Whereas allowing biological males into single-sex facilities, such as restrooms, locker rooms, and changing rooms designed for women, jeopardizes the safety and dignity of Members, officers, and employees of the House who are female: Now, therefore, be it

5	(a) Prohibition.—A Member, Delegate, Resident
6	Commissioner, officer, or employee of the House may not
7	use a single-sex facility (including a restroom, changing
8	room, or locker room) in the Capitol or House Office
9	Buildings, other than those corresponding to the biological
10	sex of such individual.
11	(b) Enforcement.—The Sergeant-at-Arms of the
12	House of Representatives is charged with the enforcement
