Wisconsin voters deserve to know that their vote counts. Our Constitutional Amendment closes the loophole used in states like Maryland to allow noncitizens to vote in local elections.

Section 1 of Article III of our state constitution reads "Every United States citizen age 18 or older who is a resident of an election district in this state is a qualified elector of that district." This proposal would ensure illegal immigrants and other noncitizens are not able to vote by replacing the word "every" with "only."

Dear Senator Bradley,
Could you explain to me (in plain English) how "Only" vs. "Every" differentiates between "illegal immigrants" and "other noncitizens"? No matter what adjective you use, an illegal immigrant or other noncitizen is still NOT A CITIZEN of the United States.

You use Maryland allowing NONCITIZENS to vote as the reason for your proposed amendment to the Wisconsin Constitution. In the Wisconsin Constitution, please explain to me how the phrase "Every United States citizen age 18 or older" allows any "illegal immigrants and other noncitizens" to vote in a Wisconsin election (which is what you imply by proposing changing "every" to "only")? Obviously anyone in either group cannot vote in Wisconsin with the way the Constitution now reads. Furthermore, by the use of the word "other" (in the Constitution) to describe "noncitizens" all illegal immigrants are directly and inextricably defined as "noncitizens" and are therefore not allowed to vote in any Wisconsin election.

For clarity, I am in agreement with your general premise of this issue, and that is that any NONCITIZEN of the United States should NOT be allowed to vote in any election in Wisconsin.
