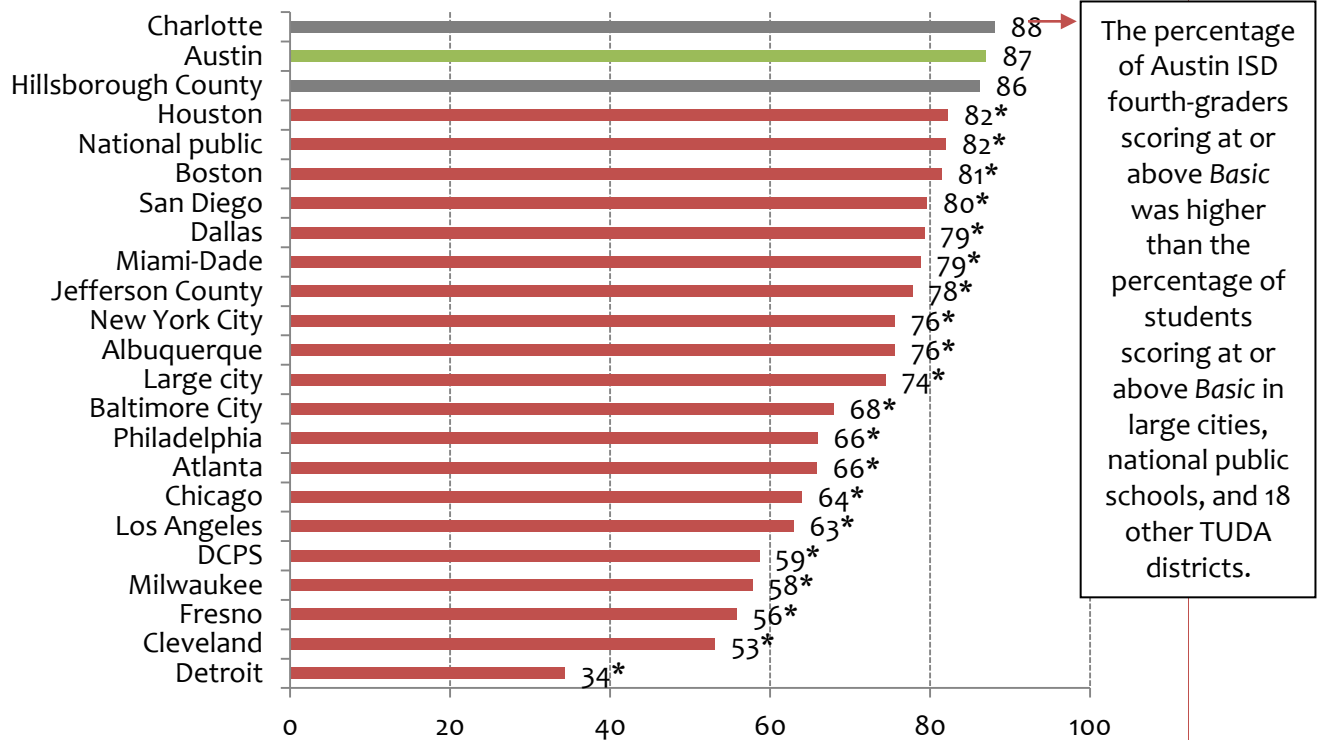
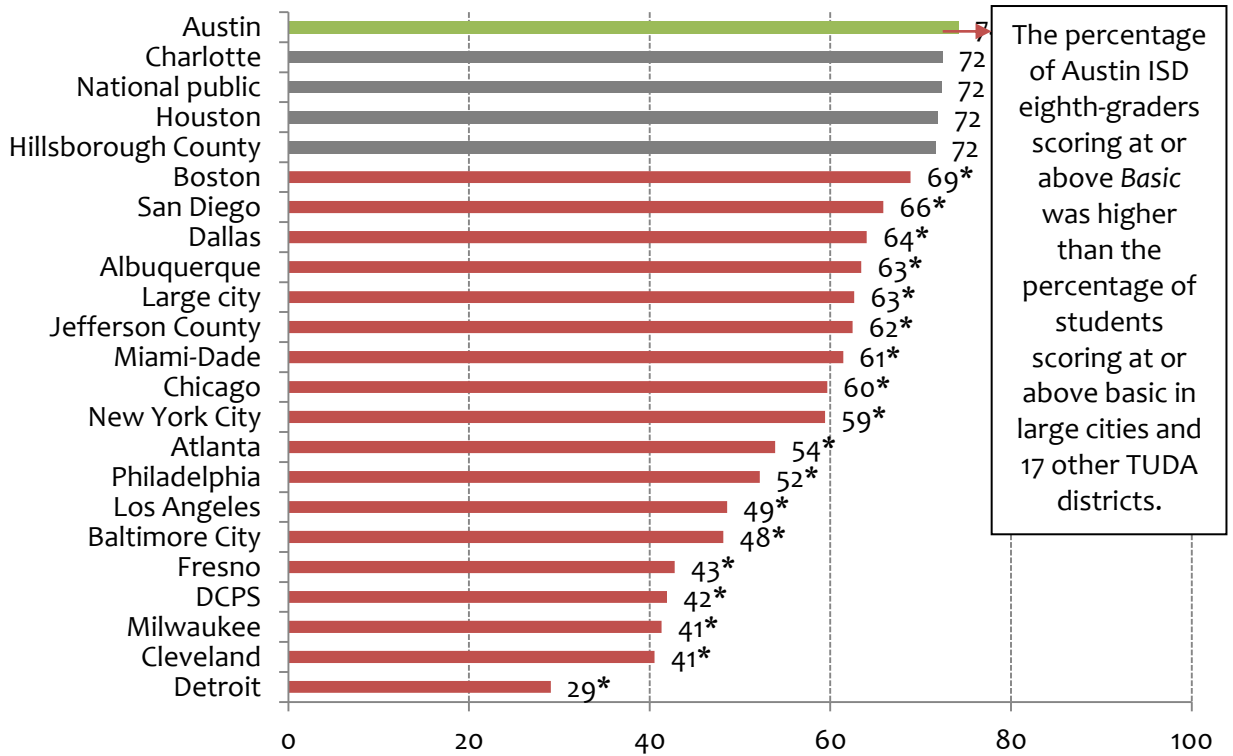


**Mathematics Figure 1.