(12-15) Staff and Volunteers, including museum staff, to manage cast, lines, and logistics, ensuring efficiency and comfort for all attendees.

(2) Front Gate Attendants assigned to check tickets and handle registration professionally and smoothly.

2 Full Fireman Tent Watch in place during all event functions for additional safety.

Shaded Tent Area provided for guests to rest comfortably throughout the event.

Additional Efforts for Guest Comfort:

A **Shuttle Bus Service** was provided for additional parking, running from 9 AM to 9 PM on Saturday to ensure ease of access for all attendees.

² We had **10 Porta Potties** available in addition to the indoor restroom facilities to accommodate the needs of all guests.
