ORDER RE: PETITION FOR USE AND DISSEMINATION OF JOHN DOE  
INFORMATION AND MATERIALS – REQUEST FOR COMMENCEMENT OF JOHN DOE

WHEREAS Milwaukee County Assistant District Attorney David Robles has requested that the John Doe Judge permit the use and disclosure of information developed in the course of these proceedings as may be reasonably necessary for the commencement of a new John Doe proceeding to investigate the specific violations that are identified in the Eighteenth Petition to Enlarge the John Doe proceedings, separate and distinct from the investigation in Milwaukee County Circuit Court Case no. 10JD000007, that will also facilitate the closure of the John Doe investigation in that matter;

NOW THEREFORE, for good cause shown, it is hereby ordered that the District Attorney's Office is authorized to use and disclose information from the John Doe proceeding in Milwaukee County Circuit Court Case no. 10JD000007, as may be reasonably necessary to petition for the commencement of a new John Doe proceeding.

FURTHER, the District Attorney's Office is authorized to use and disclose information from the John Doe proceeding in Milwaukee County Circuit Court Case no. 10JD000007 in order to conduct an investigation into the violations that formed the basis of the Eighteenth Enlargement of the Scope of the John Doe Proceeding, and that will form the basis of the investigation of a new John Doe proceeding.

In all other respects, this Order does not modify the scope or import of the existing Secrecy Order except as reasonably necessary to conduct the new John Doe proceeding, that shall be subject to any Secrecy Order in that proceeding.

I just locked in Eric O'Keefe to head up our national fundraising operations with donors we know from the Koch seminar and across the country as we discussed at the residence. I am hopeful that Nick will stay to his commitment to call his folks, tell them we are the group, and that they should contribute liberally to what we propose. I haven't spoken to him because I was waiting to nail down Eric. We will be hiring a key person in each state to hit our goals.

As I told you on the phone, putting Scott in that room will take major chunks of money off the table for an effort under our control. What is going on is an attempt to raise the resources under the RSLC in an alternative way to what Nick Ayers had proposed, but with the same effect. This isn't simply about being a team player, we will end up getting rolled. Every major hitter in the room will now NOT be contributing to our effort, because they believe they have already done so or have been waived in by us to the RSLC. Maybe you believe you have this worked out behind the scenes, and if somehow you can get an assurance that won't happen more power to you. I don't trust these people as far as I can throw them. As far as Fitzgerald, I would tell him the Governor will be raising 5 million plus under Wisconsin control.

After having been totally screwed by the U.S. Chamber I am more convinced than ever that we cannot put our fate in the hands of others. Their first negative add is finally going up this morning. 1.5 million in media available and it stalled. They likely have cost us any chance we had at keeping the court. They all start with "we are here to help." The problem is it's as much helping themselves as us, both in terms of skimming dollars for other efforts and skimming off of the buys. And then it's where when and how it is spent. That's reality. I have seen it happen on at least six occasions this year. The only way to succeed is as Reagan said trust but verify. Verification is we control the resources. As far as Reince entering the fray, in terms of the meeting suggested this week with them, us and Gillespie, ask yourself where the RNC has been on resources to underwrite the recall effort. Better yet, ask Jefferson. It's zero. Same story different day. Reince has raised a ton of dough on this for the RNC here. It may be as much as 7 figures.

With Eric now on board, I need the Governor on probably 7-8 trips to get us where we need to be along with some in-state stuff. It's the answer I have been waiting on and couldn't pressure time wise because I needed to raise half a million last week to run a flight of TV on Kloppenburg and try to do what the chamber was failing to do. That ad is up now under Citizens for a Strong America. Given that we have already raised 3 million for efforts in state from a variety of sources for the court, senate, and budget, I am not concerned that we can make our targets. What we don't need is donor confusion by the RSLC.

Johnson was a former political strategist for Walker. Johnson declined to say where Wisconsin Club for Growth is getting its funding.

