZ-SEN-23-1160

- This request concerns communications between Gina Swoboda and a list of domains for individuals and organizations.
- A preliminary search yields a single responsive result.

Request 4: AZ-SEN-23-1161

- This request concerns communications sent by Gina Swoboda that include various keywords as well as reports, analyses, recommendations, or guidance prepared by Gina.
- A preliminary search yields several results which also appear for request 1 and 2.

Essentially, I have three different sets of results that overlap greatly with each other. I can process each

request individually, which would take a longer amount of time and would result in many duplicated if not triplicated records being pulled. Alternatively, you can consolidate your requests into one request that more narrowly identifies what kind of records relating to Gina Swoboda that you are interested in – in this case, I can run one search, process one set of results, and produce one batch of results. This would reduce processing time and provide you with only the things you are actually interested in.

Please let me know if you are interested in developing a consolidated request. If you are able to define what you are interested in re: Gina, we can develop search parameters to most directly address that.

CONSULTANT AGREEMENT

This agreement is made and entered into beginning November 01, 2023, by and between Gina Marie Swoboda, Agrippa Consulting Group, LLC, (Consultant) and the Arizona State Senate.

I. SCOPE OF WORK

The consultant shall work under the direction of the Senate President. During the term of the contract, the Consultant shall provide advice regarding elections and election related legislation as requested by the Senate President. During the contract term, Consultant shall not perform any other work related to Arizona Elections that directly conflicts with this contract.

II. TERM

IV. INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR



Any travel or other costs may only be reimbursed to Consultant and must be pre-approved by the Senate President.

The agreement is subject to cancellation pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes, Section 38-511, and the provisions of which are incorporated herein.

VII. ENTIRE AGREEMENT

This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement, and any modifications or waiver of the Agreement must be in writing and is not valid unless signed by both parties.

Annex A. Ten basic duties at the county level -

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Guidance for the Registrars and Local Election Boards

- 1. Establish a Clean Voting Roll of existing voters:** Inherent under § 24.2-114. Duties and powers of general registrar (sub-section 6) it is the duty of the Registrar to ensure Voters are lawful, which includes citizenship. In a 2019 FOIA of Prince William Court (31st District), 6% of the jurists were rejected due to three reasons that would make the ineligible to be on the voting roll. Under § 8.01-345 the primary source of jurists are the voting rolls.
- 2. Demonstrate a trusted process for new voters registered via the DMV:** The registrar, as the lead official for ensuring a clean roll should establish and publicly demonstrate a process for ensuring that voters registered through the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) are lawful voters. Currently there appears to be no reasonable check and balance to validate an individual who checks the first on a driver's license application is a lawful voter.
- 3. Implement demonstrative ability of the Election Board to provide guidance and perform its duties:** Under § 24.2-106 – 109, Local Election Boards must pro-actively carry out their duties. With examples from Fairfax and Prince William Counties in 2020 and 2022, the Election Boards have been passive observers who have acquiesced to un-lawful guidance from registrars to disregard signature requirements on absentee ballots and hiring of Assistant Registrars. Election Boards must approve these actions and/or give approval first.
- 4. Ensure Security and Integrity of Federally designated, Critical Infrastructure:** Registrars must demonstrate the complete ability to independently (without the vendor) conduct complete inspections, tests, and oversight of the Federally designated, Critical Infrastructure (Election Machines, Tabulators, Poll Books, and related components) under their sworn oversight. There has been a Failure to exercise Articles 13 and 32 of the Hart Contract SBE-140324-HART Voting Machines, Equipment, which allows unfettered, complete access to the machines and a five-year retention of all artifacts related to the voting process. The Federal Election Assistance Commission provides no standards for other than what many call “election machines”. This means there are no security standards for tabulators, poll books, data storage, data processing, cloud computing, printers, or any other equipment or peripherals used in the election process. This process should include independent 3rd party audit, verification, and validation.
- 5. Validate Security and Sovereignty of all election data:** With the Konnech case in Michigan, it is an imperative duty of the vendor and the Registrar to validate all aspects of election data processing, storage, and networks to ensure all data and activity is conducted completely within sovereign U.S. territory.
- 6. Make elections clean and clear of outside non-appropriated funds to “assist” or “facilitate” anything related to elections, voter registration or any activity: Any outside funds are poisonous and acidic to the lawful election process.** The Facebook related CTCL is but one example. This funding is weaponized to advocate for causes and candidates and undermines the integrity of the election process for all. In 2020, under the guise of the Virus, State laws and counties were manipulated, and citizens were misled by the true extent, nature, and purpose of these outside funds. If we are to say we are inclusive in Virginia – this must never happen again.

