Re: Resignation - Per Section 14: Severance (b) (3) of my Employment Contract

Dear Mayor Hoy and City Councilors

It has been my pleasure to serve as Salem's City Manager for the past 2 and ½ years. Everyday has been a challenge, we made some real progress, we had some fun and I am proud of the work that we have done together.

I understand the desire of the Mayor and Council to move forward and have a fresh start. I hope that my resignation per Section 14: Severance (b) (3) of my contract will help to facilitate that.

I am submitting this resignation based on a meeting that I had with Councilor Nishioka on Friday February 7, 2025, where she represented that she was the duly authorized representative of the Mayor and a majority of City Council and requested that I tender my resignation.

As per Section 14: Severance (b) (3) of my contract I offer my resignation.

In doing so, I ask that Council consider the following clarifications and modifications:

- 1. That I be placed on administrative leave until March 22, 2025.
- 2. That I be allowed to take my accumulated vacation time starting on Monday March 24, 2025 and running until it is exhausted on or about May 10, 2025.
- 3. That my severance pay per my contract start on or about May 10, 2025 when my vacation is exhausted and be paid over the next 8 months in monthly installments.

While on administrative leave, I would be available for consultation as requested.

I wish the Mayor and Councilors, the City's extraordinary employees and the community all the best. There are many challenges ahead and by working together this organization and community will find a way forward.