** Percent of fourth-graders scoring at or above *Basic* on NAEP mathematics, 2011



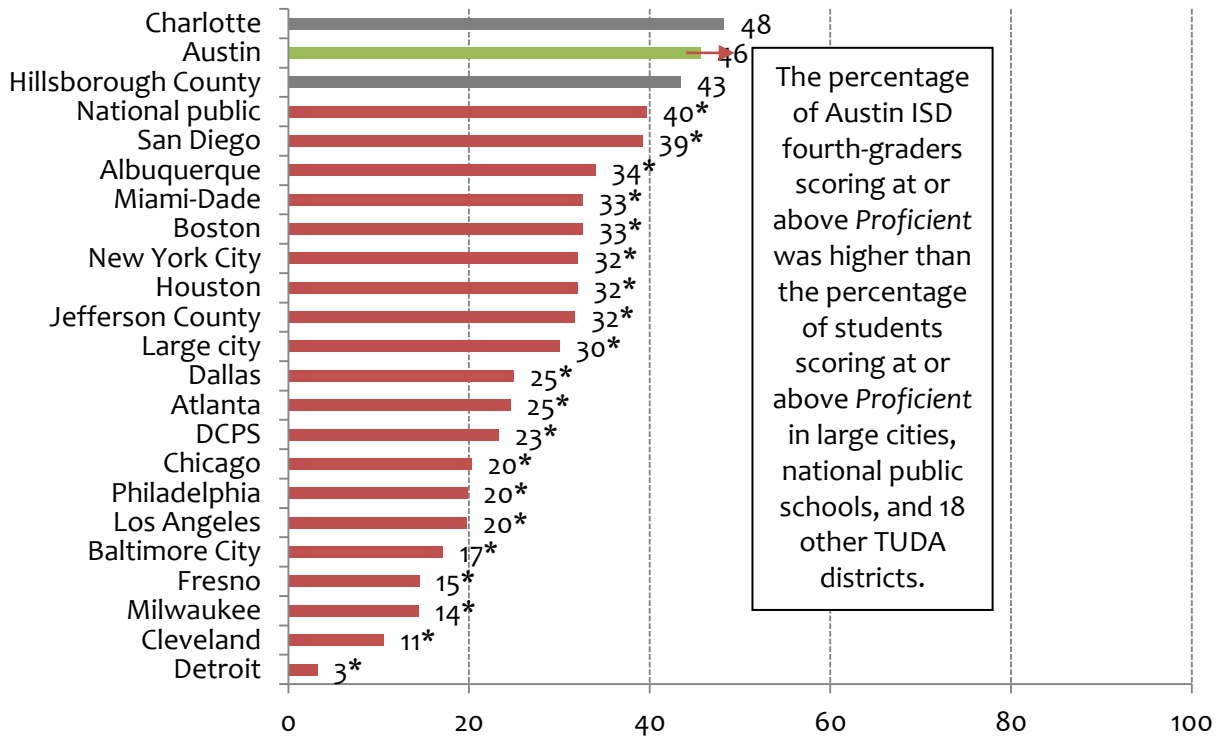
