Follow-up due to non-compliance identified during routine inspection on 6/6/24.

Non-compliance identified during follow-up inspection:

**ATCP 16.20(2)(b) The responsible caretaker on the premises, or an individual implementing a caretaker's oral or written instructions, shall perform daily body, mobility, and behavior checks on each dog.**

**ATCP 16.20(2)(e) A licensed veterinarian shall examine each dog as often as necessary to ensure adequate health care. The examining licensed veterinarian shall use appropriate methods to prevent, control, diagnose, and treat diseases and injuries. The license holder shall follow the veterinarian's recommendations.**

- I observed a dog identified as FVC-0 / inside enclosure 737/739 that was limping while moving through the enclosure, not bearing any weight on the right front leg. Two partially healed scratches and/or puncture wounds and swelling were present on the leg near the carpal joint. No documentation of the injury was present on the enclosure card or the whiteboard documenting ongoing or necessary treatment(s). Ridglan representative stated no treatment had yet been provided and the injury "probably" would have been observed today. The second dog present in the same enclosure (FJA-9) appeared to have partially healed puncture / scratch marks on the snout. A Ridglan representative on 9/20/24 responded to a request for follow up - "The enclosure numbers for the two dogs you asked about are 737 and 739. FVC-0 is the dog that had the small cut on its leg. Today there is a small scab present and she is normal in all other aspects. I attached a picture of the healed leg. Her pen mate is FJA-9."

**Pursuant to ATCP 16.20(3)(c)(4): 9 CFR Chapter I, Subchapter A, § 3.1(f): Drainage and waste disposal. Housing facility operators must provide for regular and frequent collection, removal, and disposal of animal and food wastes, bedding, debris, garbage, water, other fluids and wastes, and dead animals, in a manner that minimizes contamination and disease risks. Housing facilities must be equipped with disposal facilities and drainage systems that are constructed and operated so that animal waste and water are rapidly eliminated and animals stay dry. Disposal and drainage systems must minimize vermin and pest infestation, insects, odors, and disease hazards. All drains must be properly constructed, installed, and maintained. If closed drainage systems are used, they must be equipped with traps and prevent the backflow of gases and the backup of sewage onto the floor. If the facility uses sump or settlement ponds, or other similar systems for drainage and animal waste disposal, the system must be located far enough away from the animal area of the housing facility to prevent odors, diseases, pests, and vermin infestation. Standing puddles of water in animal enclosures must be drained or mopped up so that the animals stay dry. Trash containers in housing facilities and in food storage and food preparation areas must be leakproof and must have tightly fitted lids on them at all times. Dead animals, animal parts, and animal waste must not be kept in food storage or food preparation areas, food freezers, food refrigerators, or animal areas.**

- In several buildings within the facility, the drainage systems are not constructed and/or operated so that animal waste is rapidly eliminated. Excess excreta, low spots where waste and wash water accumulates and becomes stagnant were consistent in the catch pans beneath the second-level enclosures where adult dogs were kept, and on the concrete flooring beneath the first level enclosures - with the exception of the pre-shipment / order dogs area and the whelping rooms. A film of organic waste material was present on the concrete flooring beneath the enclosures throughout the facility.

**ATCP 16.20(6)(b) All dogs shall have daily positive human contact and socialization, not limited to feeding time.**

**ATCP 16.20(6)(d) Dogs may not be deprived of contact, activity, or enrichment under this section for extended periods, except for good cause.**

- Pursuant to observations during the routine inspection (CA 99107) and the follow up inspection, dogs within the facility are not receiving daily human positive contact and socialization. During the routine inspection and the follow-up inspection, injuries apparent to DATCP staff were unidentified and untreated.

- Ridglan farms has approximately 3,200 dogs present within the facility, and approximately 16 full time employees (at the time of the 6/6/24 routine inspection, not including manager and lead veterinarian). Three of these sixteen employees' duties primarily consist of dog socialization. All dogs within the facility are not receiving daily positive human contact and/or socialization, not limited to feeding time.



## INSPECTOR COMMENTS / NOTES

Inspection Notes and Summary of Non-Compliance (if any) - continued:

**Pursuant to ATCP 16.20(3)(c)(4): 9 CFR Chapter I, Subchapter A, § 3.2(b): Ventilation. Indoor housing facilities for dogs and cats must be sufficiently ventilated at all times when dogs or cats are present to provide for their health and well-being, and to minimize odors, drafts, ammonia levels, and moisture condensation. Ventilation must be provided by windows, vents, fans, or air conditioning. Auxiliary ventilation, such as fans, blowers, or air conditioning must be provided when the ambient temperature is 85 °F (29.5 °C) or higher. The relative humidity must be maintained at a level that ensures the health and well-being of the dogs or cats housed therein, in accordance with the directions of the attending veterinarian and generally accepted professional and husbandry practices.**

- Due in part to the 9 CFR Chapter I, Subchapter A, § 3.1(f) violation (excess waste accumulation) and inadequate air circulation, odors observed by the inspection team from stagnant pools of moisture and excess excreta had not improved since the routine inspection.
- Most wall-mounted exhaust fans and their adjacent surfaces (louvers, fan blades, casing and ingress points) within the facility were coated with organic material, restricting air movement.

### **Areas of concern:**

- In some enclosures where gaps exist between adjacent coated wire flooring panels, organic matter/fecal matter was present in the gaps
- In one enclosure with dogs present a hole was found in the coated wire flooring in the pre-shipment / order dog area
- In three enclosures in the pre-shipment / order dog area, the coating of the flooring panels had worn in several spots, leaving exposed wire present
