To provide for the acquisition and publication of data relating to cybercrimes against individuals, and for other purposes.
1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
4 This Act may be cited as the "Cybercrime Statistics
5 Act''.

1	SEC. 2. NATIONAL STRATEGY, CLASSIFICATION, AND RE-
2	PORTING ON CYBERCRIME.
3	(a) National Strategy.—The Attorney General
4	shall develop a national strategy to reduce the incidence
5	of cybercrimes against individuals, coordinate investiga-
6	tions of cybercrimes against individuals by Federal law en-
7	forcement agencies, and increase the number of Federal
8	prosecutions of cybercrimes against individuals.
9	(b) Classification of Cybercrimes Against In-
10	DIVIDUALS FOR PURPOSES OF CRIME REPORTS.—Pursu-
11	ant to authority under section 534 of title 28, United
12	States Code, the Director of the Federal Bureau of Inves-
13	tigation shall—
14	(1) design and create within the Uniform Crime
15	Reports a category for offenses that constitute
16	cybercrimes against individuals;
17	(2) to the extent feasible, within the category
18	established pursuant to paragraph (1), establish sub-
19	categories for each type of cybercrime against an in-
20	dividual which is an offense under Federal or State
21	law;
22	(3) classify the category established pursuant to
23	paragraph (1) as a Part 1 crime in the Uniform
24	Crime Reports; and
25	(4) classify each type of cybercrime against an
26	individual which is an offense under Federal or

1	State law as a Group A offense for the purpose of
2	the National Incident-Based Reporting System.
3	(c) Annual Summary.—The Attorney General shall
4	publish an annual summary of the information reported
5	in the Uniform Crime Reports and the National Incident-
6	Based Reporting System relating to cybercrimes against
7	individuals.
8	(d) Definitions.—In this section:
9	(1) The term "cybercrimes against individ-
10	uals" means Federal, State, or local criminal of-
11	fenses that involve the use of a computer to cause
12	personal harm to an individual, such as the use of
13	a computer to harass, threaten, stalk, extort, coerce,
14	cause fear, intimidate, without consent distribute in-
15	timate images of, or violate the privacy of, an indi-
16	vidual, except that—
17	(A) use of a computer need not be an ele-
18	ment of such an offense; and
19	(B) such term does not include the use of
20	a computer to cause harm to a commercial enti-
21	ty, government agency, or any non-natural per-
22	sons.
23	(2) The term "computer" includes a computer
24	network and any interactive electronic device.