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7. **Separate from the ERIC system:** There is no federal legal requirement to participate in the ERIC system for voter registration (ericstates.org). Although nice sounding, states have surrendered sovereignty of their voting roles to this non-profit. The Commonwealth of Virginia needs to stand on its own and be able to demonstrate their ability to manage their voting rolls. ERIC receives no independent, 3rd party audits or reviews and has become an unquestioned manager and uploader of voting data, often without the direct verification and validation of state and county officials. There is no demonstrated efficiency or accuracy from participation in the ERIC organization.
8. **Establish and use a Trusted Ballot:** In the most sacred of processes to our democratic republic, the voting process, the counties of the Commonwealth of Virginia do not have standards or control measures to define or ascertain the validity of absentee ballots. This is shocking, ballots should be valued and protected, just like our currency. Modern currency has numerous counter-counterfeiting measures built in, it is quite inexpensive and implementable to do the same with ballots. To not do this is a direct affront to the sensibilities of the lawful voter.
9. **Move to Paper only with Trusted Ballots:** In the 2022 election, Prince William County demonstrated that paper re-counts were quick, efficient, and accurate. The overly complex electronic systems that are now in effect have no independent verification and validation of the scope, scale, and connectivity of their environment. Countries such as France, Germany, Canada, and Taiwan are paper only voting countries, this can be done in America.
10. **Create a new audit system and process:** The nice sounding “Risk Limit Audits” that are currently used in Virginia have little legitimacy in respect to any environment that must generate a legal audit of finances or activities of business or government operations. A more reasonable and realist process that uses at least a four percent sample (or complete precincts within a county) are more accurate and will generate better confidence of a broader cross section of society than the questionable methodology of the existing “Risk Limit Audit” model.

At the State Government level, an additional finding and observation is the need for a State Inspector General Office on the model of the Federal Government. Currently, the State has little ability, capacity, or capability to conduct audits, reviews, and investigations in elections or across any aspect of State or County Government. At the size, scope, and scale of the Commonwealth of Virginia, it is time for establishment of a modern Inspector General like model for state government and county government. It is simply the right and reasonable thing to ensure confidence in governance by the citizens of Virginia

Senate Presentation January 23rd, 2023

Overview - 2 main areas of the 2022 Maricopa County election process were deeply flawed

- **Signature Verification 2020** - 420,987 FAILED signatures in the 2020 election. The system was never repaired, thus, 2022 election was left vulnerable to fraud. *(provided via AZ Senate subpoena of 2020 Maricopa County election data analyzed Sep 2022)*
- **Tabulator Machines 2022** rejected nearly ¼ million vote attempts... at an unprecedentedly high rate never seen before. This cast doubt on, and thus compromised, the integrity of the entire election. *(provided via FOIA, analyzed January 2023).*

Signatures Failed AZSOS Standards

per Signature Verification Training Manual 2020

Signature verification is the process of comparing:

- The signature on a voter's affidavit envelope or ballot affidavit to
- The voter's signature in the voter registration database.

Signature verification plays an important role in our elections because it:

- Helps ensure that only those individuals eligible to vote have their vote counted.
- By serving as the method of identity verification for mailed ballots, it allows Arizona voters the convenience of voting by mail.

This Guide will help those reviewing ballot affidavit signatures to:

- Determine whether the ballot affidavit signature and
- The voter's signature in the voter registration database were authored by the same person.

Overall Assessment

- ▶ **Signature Verification is the LAST LINE OF DEFENSE** to preclude invalid ballot injection, especially when chain of custody and/or ballot harvesting are in question.
- ▶ **420,987 of 2020 ballots FAILED SIGNATURE VERIFICATION.** Thus, the election was openly vulnerable to fraud.

