The City of Reedsburg is situated along the Baraboo River. It is part of the Baraboo Micropolitan Statistical Area, which comprises a portion of the Madison Combined Statistical Area. The Madison Combined Statistical Area consists of four counties in the Madison MSA (Dane, Iowa, Green, and Columbia) as well as Rock County and Sauk County (Baraboo Micropolitan Statistical Area). Baraboo is the largest city in Sauk County, approximately 15 miles from SCHCC. Reedsburg attractions include Carr Valley Cheese Factory tours, Circus World Museum, Railway Museum, a large retail outfitter, "Beyond Boundaries," a Walmart Supercenter located in Baraboo, and several state parks to visit, such as Devils Lake, Mirror Lake, and Tower Hill.

SCHCC is 3.3 miles from Reedsburg Area Medical Center, a 25-bed critical access facility that offers various general services, including family medicine, obstetrics, pediatrics, inpatient—surgical, and intensive care. In 2020, the hospital saw a major construction program of private inpatient rooms, a remodeled Birth Center, a new registration, laboratory, sleep study rooms, a gift shop, and seniors housing.

The City of Reedsburg is also proximate (14 miles) to the Wisconsin Dells. The Wisconsin Dells is known for its indoor and outdoor waterparks and has been known as the "Waterpark Capital of the World" since 2005. The Wisconsin Dells reported estimated visitor expenditures for 2021 were \$1.77 billion. While tourism is the predominant industry for the Wisconsin Dells, it has gained recent recognition and success in the meetings and convention market.

Sauk County Health Care Center

Sauk County Health Care Center is an 82-bed Skilled Nursing Facility (SNF) licensed by the State of Wisconsin and operated by Sauk County with all private beds. SCHCC has served Sauk County for 54 years. It was initially constructed in 1970 on the County Farm and moved to its current location in 2009. In 2009, the county built a state-of-the-art skilled nursing facility with all private rooms and baths. SCHCC is currently operating as a <u>non-union</u> facility. The facility comprises 71,322 square feet of building space and sits on 9.82 acres with asphalt parking lots that accommodate 102 vehicles and acres to develop an assisted living/memory care component. The county is offering an additional 31.7 acres that is included with the sale of SCHCC.

SCHCC's financial section was sourced from the 2022 Wisconsin Medicaid Cost Report. Per the 2022 Cost Report, the facility's average private pay daily rate is \$322.58. January 2024 census is 52 residents with a 21% quality mix. Please note that SCHCC received a 30.7% Medicaid increase on July 1, 2023, and has an overall 5-star rating.




Sauk County Health Care Center // LOCAL MAP HOSPITAL





EMPLOYMENT

In 2022, 7,401 people in your selected area were employed. The 2000 Census revealed that 47.6 percent of employees are in white-collar occupations in this geography, and 52.4 percent are in blue-collar occupations. In 2022, unemployment in this area was 3.0 percent. In 2000, the average time traveled to work was 13.2 minutes.



HOUSEHOLDS

There are currently 5,135 households in your selected geography. The number of households has changed by 26.2 percent since 2000. INCOME




EDUCATION

The selected area in 2022 had a higher level of educational attainment when compared with the U.S averages. Only 5.3 percent of the selected area's residents had earned a graduate degree compared with the national average of 12.3 percent, and 13.4 percent completed a bachelor's degree, compared with the national average of 19.7 percent.

The number of area residents with an associate degree was higher than the nation's at 12.1 percent vs. 8.4 percent, respectively.

The area had more high-school graduates, 37.8 percent vs. 27.1 percent for the nation. The percentage of residents who completed some college is also higher than the average for the nation, at 22.9 percent in the selected area compared with the 20.4 percent in the U.S.