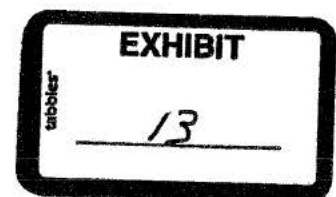

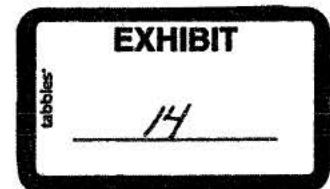

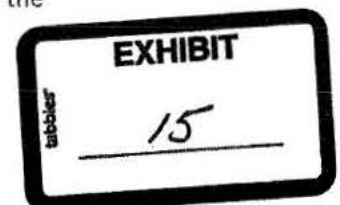
The "recently aired commercials" were radio ads run in Milwaukee, in October of 2008. They were issue advocacy in nature, and related to an advisory referendum on the November ballot to raise the sales tax in Milwaukee County by one percent.

The recently "disseminated communications" you refer to are two e-newsletter items, one in early January and a second in March about County Executive Scott Walker's public refusal to seek federal stimulus dollars. "No Pork on My Fork" was published on January 14<sup>th</sup>, and on March 4 we reprinted of an editorial by Walker, published in the Wall Street Journal about the same subject. Given your staff is on our mailing list, I assume that you've seen those newsletter articles.

We will continue to criticize and praise the behavior of our elected officials. We are concerned about the potential legal issues that might be presented should the Wisconsin Club for Growth continue to air the previous ads or run additional advertisements or communications featuring Scott Walker. (Communications include, but are not limited to, radio, television, mail, email and telephonic communication).

If the Wisconsin Club plans to air additional advertisements or engage in any of the aforementioned activities featuring Scott Walker, then we must insist on a legal opinion that your plans comply with a conservative interpretation of state laws and regulations and that any ads or communications and fundraising plans for such are reviewed by counsel before they air or are disseminated to the public. This is for the Wisconsin Club's sake as well as ours.

The Agreement that Wisconsin Club for Growth signed that allows it to use the Club for Growth name clearly indicates that it will fully comply with state election laws and regulations and avoid activities that would damage our reputation.

Please let us know if the Wisconsin Club plans to air any more ads or disseminate any communications featuring Scott Walker and if such are planned, then please brief us on the legal issues prior to running such ads or disseminating such materials.

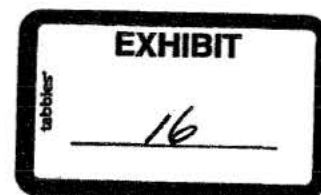

Spoke to Gillespie this morning. My sense is that everyone's heart (AFP, WIGOP, RSLC, RGA, CFG) is in the right place but no one is clear on the entire battle plan, and that is leaving very vulnerable gaps in both the planning and execution of a winning strategy.

Stating the obvious: it is crucial that if we provide the air cover in the coming few months that someone else has a top-notch absentee ballot and GOTV plan. It is crucial that if those two things are happening some other entity has total responsibility for collecting the petitions in the 3-4 targeted democratic senate seats. It is equally crucial that someone is providing talking points and a daily message to all the Party's talking heads. It is crucial that all these groups are reporting in on their progress and hitting their metrics for success. And it is crucial that we have a legal plan in place to challenge erroneous petitions and prevent voter fraud.

The point I am trying to make is that losing at any of these levels: GOTV plan; paid advertising; earned media; collecting petitions; legal strategy, means losing at all levels.

To resolve this we recommend getting together face to face on Wednesday or Friday of next week in WI to bring everyone together to assign responsibility and create a command structure. Does this sound correct to you? Ed and I are available by phone if you want to discuss.

Lowry Mays is CoB of Clear Channel Communications founded in 1972 where he helped Rush Limbaugh become the radio personality he is today. Scott - below are some suggested remarks by RJ for the call. RJ is in the hospital so he will be unable to join on the call. I will pinch hit for him as best I can to give some follow up comments and help answer any questions that may come up. I will bring a copy of this with me to the residence.