Physically Impossible that Ballots were Signature-Verified

- ▶ **1.3M mail-in or in-person early ballots**
- ▶ **28 workstations**
 - 25 for sig-verify**
 - 3 for curing**
- ▶ **2 Shifts**
 - 7 hrs + 3.5 hrs = 10.5 hrs daily**
 - 19 workdays start 18 Oct 22->**

Realistic Time to Verify a Signature

- ▶ Takes 30-45 secs to verify each signature*
- ▶ 298,000 signatures in 2.5 days (26.5 hours)
- ▶ $298,000 / 26.5 = 11,246$ signatures/hour
- ▶ $11,246 / 25 = 449$ per workstation per hour
- ▶ No way 1 ballot was sig-verified every 8 secs

The remaining 1,013,734 signatures at 13 seconds each.

* At times not all computers were used for signature verifications. However, we calculated all workstations.

- ▶ *Sig-verify team was trained IAW AZ Secretary of State Signature Verification Manual, July 2020 Edition... same manual used in Maricopa County election signature verification training. Team's data director was employed by Maricopa County elections department and received the official Maricopa County Elections training. Three additional team workers, who were trained by Maricopa County Elections, quality-controlled team processes, training and implementation.*

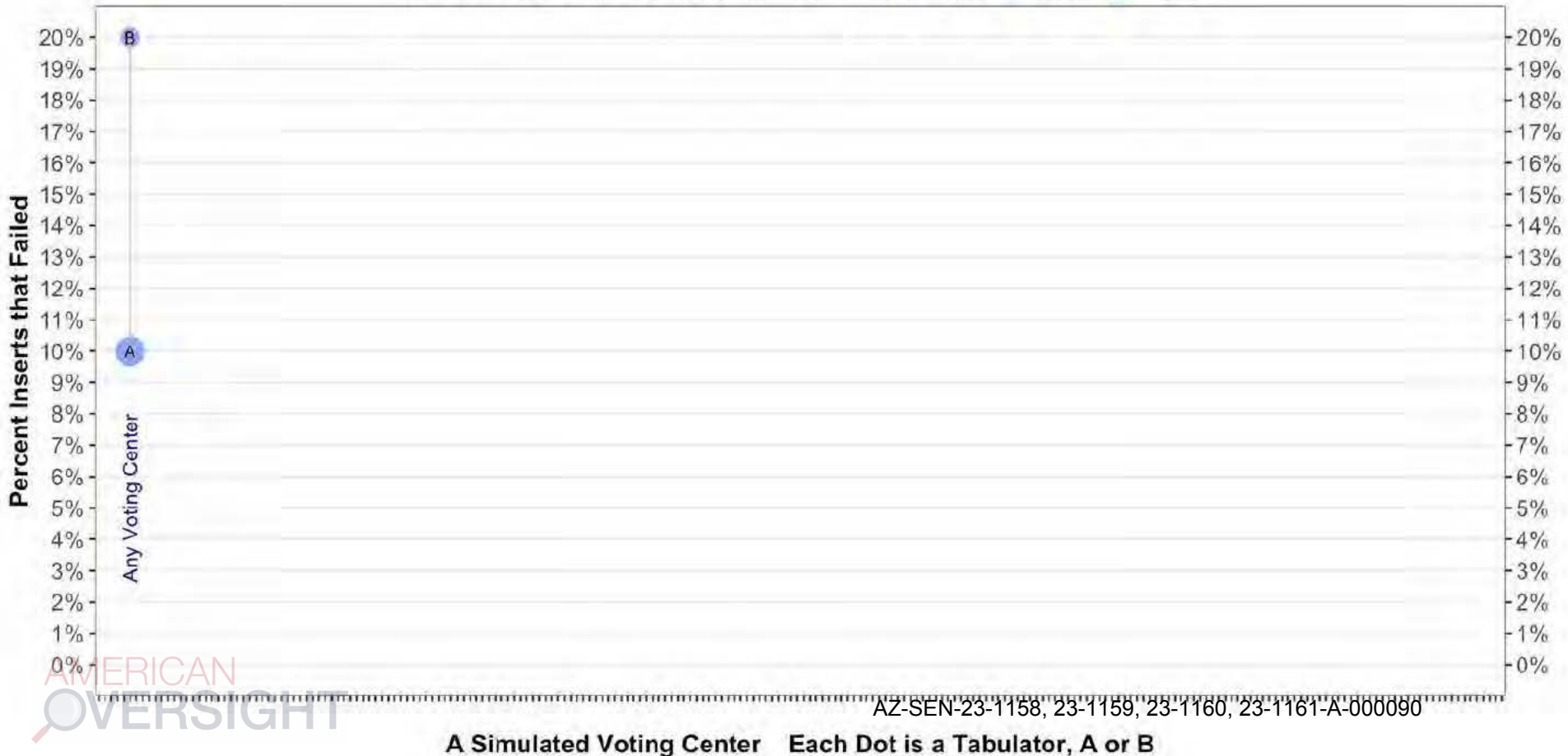

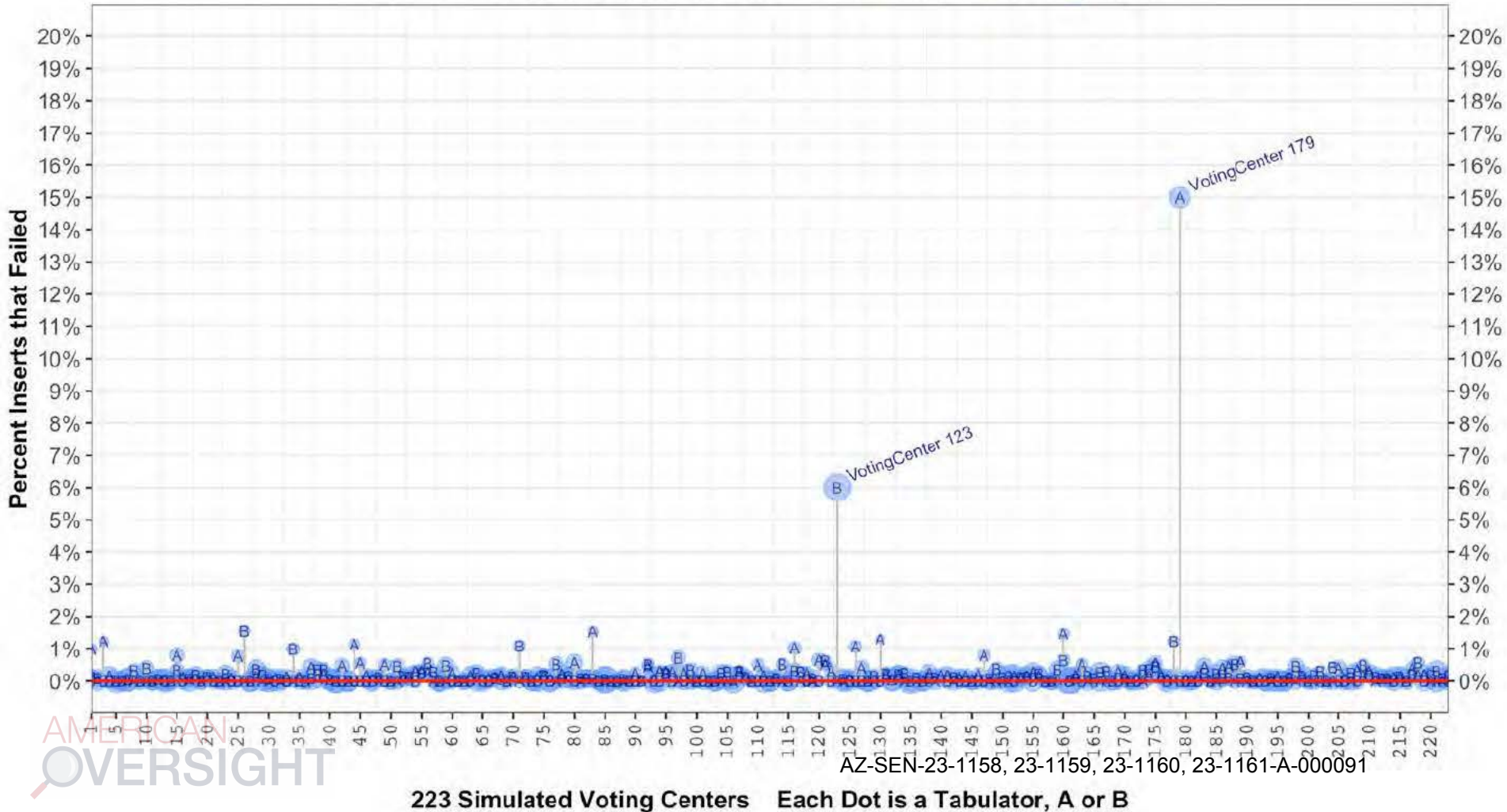

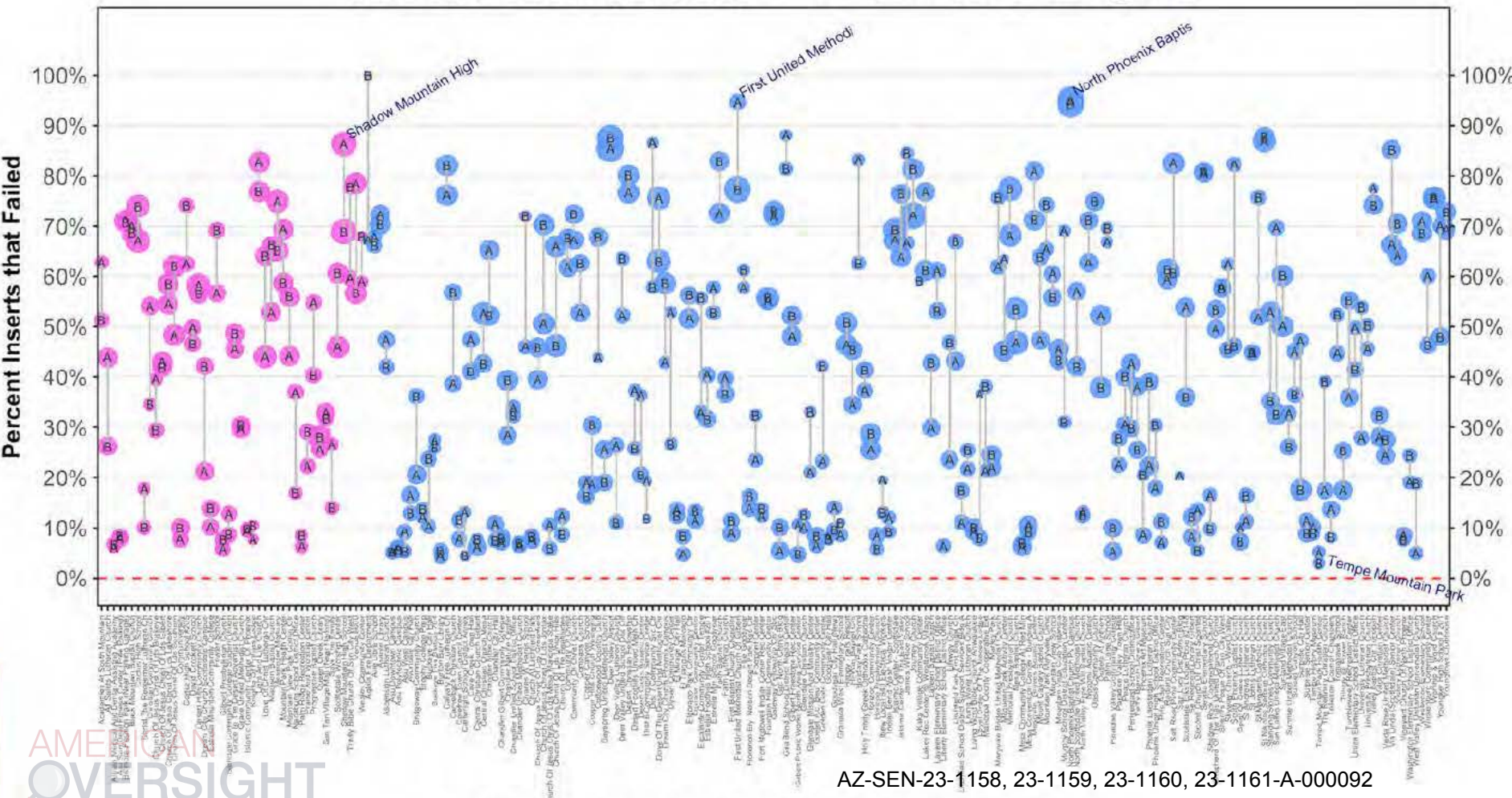

SB1260

Removing duplicate voters

SB1260 contains two primary provisions – the Cancellation provision, and the Felony provision. The challenge to the Felony provision does not impact us, and is now being defended relatively well. It creates a felony for knowingly providing a mechanism to vote to a person registered to vote in another state. The plaintiffs argue that this provision is unconstitutionally vague and could implicate constitutionally protected activities such as providing a registration form to someone who is registered to vote in another state, without the person providing the registration form even knowing it. The Attorney General’s office and the Yuma County Republican Cmte are making a

reasonable defense on appeal – “mechanism to vote” means providing an actual ballot to someone you know is actively registered to vote in another state.