**Mathematics Figure 2.** Percent of eighth-graders scoring at or above *Basic* on NAEP mathematics, 2011



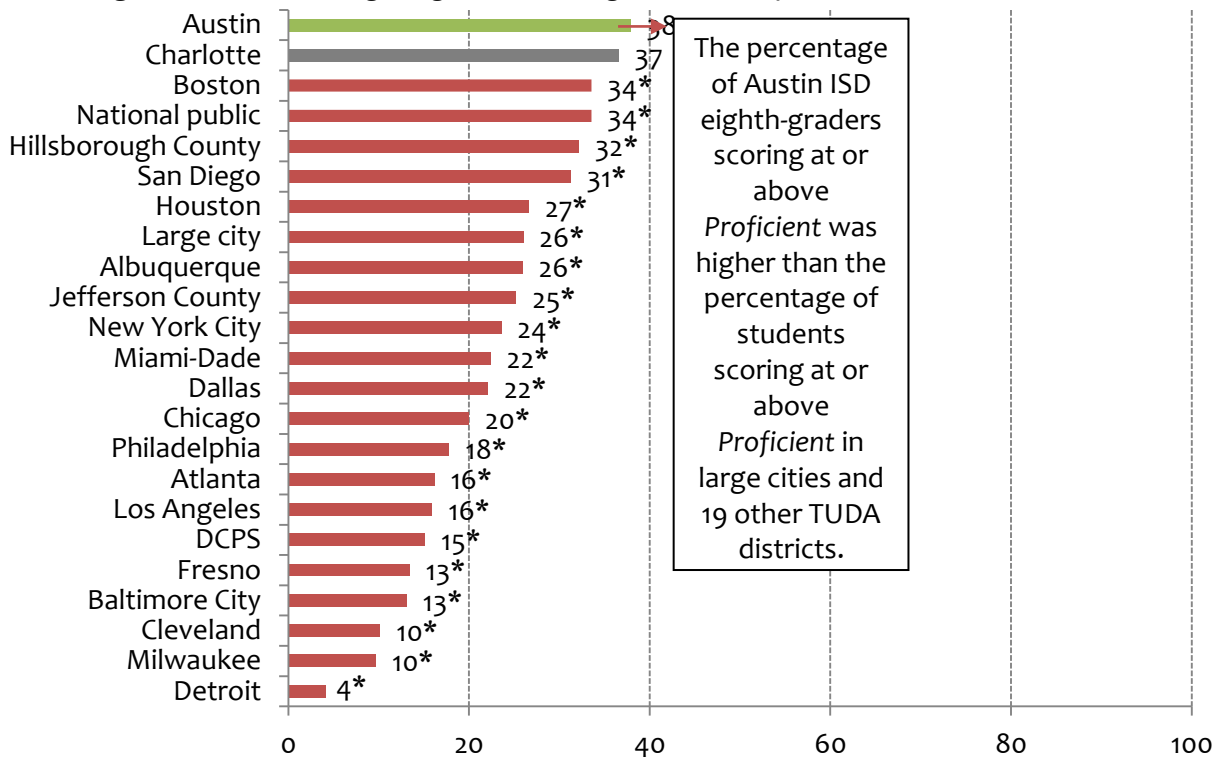