KG

We needed to hold four of the six Republican Senators facing recalls last week in order to maintain our conservative majority in the state senate. With your help and against the odds, we beat back the national unions and held our majority by a margin of 17-16.

Early polling told us that we would almost surely lose two of the six GOP seats. Two more seats were within the margin of error and trending the other way.

Thanks to your quick and very generous response to our call for help, we were able to frame the debate and define our opponents before they had a chance to define themselves.

And we managed to win in an environment where we were outspent more than 2-1, withstanding a massive influx of union organizers and an estimated 30 million dollars.

Wisconsin was declared ground zero by President Obama and the National Unions who wanted to stop similar collective bargaining reforms in states like Ohio and Florida. And they also turned the recalls into class warfare as a practice run for the 2012 Presidential race. If they could make us pay the ultimate price for our bold reforms, they believed they could stop reform efforts in Washington and around the country.

Wisconsin Democrats abdicated control of their campaigns to national consultants and Washington D.C. Unions, with heavy assistance from Barak Obama's Organizing for America, Moveon.org, The AFL-CIO, SEIU and others.

Our efforts were run by Wisconsin Club for Growth and operatives R.J. Johnson and Deb Jordahl, who coordinated spending through 12 different groups. Most spending by other groups was directly funded by grants from the Club.

We tactically outmaneuvered them.

By defining Democrat Shelly Moore early, we took a race that started at only plus 2 (and where the Governors numbers were upside down) off the table and kept it there. Moore was a board Member of the NEA and the State teachers union. We used her radical views and footage of her

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union speeches to disqualify her and turn off independent women and older voters. We knew women and older voters would reject her. We kept the pressure on through the election and won this seat by 16 points.

We also defined Democrat Fred Clark early. We used his horrendous driving record, failure to pay child support, and a recording of him saying he wanted to call a female constituent back and smack her around, to illustrate how Clark behaves when he thinks no one's watching. This angle was particularly helpful in eliminating Clark's advantage with independent women. We were behind by 2 points when we started this race and we won by 4.

Wisconsin Club for Growth raised 12 million dollars and ran a soup to nuts campaign. Every target was researched utilizing a top notch opposition researcher and Club advisors. Polling, focus groups and message development was a collaborative effort with help from Neil Newhouse and Pat Caddell.

An aggressive issue-based absentee ballot program was launched through direct mail and boots on the ground. Pro life, pro family and second amendment rights activists helped collect and process thousands of absentee ballot requests through a central operation.

These activists were joined on the ground by dozens of volunteers from Ralph Reed's Faith and Family organization through a grant from the Club.

The statewide voter list was enhanced with district specific micro-targeting data and 3.5 million pieces of issue-specific mail was sent to targeted voters.

From the beginning we knew conservatives suffered from of a double digit intensity gap that favored the Democrats. To address this, we ran a two week radio and Fox TV News admonished voters not to let the Madison liberals take us back. Simultaneously we ran generic television ads talking about the progress made balancing the state budget without raising taxes or cutting essential programs.

Targeted districts had as much as 8 weeks of heavy network and cable television and radio. Ads were run on poll tested issues, including fiscal responsibility, tax hikes, wasteful spending and spending priorities that moved independent swing voters to the GOP candidate.