The Cancellation provision requires county recorders to cancel the registrations of voters when they confirm with the county recorder in another county that the voter has since registered to vote in that other county. It also requires, when credible evidence is provided that a voter has registered in another county, the county recorder to confirm that with the other county recorder and then cancel the registration on confirmation. This was always meant for both *intrastate* and *interstate* movers.

From the beginning the plaintiffs have argued that “SB 1260 targets voters who are registered to vote in more than one place *even though having multiple registrations is legal and common*, particularly among voters who have moved their residence” ([pg. 14](#)).

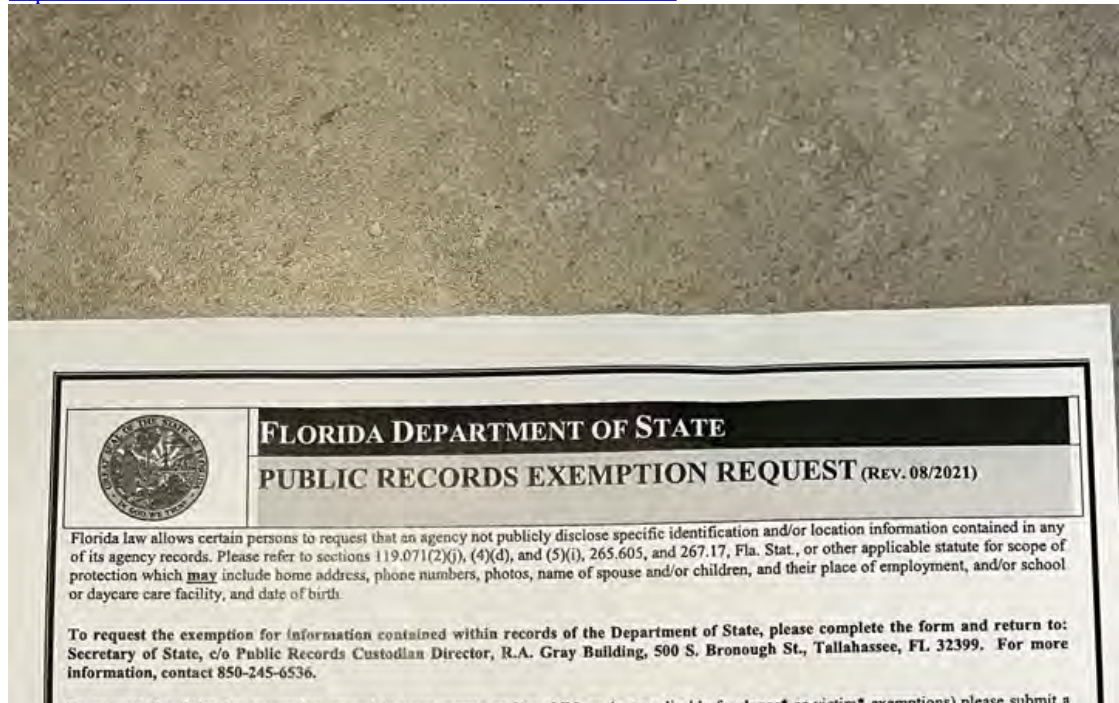

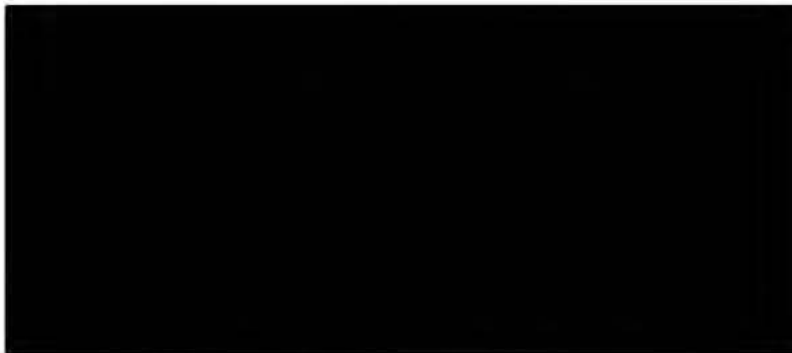

RE: Request for Confirmation of Compliance with Preliminary Injunction

Dear Recorder Burchill:

We represent the Arizona Alliance for Retired Americans, Voto Latino, and Priorities USA (collectively, the "Organizations"), in litigation challenging Senate Bill 1260, which was enacted by the Arizona legislature in 2022. *See Arizona Alliance for Retired Americans v. Hobbs*, No. CV-22-01374-PHX-GMS (D. Ariz. 2022). On September 26, 2022, the U.S. District Court of Arizona preliminarily enjoined two provisions of Arizona Senate Bill 1260—A.R.S. §§ 16-165(A)(10) and 16-165(B)—prohibiting all Arizona counties from cancelling a voter's registration upon confirming that the voter has registered to vote in a different county. *Arizona Alliance*, Sept. 26, 2022, Order at 22.¹ A copy of the court's order is enclosed herein.

We recently learned that Yavapai County has represented through counsel in separate court proceedings that it intends to "attach a cover letter to existing voter registration forms," which will state: "If the Yavapai County Recorder receives credible information that you have registered to vote in another county, your Yavapai County voter registration will be canceled." *See* Defendant Yavapai County Recorder's Answers to Plaintiff's First Set of Interrogatories, dated January 24, 2023, in *Mi Familia Vota v. Fontes*, No. CV22-00509-PHX-SRB (Lead) (D. Ariz. 2022).

Such action would directly violate the preliminary injunction order issued in *Arizona Alliance for Retired Americans v. Hobbs*.

¹ Defendants appealed the preliminary injunction order, but no decision has been issued on appeal. *Arizona Alliance for Retired Americans v. Brnovich*, No. 22-16490 (9th Cir. 2022).

Accordingly, we request that you provide immediate confirmation to us that:

- 1) Yavapai County will **not** attach a cover letter to existing voter registration forms stating that voter registrations will be cancelled if the Yavapai County Recorder receives credible information that the voter has registered to vote in another county, and
- 2) Yavapai County will **not** cancel any voter registrations upon confirming that the voter has registered to vote in a different county.

Please provide such confirmation via email to the following email addresses by **February 3, 2023**: abranh@elias.law and dcohen@elias.law.

After providing such confirmation, Yavapai County should promptly amend its discovery response in *Mi Familia Vota v. Fontes*, No. CV22-00509-PHX-SRB (Lead) (D. Ariz. 2022), accordingly.

If we do not receive your written confirmation by **February 3, 2023**, we will alert the district court of this development, and take all necessary action to ensure that Yavapai County complies with the court-ordered preliminary injunction, and that Organizations' rights and the voting rights of their members, supporters, and constituents are protected.

When we looked at all 165,000 images, there were two common denominators. 1) they were all election day ballots. 2) They occurred in a system that required additional days to count ballots with no transparency. When you allow a month of early voting, the manipulation is done on election day. Many did not send in their mail in ballots. They walked into the precincts and cast the ballot themselves. When the ballots did not scan correctly, your ballot was put in a third drawer to scan later which forced you to vote like it was a mail in ballot.

Before Nov. 3, 2020 election day the ballots were picked up at the voting centers with Transport Receipts signed by transporters of ballots with the count of the ballots and receiving agents of county at MecTec signing the transport receipts.