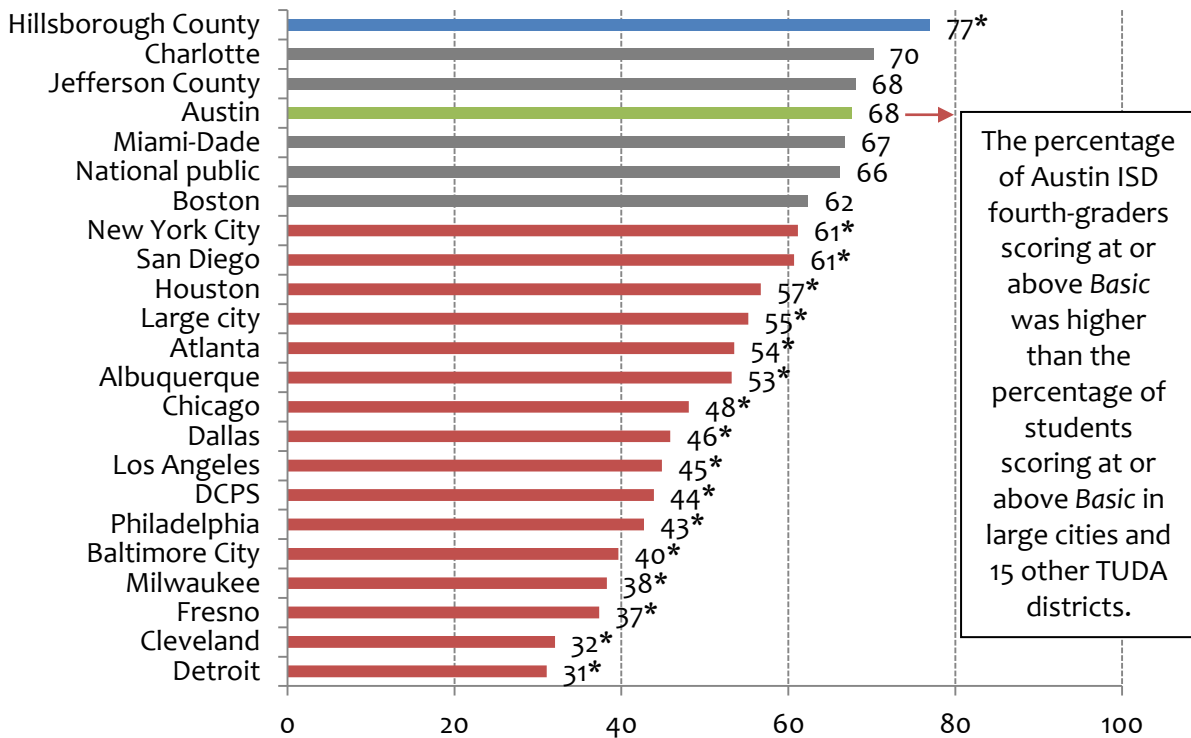

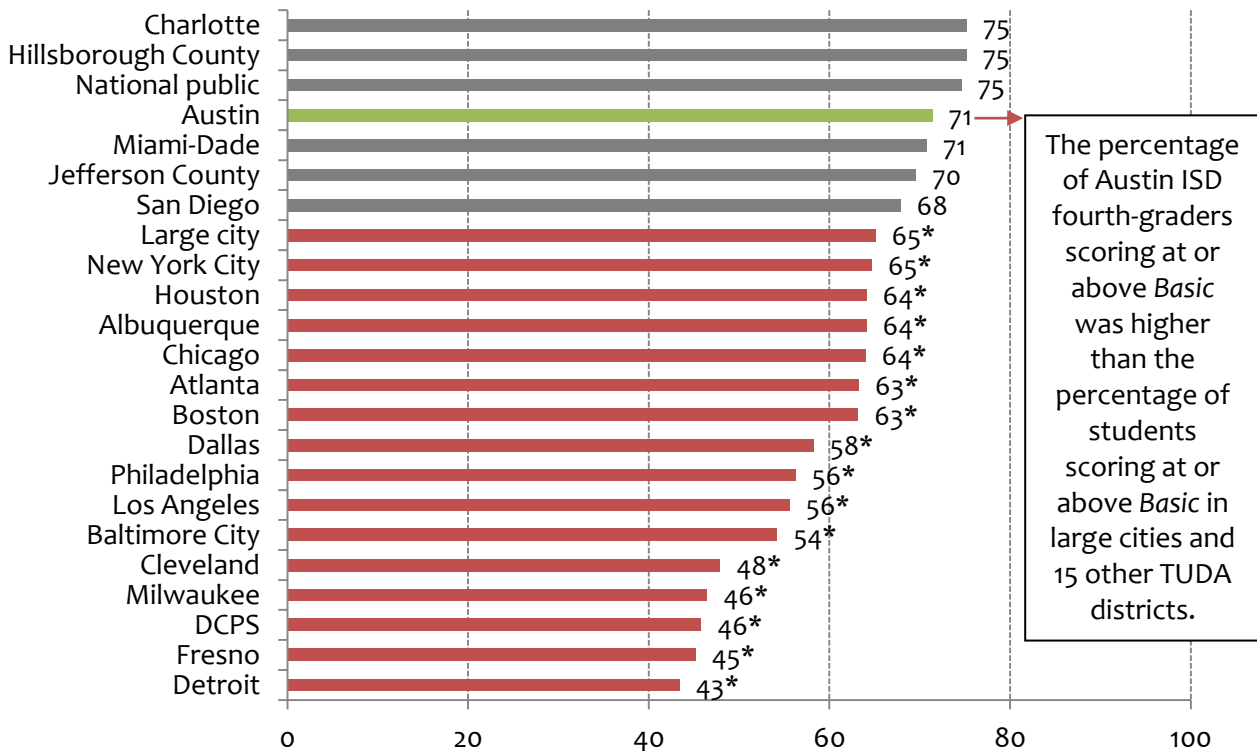

**Reading Figure 1.