We have completed our search for responsive records and are continuing our review. Four other agencies (Department of the Interior, Environmental Protection Agency, and the White House's Council on Environmental Quality and the Office of Management and Budget) also received a FOIA request for records related to the issuance of the 316(b) regulations. Accordingly, and because many of the records each agency has located contain multiple agency equities, NOAA and the other agencies began on November 21, 2014 to hold weekly calls to coordinate review. Given the large volume of responsive records and the need to coordinate the review of responsive records among the five Federal agencies, processing the records is taking more time than we anticipated.





We receive correspondence only on business days from 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Eastern Time. FOIA appeals received outside of our normal business hours will be deemed received on the next business day.

We anticipate providing a final response by October 30, 2015 as was discussed during a phone conversation on August 22, 2015. We will continue to provide interim responses as expeditiously as possible. Thank you for your patience.
