Dear Lukas Knight:

This letter is in response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request addressed to the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF) dated November 23, 2015. You are requesting all records and reports regarding the safety of diketones (especially, diacetyl, acetylacetone, and hexane-2,5-dione) when used as flavorants.

You are also requesting any records of reports that specifically mention "the use of diketones in juices used to produce inhaled vapours and their possible effects on the respiratory system when ingested in that way."

Your request was subsequently referred to the Alcohol and Tobacco Tax and Trade Bureau (TTB) and received in this office on September 15, 2016.

Please be advised TTB does not maintain the information that you have requested. TTB administers statutory provisions related to the collection of Federal excise tax on alcohol, tobacco, firearms, and ammunition, and to the labeling and advertising of alcohol beverages.

We have determined that the information you are seeking would be under the purview of the Food and Drug Administration (FDA). Therefore, we are transferring your request to the FOIA Officer for FDA, for processing under the FOIA and for direct response to you.
