RS 00608 C2

Bob Munier, Department of Insurance, presented RS 00608 C2. Mr. Munier explained that the proposed legislation is part of the legislative package from the NAIC for certification. The legislation will amend the existing Idaho Arson and Fraud Reporting-Immunity Act. It is anticipated that these amendments will aid in the investigation and detection of arson and insurance Munier answered questions from Mr. Representatives Tippets and Stubbs. Mr. Dunn from the Department clarified some points.

RS 00694:

from the State Treasurer's Office Liza Carberry presented RS 00694 to the Committee.