** Percent of fourth-graders scoring at or above Basic on NAEP reading, 2011



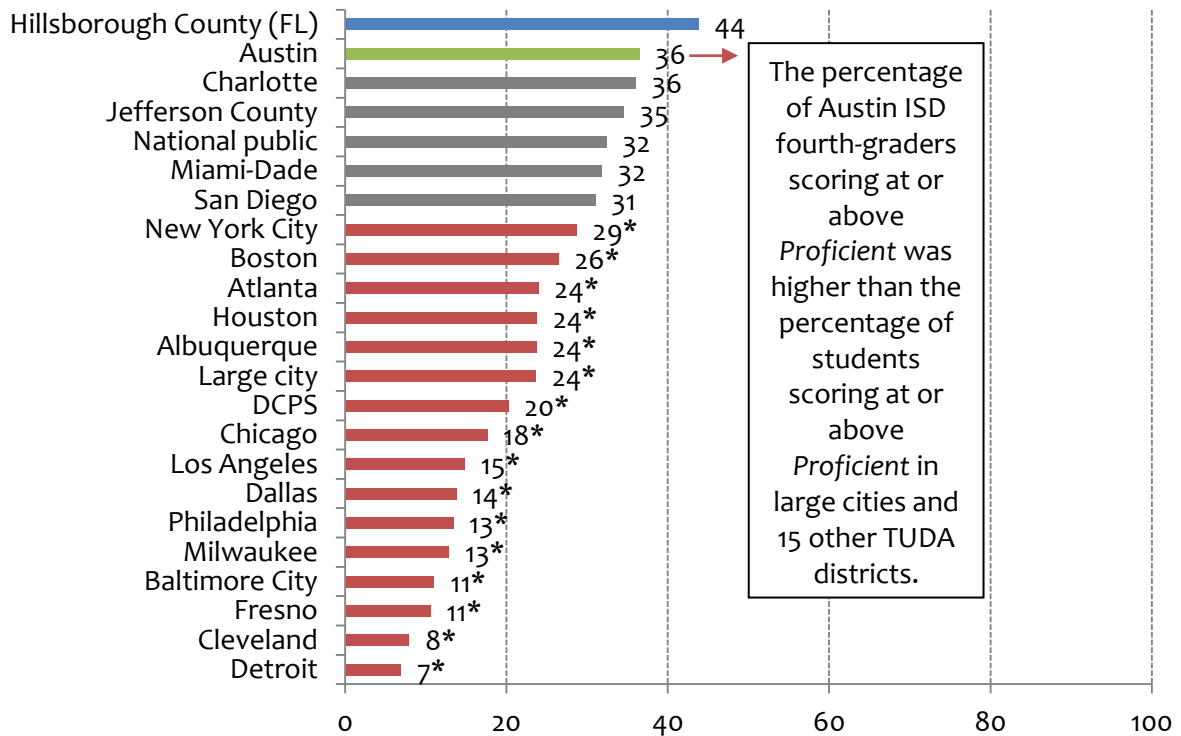