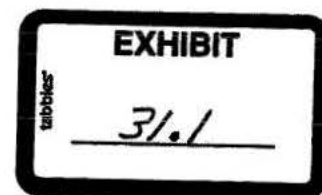

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Kenneth Griffin, chief executive of Citadel Investment Group LLC, and his wife Anne each contributed \$250,000 to Karl Rove's American Crossroads fundraising group, new Federal Election Commission reports show. Griffin, who runs the \$12.5 billion hedge fund based in Chicago, called the U.S. government's role in the financial system "frightening" at an April 2009 conference. His wife is managing partner of Aragon Global Management LLC, also based in Chicago. The U.S. attorney's office in Manhattan has subpoenaed Citadel as part of an investigation into insider trading, the Wall Street Journal reported Nov. 23. Griffin also gave \$650,000 to the Republican Governors Association, including \$150,000 on Oct. 11, Internal Revenue Service filings show.[2]

---

The Illinois chapter of Stand for Children was instrumental in this week's passage of a state law that makes it easier to fire ineffective teachers, makes it harder for teachers to strike, and carves out a longer school day for students in Chicago. Stand for Children's political action committee raised \$3.5 million last year in Illinois, more than enough to get the attention of the state's political and union leadership. It successfully solicited six-figure donations from several of the Chicago-area's leading corporate citizens, including the Pritzker family and Kenneth Griffin, founder and CEO of the Citadel Group. But its greatest coup was convincing statewide teachers' unions in Illinois to support a bill that links teacher layoffs to ability "not seniority." [3]

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One Chicago Hedge Fund billionaire, Kenneth Griffin of Citadel, wrote a single check for \$500,000 to Stand for Children at the end of December 2010. A week later, it would have been illegal for him to do so. [4]

---

The second biggest contribution came from Kenneth Griffin, the founder and CEO of the massive hedge fund Citadel, donated \$300,000 to the group. In 2007, Griffin backed Barack Obama's bid for the Democratic nomination for the presidency, raising between \$50,000 and \$100,000 as a donation 'bundler' and contributing the maximum \$4,600 to the then-Illinois senator's presidential bid. Griffin would ultimately go on to donate to and bundle contributions for the Republican candidate in the general election, Sen. John McCain (R-Ariz.). This is Griffin's second contribution to American Crossroads. Recently, Griffin bemoaned the lack of attention paid to hedge fund managers by the White House and claimed that President Obama had expanded government spending too much. Griffin was quoted in May saying, "The frustration with Obama is that the administration is taking the spending levels of the Bush era and multiplying them by some multiple. We are greatly concerned about the fiscal stability of this country." [5]

Ray Hunt, the Texas oil man who landed a controversial oil production deal with Iraq's Kurdistan regional government, has enjoyed close political and business ties with Vice President Dick Cheney dating back a decade and to the Bush family since the 1970s. [8]

DALLAS -- Hunt Oil Co. Chief Executive Ray Hunt said his ties to the Bush family and the Republican Party didn't help his company cut a deal last month to explore for oil in Iraq's semiautonomous Kurdish region.

The agreement, which gives the closely held Dallas company access to a largely unexplored part of oil-rich Iraq, has been criticized by the Bush administration and Iraqi officials as undermining efforts to strengthen the war-torn country's central government. Some critics also suggested Mr. Hunt was cashing in on his ties to President Bush, while others claimed he was turning his back on the president.

In an interview, the 64-year-old Mr. Hunt says that, contrary to the State Department's assertion, the company received no U.S. government advice before striking a deal. "The State Department must have been misinformed," he said. "We did not consult with anyone in the (U.S. government) prior to signing our agreement."

Mr. Hunt, a longtime friend of the Bush family, gave \$75,000 to Republican Party fund-raising committees in the past two years, according to the Center for Responsive Politics. But he said his political ties didn't play a role; the company saw an opening in Kurdistan and jumped on it. "It's another example where we're able to move quickly when opportunity presents itself," said Mr. Hunt, who says Kurdish oil executives turned to Hunt because of its oil-development record in Yemen.

Mr. Hunt added: "The fact is, as a matter of policy, we never have and never will go to the government of the U.S. and ask the government's advice on anything we do from a business point of view." [9]

---

Hunt's company, Hunt Oil, is exploring on the tribes' land and they want to tell its owners, in person, that the company isn't welcome there.