On election day, at MecTec all of the bottom of the forms were blank with no signature for receiving agent, no count of number of ballots confirmed or audit agent signature. No one at Mectec signed for them. There was no count of 118K ballots and no date and time stamped with no chain of custody. We believe they did this because they did not know how many ballots they needed for Biden to win the election. There were no signatures on any of the 2020 transport receipts for every precinct on election day. Somebody must have given an order not to sign the transport receipts at Mectec. 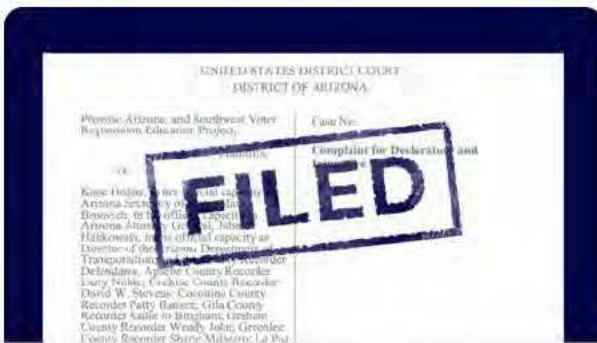

SB1260 Removing duplicate voters

SB1260 contains two primary provisions – the Cancellation provision, and the Felony provision. The challenge to the Felony provision does not impact us, and is now being defended relatively well. It creates a felony for knowingly providing a mechanism to vote to a person registered to vote in another state. The plaintiffs argue that this provision is unconstitutionally vague and could implicate constitutionally protected activities such as providing a registration form to someone who is registered to vote in another state, without the person providing the registration form even knowing it. The Attorney General’s office and the Yuma County Republican Cmte are making a reasonable defense on appeal – “mechanism to vote” means providing an actual ballot to someone you know is actively registered to vote in another state.

The Cancellation provision requires county recorders to cancel the registrations of voters when they confirm with the county recorder in another county that the voter has since registered to vote in that other county. It also requires, when credible evidence is provided that a voter has registered in another county, the county recorder to confirm that with the other county recorder and then cancel the registration on confirmation. This was always meant for both *intrastate* and *interstate* movers.

From the beginning the plaintiffs have argued that “SB 1260 targets voters who are registered to vote in more than one place *even though having multiple registrations is legal and common*, particularly among voters who have moved their residence” ([pg. 14](#)).

“While it is heartening to see Recorder Richer’s ‘Arizona Election Law Reform’ proposal, the Arizona State Senate has been engaged in this work for several years, most often without the cooperation of Maricopa County Election Officials, including the County Recorder.

Recorder Richer’s proposal is an acknowledgment that there is a crisis of confidence in the elections process in Arizona and in particular, in the November 8, 2022 voting process experienced by Maricopa County voters.

The Arizona State Senate has repeatedly extended the hand of partnership to Maricopa County election officials over the past two years as we have sought to execute our duties of oversight and to address the issues that have continued to arise in Maricopa over the past two election cycles.

From the 2020 general election which led this body to execute its oversight by commissioning an audit, through the 2022 election to today, the Arizona State Senate has put forth meaningful elections process reform proposals.

These include several of the items mentioned in Recorder Richer’s proposal:

-In the Second Session of the 55th Legislature Senator Mesnard’s SB1362 ‘On site tabulation of Early Ballots’, a proposal which mandated that voters be provided the opportunity to tabulate their early ballot at the polling place after showing ID, was modified to be optional, after some county officials objected to the mandate. The Senate expects to debate this bill this session.

-former Senator Ugenti-Rita’s 2019 bill SB1064 in the First Regular Session of the 54th Legislature to prohibit the ‘Late Early’ drop-offs (mail ballots dropped off at the polling place by voters in an affidavit envelopes) was likewise rejected as unworkable by county officials. The Senate is discussing effective ways to cut down on the ‘late early’ drop off backlog issue without restricting voter options.

Recorder Richer’s suggestion that these ‘Late-Early’ mail ballot drop-offs be picked up throughout the day on Election Day is an interesting proposal which requires further review following an election

in which Maricopa County purportedly failed to adhere to the current statutory Chain of Custody requirements for these ballots.

The proposal to modify the County Recorder position to a 'non-partisan' elected position, runs counter to the way in which Arizonans choose their elected county officials. It would be counter to requirements enshrined in the Arizona Constitution which ensure a direct primary for the nomination of candidates for county office.

The Arizona State Senate continues to work to restore the confidence of the people of the state of Arizona in their elections.

Legislators have been working for months to craft meaningful process reforms and as these bills move forward we hope to see the support of the county recorders and boards of supervisors as well as the Secretary of State and Governor to ensure that these proposals are enshrined into law and the people of Arizona can once again cast their ballots with confidence that regardless of the outcome their voices have been heard.
