CRIMINAL COMPLAINT

The undersigned, under penalty of perjury, complains and says that on or about 10/13/2024 7:00:00 PM, in the County of Bernalillo, State of New Mexico, the above-named defendant(s) did commit the above Offense(s) (here state the essential facts):

On 10/13/2024 at approximately 1414 hours the Bernalillo County Sheriff's Office responded to reports of a shooting at 55 Young Rd, Tijeras, NM 87059. The calling party, Daniel Abram, stated to BCSO communications that he heard multiple gunshots from the property located at the above address. He stated he knew the family of four who lived in the house on the property and after hearing the gunshots he attempted contact with them via text message but received no response. The calling party also attempted contact with the family by honking his vehicle's horn, but he received no response. He described the family as a father, mother, adult son, and juvenile daughter.

Deputies arrived at the property and contacted a mid-20's male who exited the residence. He was detained by deputies and identified as Adlai Mestre. Mestre had a handgun on his person, along with a second magazine loaded with ammunition. While being detained by deputies, Adlai uttered something to the effect of, "I killed them and was going bury them." While clearing the residence of additional occupants, deputies observed blood transfer patterns consistent with drag marks and mopping/cleaning. Deputies also observed a knife and a meat tenderizer hammer near the front door with apparent blood on them.

Deputies located two adults and one juvenile deceased from apparent gunshot wounds in the curtilage of the property, in a small arroyo north and east of the residence. The scene was secured for detectives.

Patrol deputies transported Adlai to the main substation for an interview. At approximately 1730 hours, I conducted an interview with Adlai. I advised him of his Constitutional Rights per Miranda and he stated he understood and began writing on my department issued tablet. His notes included times when there were "seismic waves" and how he shot at cell towers and had thermal imaging on his house. I asked him who lived with him and he stated his dad, mom and his younger sister. He stated he killed his dad in the living room, his mother as she came down the stairs but didn't know about his younger sister. He drug them outside to bury them in the ravine. He stated the gun he had on him was a Glock 19 9mm. He tried to clean up by mopping before he was interrupted by initial responding deputies. He stated his dog was ravenous so he had to shoot the dog as well. A dog was found and

with at least one gunshot wound on the property.

It should be noted, Adlai had apparent blood on his tennis shoes, his white shirt and had blood on his hands. He kept asking me how many people had died at the house. I advised him I did not know as I had not been out to the scene yet.

When deputies were searching for the bodies, they observed three individuals, one male and two females, lying in a ravine. They had significant injuries and were lying face down. They were apparently deceased. It appeared they were possibly stabbed as well. The investigation of the scene is ongoing.

Adlai Mestre shot and possibly stabbed his father Raymundo Mestre, mother Nancy Mestre and his sister Brielle Mestre. Adlai dragged each body from the house, outside the yard and into a ravine. The bodies were placed face down approximately 50 yards from the house. A mop was observed by deputies that appeared to be pink and there were signs of mopping up blood. With the physical signs on scene, Adlai's interview and observations of initial responding deputies, I arrested Adlai Mestre for three open counts of murder, four counts of tampering with evidence and extreme cruelty to animals. The four counts of tampering are one each for the dragging of each body from the home and the mopping of the blood.

At approximately 1900 hours, I was finishing the booking paperwork. I observed on our camera of the interview room Adlai punching the wall. I got up to grab my body camera when he kicked the wall. He kicked a hole in the wall and escaped out the hole he kicked. Detectives chased him down the hall and took him into custody without further incident. The initial estimated amount to fix the entire wall of the interview room is over \$1000 but less than \$2500. Based on Adlai's new actions, I added the charges of escape from police custody and criminal damage to property \$1000 or more.