**Reading Figure 2.** Percent of eighth-graders scoring at or above basic on NAEP reading, 2011



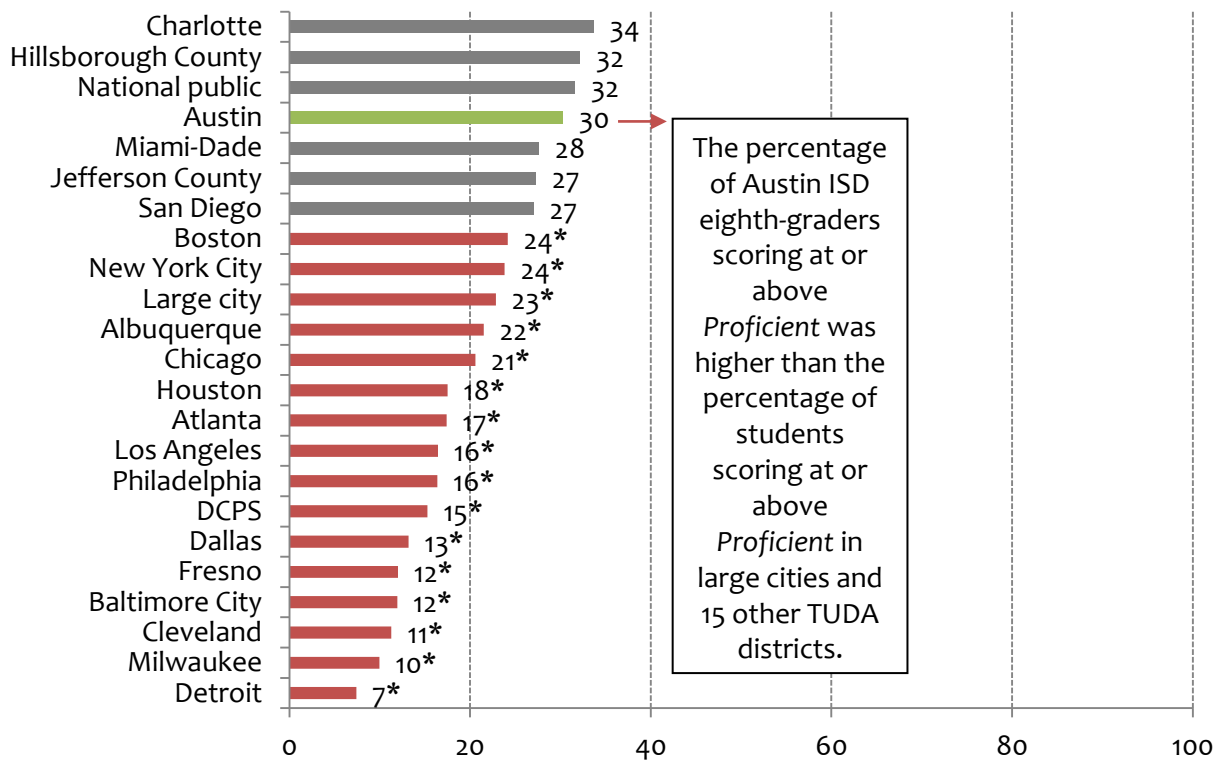