To date, Hunt has ignored local people's protests. Even though they have threatened to expel Hunt from the region. Even though oil exploration and drilling will destroy a beautiful part of the Peruvian Amazon that acts as the source of several rivers which 10,000 people depend on. Even though, at a recent meeting with two Hunt employees, one woman, from the Harakmbut tribe, said this:

'The people who said the company could work here, don't they have children? Don't they think about them? We are poor people. But even if they give us money " one sol, five soles, one hundred soles " oil exploration will kill us. The company must not be allowed to work here. I agree with what the others are saying. Don't insist any more! They're only interested in money! They already have plenty of money and now they want more! We want them to return to their own country and work there instead and not disturb us like this. Get out of here! If you want to explore for oil, go and do so on your own land, not ours. That's all. Thank you.' [10]

Campaign-finance watchdogs say Rees-Jones wasn't on their radar before he donated \$2 million this year to American Crossroads, an independent group raising money with the help of Republican strategist Karl Rove. That's because until 2008, Rees-Jones had donated less than \$20,000 to federal candidates, and just \$54,000 to state candidates.

"He expects to get something for his money, meaning he wants change," said T. Boone Pickens, the Dallas energy investor who has been a major contributor to Republicans in the past.

"We have some change now," Pickens said. "But if Republicans can get back in, maybe they can make it better than it is. It's not too good right now."

At the state level, Rees-Jones has given generously this year to several GOP-aligned groups, including \$250,000 to Texans for Lawsuit Reform, a group that advocates limits on lawsuit awards.

He gave \$150,000 to Associated Republicans of Texas, a group that works to preserve the GOP majority in the Texas Legislature, as well as \$100,000 to the re-election effort of Gov. Rick Perry.

Several people who know Rees-Jones said they don't think he has a particular agenda beyond electing pro-business Republicans. Chief Oil & Gas has never hired its own lobbyist in Washington, according to House lobbying records.

^



At a recent conference on natural gas at the George W. Bush Presidential Center, Rees-Jones talked about Chief's efforts to work with landowners whose property is needed for drilling. But he stayed away from political subjects such as environmental regulation.[12]

Both Dick and Liz have a strong history of contributing to conservative causes and candidates, most notably Club for Growth. Dick recently gave \$50,000 to Justice Prosser for his election and recount.

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subject: harold simmons

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Harold Simmons has consistently been a target of environmentalists. One of the most immediate issues was that NL Industries (purchased by Simmons in 1986) was the leading maker of lead pigment paint. A 2007 ruling showed that NL Industries did not have to pay the City of Milwaukee \$53 million in damages for repairing windows with lead paint and the treatment of children who had suffered from lead poisoning.

A spread in Dallas Magazine described NL Industries as having blatant disregard for its dumping of toxic waste, even though much of this dumping came before Simmons owned the company – many of the sites (most specifically Ferdinand, OH) took years for NL to even begin cleanup.

Still, they claim Simmons has dumped on sites on the EPA’s National Priorities List, most notoriously through political maneuvering in the Texas Legislature. In a 2006 interview Simmons stated – “We first had to change the law (in Austin) to where a private company can own a license [to handle radioactive waste], and we did that. Then we got another law passed that said they can only issue one license. Of course, we were the only ones that applied.”

Most recently (July 2009), he paid out \$178.1 million to a plaintiff (minority shareholders in an NL subsidiary) who – “claimed that NL had improperly stripped the subsidiary of its assets and reduced the value of their shares tenfold.”

Simmons does have a past history with unions, most specifically the UAW. National Lock, a subsidiary of Keystone, then owned by Harold Simmons, moved its operations from Illinois to South Carolina. The Local UAW argued that National Lock needed to bargain over the move, while National Lock argued that UAW had received notice but did not make address the issue until it was too late.

Additionally, Simmons was found guilty of violating federal pension fund law by using a Local UAW’s pension funds to purchase a Utah firm.

Simmons has been fined and continuously targeted by the Federal Election Commission and also attempted a high profile hostile takeover of Gehl Industries in West Bend.
